

Directions:

From State College: Take SR 322 East to Newport Exit.

From Harrisburg: Take SR 322 West to Newport Exit.

At Newport exit, turn onto SR 34 South into Newport. Continue one mile south of town to State Park Road. Follow the brown State Park signs as you continue on SR 34, one mile south of town to Little Buffalo Road. Turn right onto Little Buffalo Road. Drive through the first intersection near the park office, pass Holman Lake on your left, turn left onto Swimming Pool Road. Drive into the Main Picnic area. Passing the first road on the right, park in the first section of larger parking area. Follow the signs to Pavilion #1.

Parking: There is plenty of free parking.

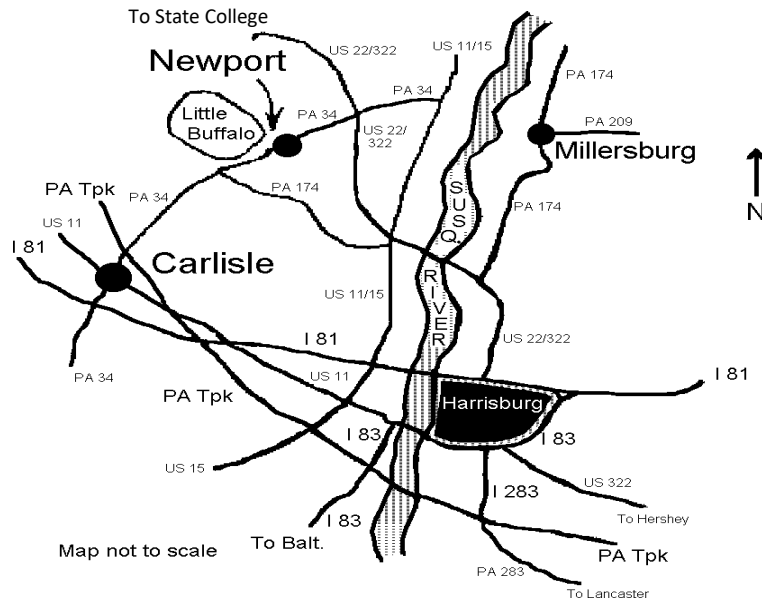

Eligibility: Everyone is welcome to participate. Walk at your own pace. Runners are welcome. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult.

Trail: Little Buffalo was the first year-round event in PA. We haven't had an event here for several years. Come stroll down memory lane as you walk past the Blue Ball Tavern, Clay's Covered Bridge (shown on the cover), Shoaff's Grist Mill and the Newport and Sherman's Valley Railroad car.

The 5K will be an easier route to enjoy walking around Holman Lake and through the historic district. The 10K includes a more difficult route using the woods trails.

Registration and Fees: These events are Free to those who wish to participate without IVV Credit. IVV Credit is \$3.00 for event credit. No refunds.

Procedure: AVA policy requires that every participant, fee or non-fee, must sign an insurance waiver and obtain a numbered start card which is carried while on the trail. At the end of the walk, the start card is turned in and IVV books are stamped for official credit, if the fee has been paid. The trail may be walked a second time on the same day using the same start card at no additional cost.

Conditions: The events will be held regardless of the weather. There will be no littering. Wildlife and plant life are not to be disturbed. Pets are allowed on the walk. Leash laws must be observed. There are restrooms nearby. Water will be available at the registration area. Hard for wheelchairs and strollers.
