**DATE:** Saturday November 2, 2019

**START LOCATION:** Patuxent Wildlife Visitor Center  
10901 Scarlet Tanager Loop, Laurel, MD 20708. Near the solar panels in the parking lot

**START/FINISH:** 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM finish by 4:00 PM. (Visitor Center with rest rooms does not open until 9:00 AM)

**TRAIL DESCRIPTION:** There are 2 5K loops. 1<sup>st</sup> loop goes through the Visitor Center and exhibits, demonstration of the PEPCO power line right-of-way management program, meadow management, and a mitigation wetland, wander through a forested wetland Goose Pond, woodland trail, and through a woodland valley. Loop 2 Goes around the outside trails pine and hardwood forests, opportunities to view Cash Lake and its waterfowl, as well as a beaver lodge and evidence of their activity. There may be fallen trees across the trails not suitable for wheelchairs and hard for strollers.

**TRAIL RATING:**

**1** - Very small hills or very little stair climbing

**B** - A significant part of the route is on well-groomed trails with very few obstacles.

**AMENITIES:** Water, candy and restrooms available at the Start/Finish and midpoint. Please carry water.

**SPECIAL PROGRAMS:** Bridges, Boardwalks

**SANCTION:** The Maryland Volkssport Association and the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports. This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards.

**PROCEDURE:** AVA policy requires that every participant, fee or non-fee, sign the insurance waiver and obtain a numbered start card. At the finish, the validated card is turned in and IVV books are stamped for official credit, if the credit fee has been paid. The trail may be walked a second time on the same day using the same start card at no additional cost.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Everyone is welcome to participate. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Walk at your own pace and speed.

**REGISTRATION:** Each walker must register at the start by filling out a start card to be carried throughout the event.

**FEES:** Our walk is free. IVV credit is \$3.00. Children under 12 may earn IVV credit for no charge. Event sponsored by the Great Greenbelt Volksmarch Club. New walker packets will be available for \$6.00 and Event/Distance Books for \$6.00.

**CONDITIONS:** The event will be held in all reasonable weather conditions. Pets allowed on trails except in the visitor center, the ponds, or lakes. Pets but must be kept on a leash no longer than 10' at all times, pet owners must pick up after pets. There will be no littering. Trash and recycling containers are available at the start.

**PARKING:** There is plenty of free parking at the start. See driving directions.
