2 Travelling Guided Walks

Tyler State Park (AT 20/116285) – **Thursday, October 15, 2020**

Start Point: The Boat House at Tyler State Park, 101 Swamp Rd., Newtown, PA 18940

Directions: From the PA Turnpike (I-276), take Exit 343 for Willow Grove. Merge onto PA-611 N. Go 0.8 miles and turn Right onto Blair Mill Rd. In 1.8 miles, turn Right onto W. County Line Rd. Go 0.8 miles and turn Left onto Jacksonville Rd./PA-332E. Follow PA-332 for 9.7 miles. Turn Left on PA-332 E/PA-413 N/PA-532 N. In 0.5 miles turn Left to enter the park on Swamp Rd. at the traffic light. When you reach the stop sign, turn Right and follow Main Park Rd. 1.2 miles to the parking lot just before the Boat House. Registration will take place at the Boat House Parking Lot.

Trail: AVA trail rating is 1-B. Distance is 10K, but a shorter distance may be offered. The trail winds through scenic woodlands and along Neshaminy Creek on paved trails and wooded gravel paths. There are minor hills. Strollers and wheelchairs should have no difficulty on the paved trails, but may have difficulty on the gravel paths. Restrooms available at the start point. Water should be carried. Dogs are permitted, but must be leashed and picked up after.

Antietam Lake Park (AT 20/116288) – **Thursday, November 5, 2020**

Start Point: Angora Trailhead Parking Lot at Antietam Lake Park, 232 Angora Rd., Reading 19606

Directions: Take US-422 W towards Reading. Turn Right on Shelbourne Rd. near Wendy's and Dunkin' on the right. Go 2 miles and turn Left onto PA-562/St. Lawrence Ave. Go 1.3 miles and turn Right onto N. Bingamin St. which becomes Butter Lane. Go 0.4 miles and turn Right onto Antietam Rd. Go 0.4 miles and turn Left onto Angora Rd. Go 0.3 miles and turn Left into trailhead parking lot.

Trail: AVA trail rating is 2B. Distance is 10K or 5K. Trail is on natural paths through wooded areas. Much of the trail parallels a very scenic and swift moving creek. There are some minor hills and the trail may be rough in places. Not suitable for strollers and wheelchairs. There are no restrooms at the start point or along the trail. Suggest you stop at Dunkin' on the way to the start point. Water should be carried. Dogs are permitted, but must be leashed and picked up after.
