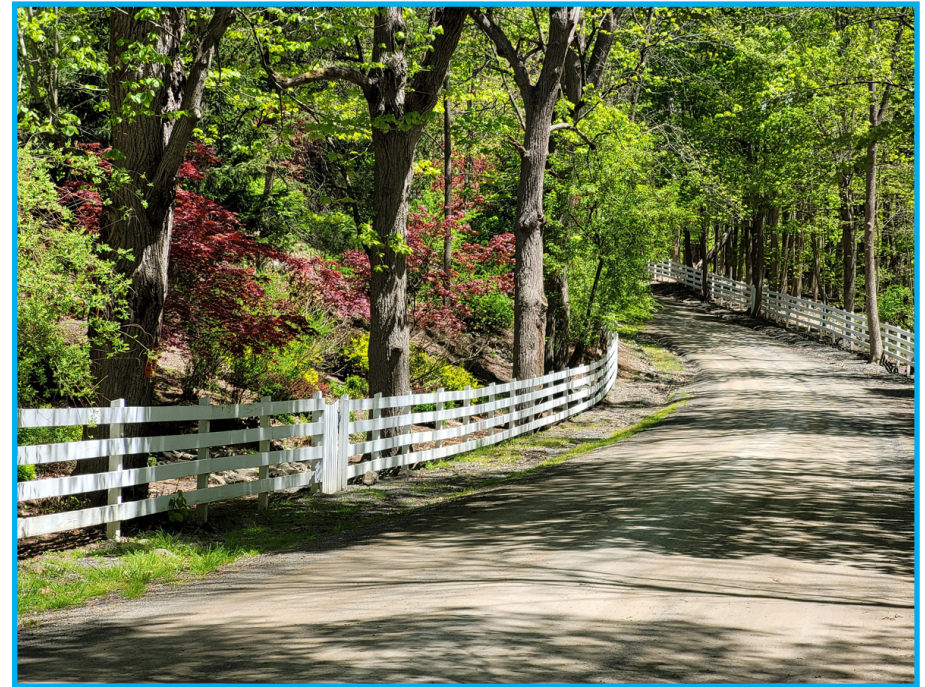
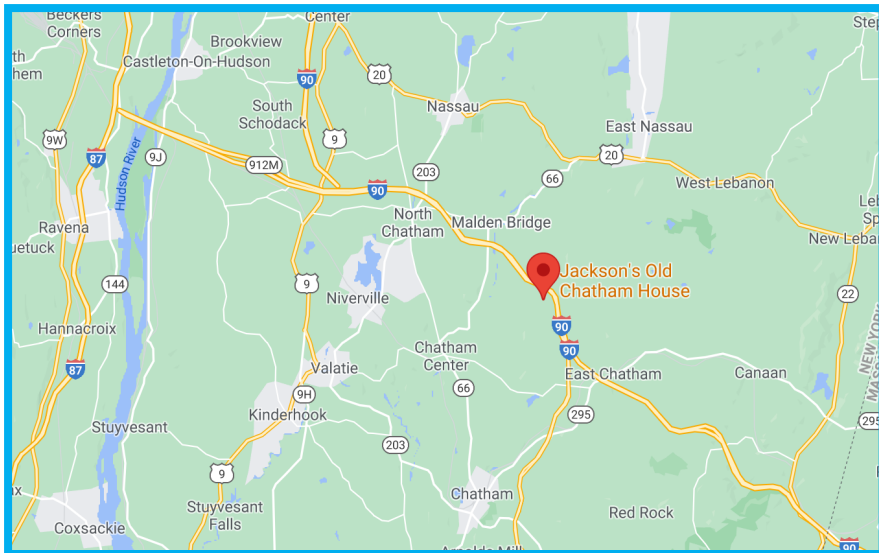


Restrooms on Route not at destination until after walk – Restaurant opens at 11:00 - Walkers are welcome to gather after the walk. Abbreviated menu is attached to the brochure. The food is excellent!

Directions / Parking : From I-87 North or South take I-90 to Exit 12 (Hudson). – 9.5 miles Exit onto US-20 E/U.S. 9 S - Keep left to continue on US-20 E for 4.2 miles ~ (For Restrooms visit Stewarts or Cumberland Farms before turning off Rt 20) ~ Turn right onto Chatham St 131 ft . Turn left onto Malden St 0.5 mi. Continue onto Malden Bridge Rd 1.9 mi. Continue onto Albany Turnpike 1.1 mi Slight left onto NY-66 N 0.3 mi. Continue straight onto Albany Turnpike .

Destination will be on the left 2.1mi Go to the intersection in town and turn left at Jackson Old Chatham Restaurant Park behind the building all the way into the rear parking lot so we do not obstruct patrons.

AVA Rules & Conditions

Start/Finish: Jackson's Old Chatham House, 646 Albany Turnpike, Old Chatham, NY 12136

Start/Finish Time: Start anytime between 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM; finish by 2:00 PM

Trail Rated: 2B for 5K & 10K walks: Walks will be on the wooded trails and paved park roads of this beautiful park in the foothills of the Adirondacks. If the weather has been, or is wet, the trails will probably be muddy. Appropriate footwear should be worn and walking sticks are a plus.

Stipulation: There is no preregistration, and this walk will take place regardless of weather. At the time of registration, each participant accepts the guidelines for AVA Volkssport events. There are no refunds. Pets must be leashed and cleaned up after! Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult and watched carefully, especially near roads and waterways. Not suitable for strollers or wheelchairs.

Procedure: We will follow our current procedure. Print your own Start Card, Event Stamps, directions and maps. Please fill out and sign the Start Card ahead of time and attach the exact change to it. Drop this into a designated container at S/F beginning at 10am. This walk is sanctioned and insured for June 12 ONLY so no later day Start cards can be honored.

Event Fees: All Participants will now pay \$3 .

IVV Books: Event & Distance books will be available at the Start/Finish location for \$6.00 each. Event and Distance Credit may be earned each time the course is completed.

Restrooms/Water: Available at the start/finish after Jacksons opens between 10 and 10:30. Note there is a Stewart's and Cumberland Farms on Albany Ave (not Albany Turnpike) that is 10 minutes before the S/F. Stewart's is first on the left across from Ace Hardware, and Cumberland Farms is where you will make right turn off of Rt 20 onto Chatham St.

Old Chatham is a hamlet in the northeast quadrant of the township of Chatham, located in Columbia County, New York. Founded in 1795, Old Chatham is one of the earliest settlements in the township.

The center of Old Chatham is marked by a few businesses around the intersection of the Albany Turnpike and County Rt. 13.

These businesses include the United States Post Office for area code 12136, the Old Chatham Country Store & Café (check website for business hours), and Jackson's Old Chatham House. Built in 1945 and currently run by a fourth-generation member of the Jackson family, this restaurant serves as our starting point for the day. (See attached abbreviated menu for quick meals available to walkers upon return.) The Old Chatham Shepherding Company is also located in Old Chatham. The Shaker Museum Library on Museum Road has relocated to Mount Lebanon. The rolling hills of Columbia County and the beauty of its country roads lend themselves to a day of interesting walking.
