

Directions to the start point:

From I-95 exit 89, MD Rte 155, to Havre de Grace (HdG). MD Rte 155 ends at Juniata St. Right on Juniata, left on Otsego, continue under railroad bridge right onto Union Avenue. Straight on Union to Congress Avenue. Turn left. The Oktoberfest is held in Hutchins Park at the foot of Congress, along the Susquehanna River. The site for the Start/Finish table will be at the corner of Market and Congress.

Note: Parking for the event is on city streets. However, there may be some area street closures.

Registration: Masks are required and social distancing practices will be in place. This event is open to the public. The fee for IVV Credit or Non-IVV Credit is \$3.00. Children 12 and under (IVV-Credit included) walk for free courtesy of Baltimore Walking Club. The same trail may be walked for distance credit twice on the same start card on the same day for no extra charge.

Conditions: All are welcome to participate but must register at the start, carry a start card during the event, and turn it in upon completion. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult during the entire event. All Volkssport participants must sign the disclaimer. The event will be held in all reasonable weather conditions. If in doubt, contact the persons listed below. Pets are welcome. Pets must be leashed during the entire walk, and cleaned up after.

Description of the Event: City walk along the Lafayette Trail.

Some parts of the trail may overlap with the popular HdG YRE (which starts on Union Avenue).
