TRAIL: John James Audubon Center at Mill Grove is administered by Montgomery County and the National Audubon Society. Its mission is to educate and inspire people to cherish and protect the natural world, by preserving Audubon's artistic, scientific, and historic legacy and celebrating the conservation movement he inspired. On this walk, you will explore Mill Grove, walk several of the area's (mostly paved) trails, visit a rarely seen section of Valley Forge National Historic Park to visit the Pawling Sycamore (a Revolutionary War Witness Tree), and walk past historic Vaux Hill and Saint Gabriel's Hall.

AWARD: The A Award for this walk will be an embroidered patch featuring one of Mill Grove's famous birds.

FEES: \$3 walk fee for credit, \$7 fee for credit plus award. Free walkers are welcome.

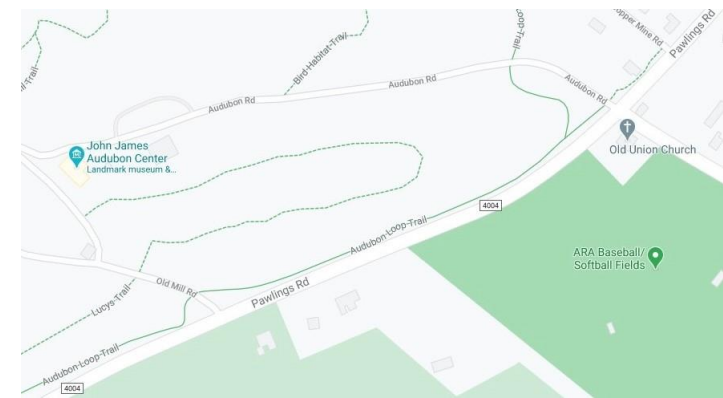

DIRECTIONS AND MAP:



From Route 422 – exit at South Trooper Road heading north and into the left lane. Make an immediate left on Audubon Road, which dead ends into the Mill Grove entrance at Pawlings. If your GPS had difficulty with the street address, try using the intersection and/or Norristown as the town. Parking is available along the Mill Grove driveway and across Pawlings Road at the ARA Baseball Fields beside the Old Union Church.
