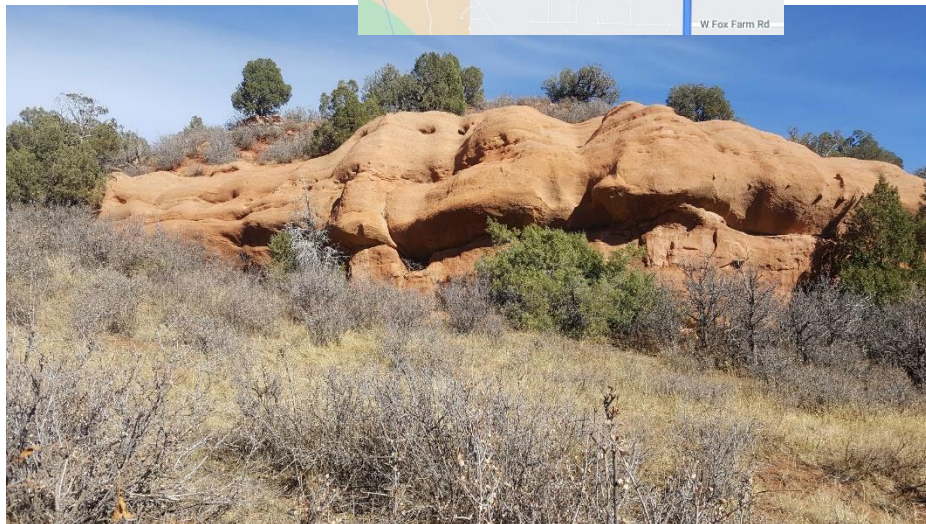
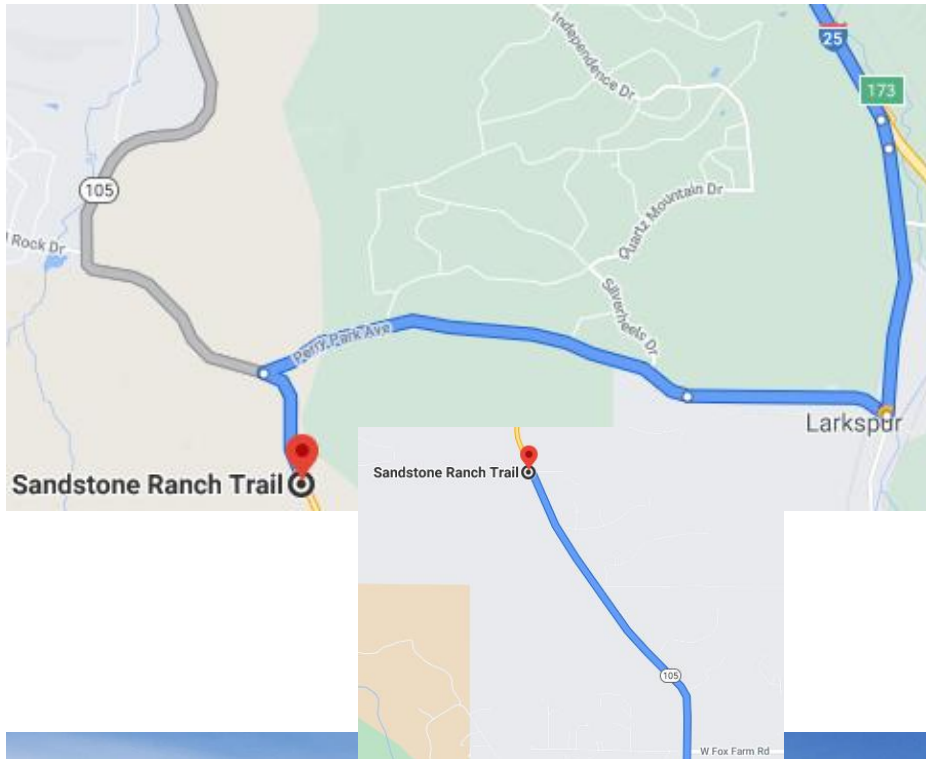

LOCATION: Sandstone Ranch; Douglas County, CO

DATE: May 22, 2021

START TIMES: 9:00 am to Noon

FINISH TIME: 3:00 pm

START/FINISH: Sandstone Ranch Trailhead; 9604 S Perry Park Rd; Larkspur, Colorado

GPS: 39.224862, -104.939621

DISTANCE: 6/11 Kilometers (3.7/6.8 miles).

AWARD: This is an IVV credit-only event.

TRAIL: Walk is rated a "3C". Trail is on nature trails. Strollers with big wheels are welcomed. Carrying water and using sunscreen is highly recommended. Water is available at the start/finish. Please allow *2½ hours* to enjoy the walk.

SPECIAL EVENT:

This 2,038-acre ranch borders the Pike National Forest and features an extraordinarily diverse landscape including red rock formations and sloping meadows; vast wildlife habitat and corridors, expansive and diverse vegetation, and other natural resources; as well as cultural and historic assets, including a historic ranch operation and several historic buildings dating back to its original owners in the 1870s. This RD Special Event is being hosted by the Rocky Mountain Regional Director to highlight the newest Douglas County open space.

DIRECTIONS:

From the north: Take I-25 southbound to Exit 173 for Larkspur. After 1.3 miles turn RIGHT onto E Perry Park Ave. Go 3.2 miles to Hwy 105 and turn LEFT. Turn RIGHT after 3/10 miles to the Trailhead. From the South: Take I-25 northbound to Exit 163 for County Line Rd. Go 2.6 miles to the 'T', turn LEFT on Spruce Mountain Rd, then take an immediate RIGHT onto Perry Park Rd. Turn LEFT after 7.7 miles to the Trailhead. Carpooling is encouraged.
