## **What is a Volksmarch?**

Is literally a “folks walk” or a walk for the people who participate at their own pace with friends over a marked course of usually 10 kilometers (6.2 miles)

**Distances Offered:** 5 km and 10 km

**Trails:** The courses are mostly flat and paved, with some small hills and some rough pavement (rated 2A). The 5 km course is a tour of the Adrian city streets and uses sidewalks. The 10 km course is an out & back on the Kiwanis rail-trail. The two courses can be combined to form a 15 km course or a 10 km half city and half rail-trail course. The walks are not timed. Stopping to eat, shop, take photos is encouraged as long as you stop by the finish table before 3:00 PM.

**Accessibility:** The 5k and 10k courses are wheelchair and stroller accessible.

**Fees and Awards:** EVERYONE is welcome.

Participants do not have to belong to the club. There is a \$3.00 fee for IVV credit. There are no awards given.

**Registration:** All registration is done on the day of the event. There will be a table set up in Trestle Park for that purpose. Participants must sign-in and sign the waiver.

**Conditions:** This is a one day event and will be held rain or snow or shine. Only deep snow or ice will cancel the event.

**Amenities:** Restrooms are available in town and on the rail-trail. Restaurants and shops are along the town 5-km course .

## **Driving Directions to Event Start-Finish**

From either the North or the South, enter Adrian on MI-52 (Main St) and drive to the intersection of Hunt St which is one block north of the courthouse. Turn west onto W Hunt St and drive to dead end of Hunt and park in Trestle Park lot, look for the event table. Note: Some GPS's (Apple CarPlay) will try to send you to E Hunt Street but Trestle Park is on W Hunt Street.
