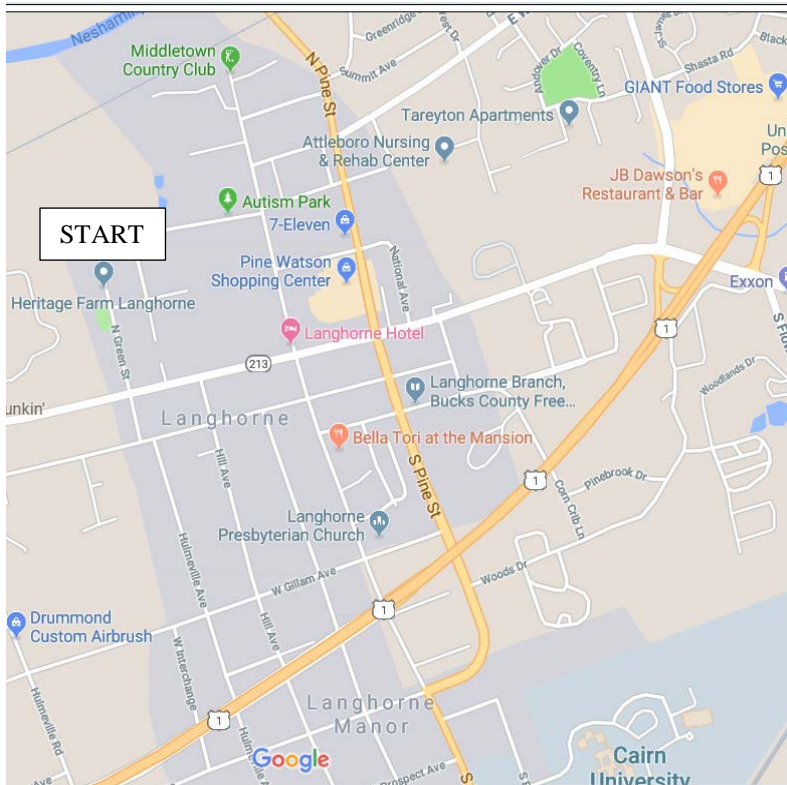


## DIRECTIONS

From the PA Turnpike (I-276), take Exit 351 and merge onto US-1 North. Proceed to PA-213 (Maple Ave) 4.5 miles (do not take Business US-1). Make a right onto PA-213S and go straight. Cross N. Flowers Mill Rd. (The Shoppes at Flowers Mill); PA-413 (Pine St.); Bellevue Ave. (Langhorne Hotel on right); and continue to N. Green St. Turn right onto N. Green St. Proceed to Heritage Farm on the left. Parking in open space next to the gardens. Look for LBW signs.

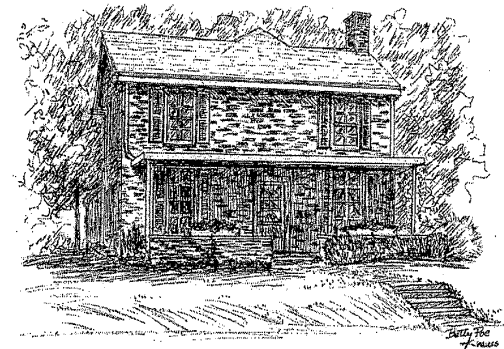

**TRAIL DESCRIPTION: AVA Trail Rating 1-A**

The trail begins on the grounds of Heritage Farm featuring an historic farmhouse dating back to 1840. Walk through the historic district passing the 300 year old Langhorne Hotel and many other notable buildings that date as far back as 1793. The trail also goes through a picturesque neighborhood with stately older mansions on beautifully manicured tree-lined streets, and the quaint downtown district with many shops and restaurants. Other highlights include the Revolutionary Soldier's Burial site and the Catawisa Nature Preserve. The trail is almost entirely on pavement and mostly flat. The trails through the nature preserve are natural. Suitable for strollers and wheelchairs.

**SPECIAL PROGRAMS:**

Bridges, Ice Cream Parlors, Little Free Libraries, Take a Walk in a City Park, Walk the USA Street by Street, Walking the USA A-Z, PA County Program

**PARKING:**

Parking is free on the grounds of the park. Follow LBW signs.

**FACILITIES:**

Restrooms are available at the Start/Finish. Water will also be available at the Start/Finish.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

This event is open to the public. You do not need to be a member of the Liberty Bell Wanderers to participate. Adult supervision is required for all children.

**PROCEDURES:**

All participants must register and complete a Start Card which is carried on the walk, and must be returned at the Finish. This also applies to free walkers.

**CONDITIONS:**

This event will be held regardless of weather conditions. There are no refunds. **Pets are permitted but must be leashed and picked up after.**
