ALTITUDE: Event Elevation is 7,881 ft.

LOCATION: Loghill Village, Colorado

DATE: June 2021 (Postponed from June 27 2020)

START TIMES: 7:00 am to 9:00 am

FINISH TIME: 12:00 pm

START/FINISH: Log Hill Volunteer Fire Department; 434 Ponderosa Dr.; Loghill Village in Ridgway, Colorado

GPS: 38.1952677, -107.77950

DISTANCE: 6/10 Kilometers (3.6/6.2 miles).

AWARD: This is an IVV credit-only event.

TRAIL: Walk is rated a “3C”. Trail is on nature trails. Sturdy hiking shoes recommended. Carrying water and using sunscreen is highly recommended. Water is available at the start/finish and check points. Please allow 2 ½ hours to enjoy the walk.

FUNDRAISING:

Log Hill Fire’s property tax revenue has dropped by almost 40% with the decrease in property values throughout the district since 2011. We continue to steward the tax funds we receive and use them to best protect the residents of the district and our volunteer firefighters. We believe we have done a good job so far with modern facilities and equipment coupled with no debt and well-trained firefighters.

DIRECTIONS:

FROM Montrose: Head south on US Hwy 550 for about 12 miles. Turn right before the La Zona Coffee Shop in Colona onto Hotchkiss Ave. It turns left and becomes CR 1. Follow it for about 11.5 miles, then turn left on Ponderosa Dr. This route has approximately 8 miles of gravel roads to traverse.

Alternate FROM Montrose: Head south on US Hwy 550 for about 25.5 miles. Turn right onto CO-62/Sherman St in Ridgway. Follow remaining directions below.

FROM Ouray: Head north on US Hwy 550 for about 10 miles. Turn left onto CO-62/Sherman St in Ridgway, after two miles turn right on CR-24A, then left on CR-24. In .9 miles, continue straight onto CR-1. In about 2.1 miles turn right on Ponderosa Dr.

Carpooling is encouraged.
