

Easy Directions! Free Parking!

From the north: Take I-95 South/I-495 South towards Richmond. Use local lanes as you approach the Woodrow Wilson Bridge. Shortly after entering Virginia, take Exit 176B (Eisenhower Ave.) staying in right lane. Turn right at Stovall St. Turn right on Eisenhower Ave. and go to first traffic light. Make legal U-turn and turn right into hotel parking lot.

From the south: Take I-95 North/ I-495 East towards Baltimore. Take Exit 174 (Eisenhower Ave. Connector.) Turn right on Eisenhower and go approximately one mile. Turn right into hotel parking lot.

From the metro: Hotel is one block from the Eisenhower Metro stop (Yellow line). Exit metro and turn left on Eisenhower Ave. Turn left into hotel parking lot.

WHAT'S A VOLKSMARCH?

A volksmarch is a non-competitive walk. You may choose your time to start within the start/finish "window" and walk at your own pace. You can walk alone, with family or friends, or with folks you meet along the way. You can walk for free or pay a small amount to earn credits that provide a tangible record of your participation. START TIME: Register and start walking between 8:00 AM and noon (Sat and Sun). Finish by 4:00 PM.

SCOTTISH WALK: On 11 a.m. Saturday, Old Town Alexandria will welcome more than a hundred marching units to salute the town's rich Scottish heritage. The 10-KM trail takes Saturday's walkers within a block of the parade. Walkers choose whether to walk one block to view the parade or continue. The 5-KM trail and Sunday walk is an option for walkers who do not care about the parade. Eligible for AVA Special Program: Walking the USA: A-Z

WALK ACROSS THE POTOMAC: The walker either drives a short distance to Jones Point Park or walks this trail in conjunction with the Scottish Walk. Once crossing Woodrow Wilson Bridge the trail takes advantage of Christmas sights of National Harbor. Eligible for AVA Special Programs: Border Crossing, Walking with America's Veterans, Walking the USA: A-Z.

DC HOLIDAY SIGHTS: The trail passes many places decorated for the holidays including Union Station, the Capitol, the Botanical Gardens, and the Ellipse. Metro available one block from the Holiday Inn. Eligible for AVA Special Programs: Rockin' Around the Clock, Mayflower-400th Anniversary, Walking the U.S.- Capitals. Walking the USA: A-Z. Register at hotel or in advance via OnLine Start Box.

DINNER: Everyone is invited to Ted's Montana Grill Saturday at 6 p.m. (across the street from hotel).

HOLIDAY INN: The hotel is offering walkers reduced rates (\$99 a night) for Friday, Dec. 3 and Saturday, Dec. 4. Call 855-857-9861 and ask for "Holiday Extravaganza 2021" Room Block.

FEES: There is no charge to participate in these events. The fee for IVV credit is \$3. There is no pre-registration for this event. No refunds will be given.
