

DIRECTIONS TO START/FINISH LOCATION

Fairland's Clubhouse Building

DIRECTIONS FROM I-95 NORTH/SOUTH

From I-95, take Exit 33 (Laurel/Burtonsville), Rt. 198 West toward Burtonsville. Turn LEFT onto Old Gunpowder Rd. Fairland Sport & Aquatics Complex is 1.5 miles on the Right. Follow signs to Volks-parking behind main building and softball fields, near the Stormwater Management Building.

DIRECTIONS FROM ROUTE 29 NORTH/SOUTH

From Washington area, heading north on Rt. 29 just after the traffic light for Blackburn Rd., take the Exit for Rt. 198 Burtonsville/Laurel. At the end of the exit ramp turn RIGHT at the traffic light. Go 1.5 miles to the 2nd traffic light and turn RIGHT onto Old Gunpowder Rd. Fairland Sport & Aquatics Complex is 1.5 miles on right. Follow the signs to Volks-parking behind main building and softball fields, near the Stormwater Management Building.

From Columbia, heading south on Rt. 29 take exit labeled to Rt. 198 Laurel/Burtonsville. At the end of the exit ramp, go straight through the roundabout. Turn LEFT at the 2nd traffic light - Rt. 198 East onto Laurel. Go 1.6 miles to the 3rd traffic light and turn RIGHT onto Old Gunpowder Rd. Fairland Sport & Aquatics Complex is 1.5 miles on right. Follow signs to Volks-parking behind main building and softball fields, near the Stormwater Management Building.

START/FINISH:

Fairland's Clubhouse Building, 13850 Old Gunpowder Rd., Beltsville, MD 20705. (behind main building and softball fields) See drive directions on back of brochure.

TIMES:

Start time anytime between 9 AM and 12 PM, finish by 3 PM.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION/DISTANCE:

There is a 10-Km trail consisting of two 5-Km loops, both with a rating of 2B. The trails consist mainly of city streets, pathways, some hills and natural surfaces.

ELIGIBILITY:

Walks are open to the public.

REGISTRATION:

The fee for IVV Credit or Non-IVV Credit walkers is \$3.00. Children 12 and under (IVV-Credit included) may walk for free courtesy of Freestate Happy Wanderers. The same trail may be walked for credit twice on the same start card on the same day with no extra charge.

PROCEDURE:

Each participant must register at the start and fill out a start card to be carried on the walk and presented at each checkpoint. Participants must turn in start cards at the Finish Table after completing the event.

CONDITIONS:

Littering along the trails is prohibited. Prince George's County law requires that all pets be leashed and that owners clean up after their pets. The event will be held in all reasonable weather. If weather conditions are uncertain, and travelers' advisories are in effect on the day of the event, please call the contact person listed to obtain up-to-date information on event status.

REFRESHMENTS:

Restrooms, hard candy and water are available at the Start/Finish. Please carry your water bottles on the trail.
