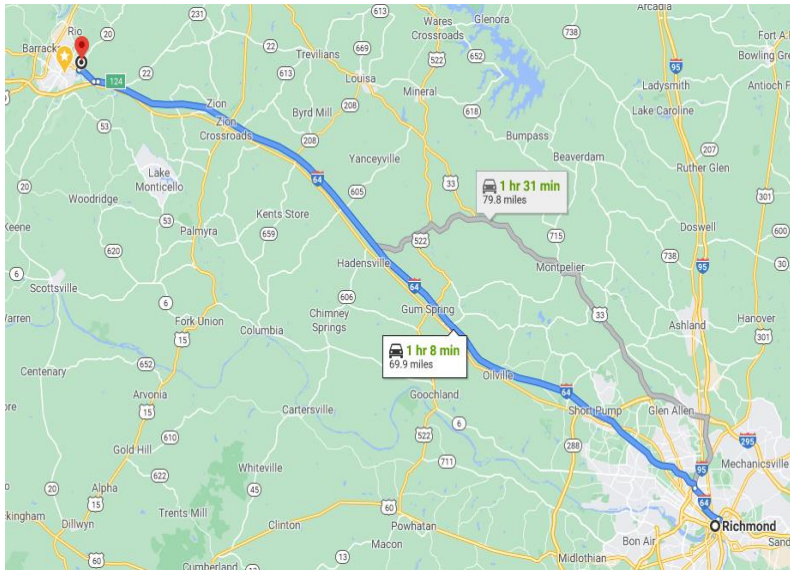
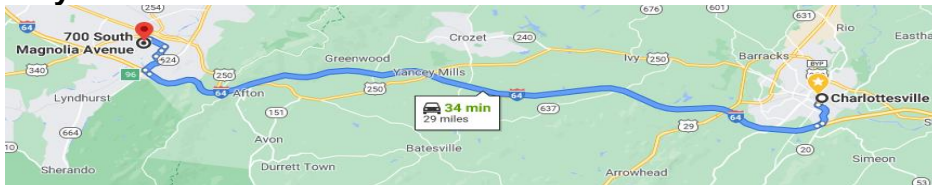


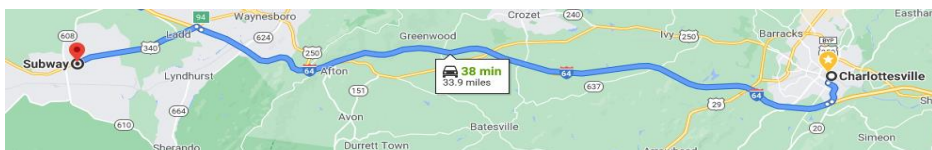

General Event Information

Sanctioned: All events in this brochure are sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV). These events count toward the acquisition of IVV achievement awards.

Disclaimer: The American Volkssport Association or its subsidiary clubs are not responsible for theft or loss of personal belongings or property. All participants must sign a waiver.

Sponsor: Virginia Volkssport Association (AVA-VA)

Distances: All events are 5 or 10 kilometers.

Start Times: All walks will start between 9 am and noon, finish by 3 pm.

Start Points: Saturday:

Eligibility: All are welcome. Everyone must register and sign the insurance waiver at the start, fill out and carry a start card, and turn it in upon completing the walk. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

Fees: There is no charge to participate. Credit only is \$3. There will be no refund of any monies paid.

Conditions: These events will be held regardless of most weather conditions. Carry water regardless of weather conditions. IVV Books and New Walker packets will be available for sale at all events. Pets are welcome on the trail, but not in the registration point. Wheelchairs and strollers may be used on all trails.

Refreshments: Water and candy will be available at the start/finish. Restrooms will be available at all start points but may not be available on the trail. Restaurants are available on the town trails.

Saturday, 29 May—Albemarle County

Start Point: Shelter at Darden Towe Park, 1445 Darden Towe Park, Charlottesville, VA, GPS: 38° 02' 37.3" N, 78° 26.57.3" W

Trail Description: Rated 2B: This lovely walk will be along the Old Mills Trail starting in Darden Towe Park and continuing along the east side of the Rivanna River. It is mostly flat except for a steep hill near the end. The trail is partly paved but mostly dirt. There are steps at the beginning and end of the walk.

Directions: Take I-64 to Exit 124 toward Charlottesville to US 250 W. Take US 250 W for about 1.6 miles to VA-20 N (Stony Point Rd). Turn RIGHT on VA-20 N and continue about ½ mile to Elk Dr. Turn LEFT on Elk Dr and continue to the T-intersection in the park. Turn RIGHT and continue to the end parking lot near the shelter.

AVA Special Programs: Virginia Counties.

Sunday, 30 May—City of Waynesboro

Start Point: Ridgeview Park River Shelter, 700 S. Magnolia Ave, Waynesboro, VA, GPS: 38° 03' 56.6" N, 78° 54' 21.5" W

Trail Description: Rated 2A: This walk will be along the town sidewalks in the city of Waynesboro, named for Gen Anthony Wayne. It is the home of Fishburne Military School. The city is at the intersection of the Shenandoah National Park's Skyline Drive, the Blue Ridge Parkway, and the Appalachian Trail.

Directions: Take I-64 to Exit 96 in Waynesboro. Turn RIGHT on Delphine Ave and continue about 0.6 miles to Windsor Rd. Turn LEFT on Windsor Rd and continue about 0.3 mi to Jefferson Ave. Turn RIGHT on Jefferson Ave and continue about 0.3 mi to Lyndhurst Rd. Bear slight RIGHT on Lyndhurst Rd and continue straight on S Wayne Ave for about 0.2 mi to 13th St. Turn LEFT on 13th St and continue about 0.6 mi to S Magnolia Ave. Turn LEFT on S Magnolia Ave and continue into the park. The River Shelter is on the right, just past the swimming pool.

AVA Special Programs: Little Free Libraries, Walking the USA A-Z, Walking with America's Veterans. Also qualifies for Virginia Cities and Virginia Find the LOVE.

Monday, 31 May--Augusta County (Stuart's Draft)

Start Point: Subway, 2857 Stuart's Draft Hwy, Stuart's Draft, VA. GPS: 38° 02' 13.2" N, 79° 01' 36.9" W

Trail Description: Trail rating: 2A. The walk will be along sidewalks and sides of roads in the town of Stuart's Draft. The town has been called the "Warehouse Capital of the World" because of the seven warehouse/factories, including Hershey Chocolate.

Directions: Take I-64 to Exit 94 in Waynesboro to US 340 W/P. Buckley Moss Dr. Take US 340 W toward Stuart's Draft for about for about 5.1 miles to Broadmoor Plaza on your left, just past Sheetz. Turn LEFT into the shopping center. Subway will be on your left. Please park away from the restaurant.

AVA Special Programs: Walking the USA A-Z. Also qualifies for Virginia Counties program.
