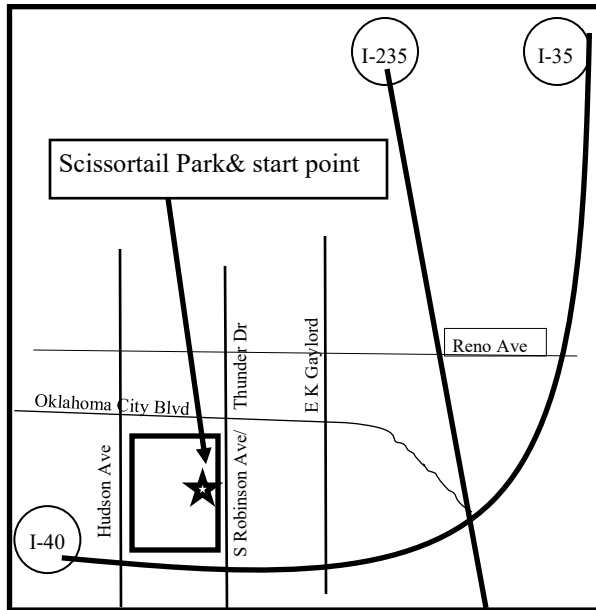


Directions to Scissortail Park. From Tulsa. South on I-44 to I-35. South on I-35 to I-40. West on I-40 to Oklahoma City Blvd, exit 151A. Continue straight (west) on Oklahoma City Blvd to Thunder Dr/S Robinson Ave. The park is on your left (south). From Lawton. North on I-44 to I-40. East on I-40 to exit 148B. Take exit to Oklahoma City Blvd. East on Oklahoma City Blvd to Thunder Dr/S Robinson Ave. The park is on your right (south). The start point is at the Picnic Grove Trellis, off S Robinson Ave, next to the splash pad.

Lat/Long: 35° 27.583 W 97° 30.994

Street parking is free on the weekends and holidays.



## What Is Volkssporting?

Volkssporting started in Germany and simply defined, is a personal fitness sports and recreation program offering noncompetitive walks, hikes, bike rides, swims, and in some regions cross-country skiing. You may choose your time to start within the start/finish “window” and participate in the sport at your own pace.

Walking – also called “volksmarching” – is the most popular of all the volkssporting activities.

Volkssporting in the United States is sponsored by the American Volkssport Association (AVA) which has a nationwide, grass-roots network of about 200 active clubs presenting more than 3,000 volkssporting events each year.

Volkssporting events take place throughout the year, all around the country. Historic and scenic sites are selected for their enjoyment. Trails are carefully laid out and marked and easy to follow directions or maps are provided.

Trails are rated based upon the challenge the route presents. The designated Start Point is open for several hours to allow you to begin your volkssporting adventure at your leisure.

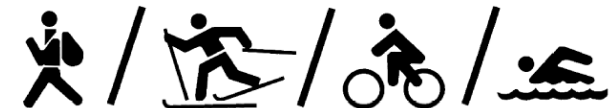

Come join the fun and fellowship, in addition to earning AVA event and distance credits, while walking Oklahoma.

Scissortail Park is part of Oklahoma City's newly created 70 acre city park. The walk route includes the park, Bricktown and Riversport areas.

**Start Point:** Picnic Grove Trellis is on the east side of the park across from the new Oklahoma Convention Center (416 S Robinson Ave) and next to the Children's play area and splash pad.

**Start Time:** 9:00 a.m. - noon. All walkers should finish by 2 p.m. that day.

**Trail:** The route is along paved park trails and city streets.

**Trail Rating:** The 5 km and 10 km routes are rated A1.

**Special Programs:** Walking the United States, Walking the USA A-Z

**Procedure:** All participants must obtain a start card at the registration (start/finish) point. Upon completing the walk, the walker surrenders the card and receives any award or IVV credit earned. All start cards remain the property of Wandergruppe and must be returned even if you do not complete the event.

**Eligibility:** The walks are open to the public. All ages are welcome for this non-competitive walk which you com-

plete at your own pace. An adult must accompany children under the age of 12.

**Event Cancellation:** The walk will be held regardless of weather.

**Sanction credit:** You may participate for free but to receive IVV credit the cost is \$3.00 per walker. **Remember,** bring your IVV record books to record your credit. AVA New Walker Packets will be available for \$6.00 for those wishing to start participation in AVA/IVV award program. These packets contain Distance and Event books, coupons for free walks and other items with the entire packet valued at nearly \$20.00.

**Pets:** Pets are allowed but must be kept on a leash.

**Water** will be provided at the start/finish shelter and any checkpoints.
