

Information: A Volksmarch is a non-competitive walk along a pre-marked or map/guided route. You may walk, jog, or run, as you desire. It's a great recreational and educational experience for the entire family. Enjoy the scenery, fresh air and time together.

IVV/AVA Sanction: The event in this brochure has been sanctioned by AVA America's Walking Club, a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV) and counts toward the acquisition of IVV achievement awards. This event will take place regardless of weather.

Eligibility: This event is open to everyone regardless of age. An adult must accompany and sign for a minor. Only paid registrants may receive AVA/IVV credit if desired.

Procedures: Register by filling out a start card waiver at the start point. All participants must carry a start card. Return the start card at the completion of the walk.

Health and Safety Guidelines:

- ✓ Feeling sick or have flu-like symptoms? DO NOT ATTEND
- ✓ Bring your own pen to sign waiver and exact cash for fees/donations.
- ✓ Wear a face covering at start/finish.
- ✓ Club will have hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes at start/finish.
- ✓ Maintain 6 feet apart to do our part, otherwise wear a mask.
- ✓ Participant starts may be staggered as necessary to social distance.
- ✓ Carry water, stay hydrated in desert.
- ✓ Sunscreen, hat and loose-fitting clothing recommended.

Fees: IVV Event and Distance Credit is \$3.00. IVV Event Credit may be used only once. For additional distance credit, you may do the walk twice on the same start card. Free walkers are welcome and donations to cover walk expenses are gratefully appreciated. Checks should be made payable to *Las Vegas High Rollers & Strollers*. Exact cash please.

Stipulation: With registration for this walk, the participants accept the guidelines for AVA Volkssport events and agree to observe the principles of good sportsmanship. Littering is prohibited.

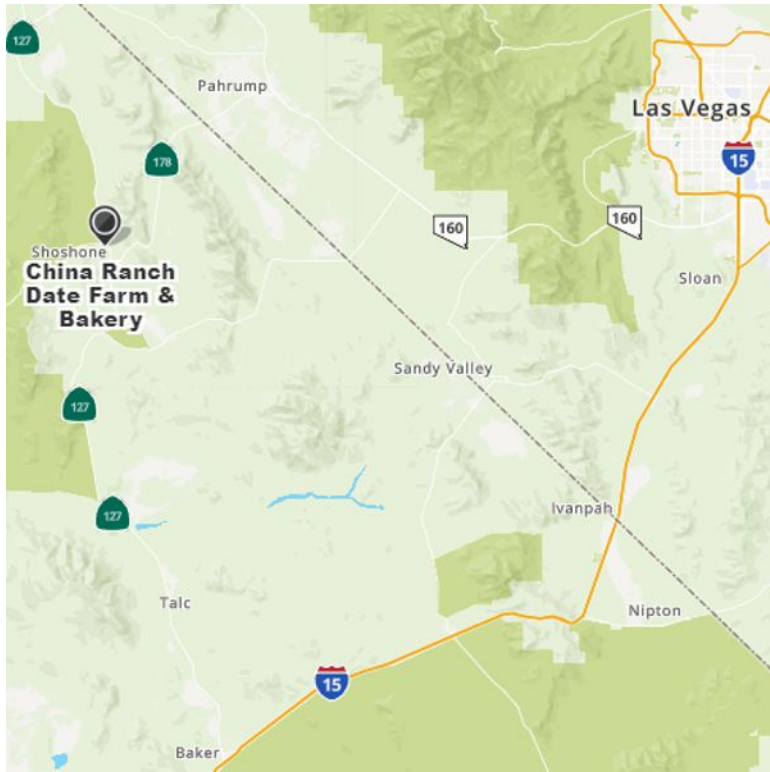
DESCRIPTION: Registration is right across from the store. Our 10k/6k walks go past towering cottonwoods and willows, by a wandering stream and waterfall, and through date palm groves, all hidden away in some of the most spectacular scenery the desert has to offer. You'll enter the south end of Death Valley and enjoy the stillness and quiet you can only get in a true wilderness area. The Old Spanish Trail is nearby, and you'll walk along the historic Tonopah & Tidewater railroad bed. Bring your cameras and keep an eye out for the abundant wildlife.

MISCELLANEOUS: Parking adjacent to the store (food and refreshments available). Water and restrooms at the start. The shorter walk loops back to start/finish. No easy access for wheelchairs/strollers, except near the store. Paths are generally flat, rough desert terrain, either graded or unimproved. Dogs on leashes welcome. Clean up and pack out what you take in.

A limited number of commemorative China Ranch patches will be available for purchase at start/finish for \$3 each.

Driving directions: From Los Angeles (approx. 230 miles) Take Interstate 15 North to Baker. Exit at Baker and take highway 127 north to Old Spanish Trail Highway. Go east on Old Spanish Trail Highway to Furnace Creek Road and turn right. Follow the signs to China Ranch.
From Las Vegas (approx. 77 miles) Take Interstate 15 South to highway 160. Go west (toward Pahrump) to Tecopa Highway. Go west on Tecopa Highway (which becomes Old Spanish Trail Highway in California) to Furnace Creek Road and turn left. Follow the signs to China Ranch.
