WELCOME: A VOLKSMARCH is a walking event designed to promote physical fitness, recreation and fellowship. Each participant sets his/her own pace along a well-marked trail. This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV) and is open to everyone. This event counts toward acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards.

DATE: Saturday, July 17, 2021
START TIMES: 6:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. EDT

START POINT: Riverdale Elementary School (back door)
6127 St. Rd. 1, St. Joe, IN
FINISH: No later than 1:00 p.m. EDT

REFRESHMENTS/RESTROOMS: Water and restrooms will be available to all walkers at check points and the start/finish.

REGISTRATION: Credit only is \$3.00.

DIRECTIONS: From I-69 north (Exit 326, CR-11A) turn left. Go to stop sign, then turn right. Continue to first county road (CR- 60, Airport sign), turn left. Follow CR-60 for 9 miles. It goes right into Riverdale Elementary (park in back). From I-69 south (Exit 316, Dupont Rd./SR-1) turn right. Go north on SR-1. Follow for 15.4 miles. School will be on the right (park in back).

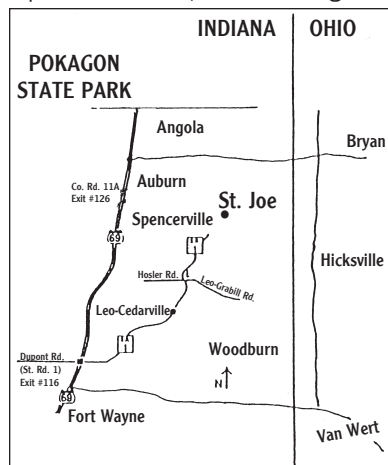
From Toledo/Cleveland take 80/90 west to I-69 south and continue as above from I-69 north.

From Bowling Green take Route 6 west to town of Butler. At SR-1, turn left (south). Continue until you go completely through St. Joe, IN, to Riverdale Elementary on the left (park in back).

From Central and So. Ohio take I-75 north to Route 30 (Exit 135). Go west on 30 approx. 40 miles to Route 49N. DO NOT take 496. At Convoy, go 5 miles to 49 north. Stay on 49N approx. 23 miles. Go through towns of Payne, Antwerp and Hicksville. At stop sign there should be a Caesar's Pizza/Hardee's to the right. GO STRAIGHT. Cross Route 2 – you should be on Spencerville Rd., which changes to Rd. 107 and CR-64. Continue straight across SR-101. Next stop sign will be SR-1. Turn right (approx. 1 mile) to Riverdale Elementary on right (park in back).

From Richmond, IN take 27 north to 33. Turn right (east) at light until town of Pleasant Mills. Turn left on Route 101. Go through towns of Monroeville and Woodburn. After crossing SR-37 into DeKalb County, watch for CR-64. Turn left (west) on CR-64 to next stop sign (SR-1). Turn right on SR-1. Go 1 mile. Turn right at Riverdale Elementary (park in back).

***Parking:** Go north past school 1 block to Jefferson, east 1 block to School St., turn right and PARK BEHIND SCHOOL.



ELIGIBILITY: Persons of all ages are welcomed and may participate. All participants, however, must register at the START table by completing a start card. Registration is FREE for those who do not wish to receive an award. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

PROCEDURE: At the START point, obtain a start card with a number. Proceed to walk the marked course at your own pace. Draw a playing card at start, finish and 3 checkpoints which will be marked on registration card. After completing the course, turn your cards in at the FINISH point to receive your award and/or IVV credit as appropriate. NOTE: All start cards must be turned in upon completion of the course, even if you are unable to complete the course and/or walk for free. Also, cards need to be turned in with telephone number to be eligible for prizes. Door prize winners will receive prize after doing walk. Poker prizes will be distributed by mail and at walking event when the top poker hands are determined.

NOTE: Everyone welcome to participate in walk. Individual FREE walkers will not be eligible for poker and door prizes. Small donations accepted to be entered for prizes. As long as one person per family donates, they will all qualify for giveaways. This applies to a walker who would normally walk FREE. Volunteering to help at the event qualifies for prizes.

AWARD: There are some B awards available: Coaster, Christmas ornaments (pickle, pepper, hot dog, Christmas tree holder and playing cards).

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: The trail goes along the beautiful St. Joe Rivergreenway, county roads to Sechler's Pickle Factory, a park, a memorial park and a cemetery. Could possibly go into a wooded area. The trail is rated 1A. The terrain is mostly level with pavement and grass. It is stroller, wagon and wheelchair accessible on the shorter route which goes along the rivergreenway and back to cemetery (5K). A checkpoint will be at Sechler's Pickle Factory on the longer route. There will NOT be any factory tours this year.

DISCLAIMER: Three Rivers Strollers and the Festival Committee are not liable for accidents, theft or material damage. Every reasonable effort will be made to make the walk safe and enjoyable. Emergency aid will be available. Pets must be kept on leashes and are not allowed inside buildings.
