## Interstate 35 Corridor Walking Weekend

Four volkssporting clubs, Pace Setters, Sunflower Sod Stompers, Tulsa Walking Club, and Wandergruppe of Oklahoma City, are joining forces to provide participants a weekend of walking in communities along the north-south corridor of I-35 in the two adjoining states of Oklahoma and Kansas.

Saturday will be devoted to walking in 2 Oklahoma counties. Wandergruppe is sponsoring a walking event in the historic town of **Guthrie – Logan County**. First known as a railroad station stop, after the [Land Run of 1889](#), it was designated as the [territorial](#) capital, and in 1907 as the first state capital of Oklahoma. Guthrie is nationally significant for its collection of late 19th and early 20th century architecture. The [Guthrie Historic District](#) includes more than 2,000 buildings & is designated a [National Historic Landmark](#).

The Tulsa club's walk will be in **Perry - Noble County**. This community began thru railroad expansion, followed by the Land Rush. This town experienced the presence of numerous saloons, gambling houses, and gangs of bank robbers. Around 1900, a German immigrant, Carl Malzahn, moved to this area. He was a blacksmith who specialized in farming & oil-rig repair. His family business evolved into the Ditch Witch Corporation, largest business in Perry.

The Sunday morning walk, sponsored by the Sod Stompers, will be in the county seat of **Sumner County in Wellington**. This county will complete the southern Kansas border counties. Wellington grew from two agricultural forms – ranching and farming. The town evolved from the Chisolm Trail, and the surrounding land was developed for wheat harvesting.

The final walk for the weekend, sponsored by Pace Setters, will be in **Wichita's Pawnee Prairie Park (Sedgwick County)**. This is a 624 acres park along the Cowskin Creek, which has a variety of plants and wildlife. The park has been designated as a Wichita Wild Habitat area. The Park has over 5 miles of looping walking trails of various surfaces. Pawnee Prairie Park is located in southwest Wichita, adjacent to Tex Consolver Golf Course and Dwight D. Eisenhower National Airport.

For the participants, group meals have been arranged for both Friday & Saturday evenings. Also, motel room blocks have been established. More information provided inside. There will be qualifiers for some of the AVA Special Programs. Come enjoy walking in 2 states in the central part of the United States!

## WHAT IS A VOLKSWALK?

A volkswalk is a leisurely walk through a scenic and/or historic area with written directions. The walk is non-competitive and the participants can travel at their own pace, thus making this an excellent recreational activity for the entire family. ### Map Guided Walks

Distance: 5km/10km

**Location:** Highland Park Pavilion - From OKC take I-35 N to exit 157. From Lawton take I-44 E to I-40E to I-35N exit 157. Turn left on OK-33W/E. Noble St, Right on Drexel St, Right into Park keeping right, then first right to pavilion. From Tulsa take I-244 W to OK-33 W, right on N Drexel St, right into park keeping right, then first right to pavilion.

**Start/Finish:** Start between 9 a.m. – 11 a.m. & 2:00 p.m.

**Courses:** Trails will include the historic downtown area of Guthrie besides residential areas. Paved roads and sidewalks. There are some gradual hills. Restrooms could be limited on course. Trail rating: 1-A

### Map Guided Walk

Distance: 5km/10km

**Location:** This walk will start/finish inside the Noble County Family YMCA at 107 N. 7<sup>th</sup> Street. Perry is 30 miles north of Guthrie. From I-35 Exit 196, go east on US 64 / Fir St. 2 miles, turn right on North 7<sup>th</sup> Street for 0.4 mile. The YMCA will be on the right. Additional parking is across the street.

**Start/Finish:** Start between 10:45a.m.-1:00p.m. & finish by 3:30 p.m.

**Course:** The route will lead through residential areas along with the business areas including courthouse square. Both routes will have some full sun. Walking surfaces will be sidewalks, along with paved and cement roadways. Restrooms will be limited on trails. Trail rating: 1-A

### Map Guided Walk

Distance: 5km/10km

**Location:** This walk will start/finish inside VFW Post 694 – 424 East Harvey. Wellington is 75 miles north of Perry. Use Exit 19 on the Kansas Turnpike & proceed west on US 160 2.6 miles. Travelodge will be on the right, Baymont on left. Turn left on South Woodlawn just beyond Penny's Diner. Go 0.6 mile to East Harvey. Turn right on Harvey, go 0.4 mile. The VFW will be on the left side opposite RR Museum. Park at the Museum.

**Start/Finish:** Start **between 9:00-11:00a.m.; finish by 12:15 p.m.**

**Course:** Both trails will include the historic downtown area of Wellington besides residential areas. Each distance will have portions of full sun. Walking surfaces will be paved roads/streets & sidewalks Trail rating: 1-A

Distance: 5km/10km

**Location:** The walk event will start/finish at Pawnee Prairie Park, 2625 S. Tyler Road. From US 400, W Kellogg Ave, take the Maize Rd exit and go south 2 lights to W Pawnee Street and turn left. Busy Bird Learning Center is on the corner. Take the first left into the parking lot. Event will start at the gazebo. Approximately 40 miles from Perry via I-35 & I-235.

**Start/Finish:** Start between 1:00-3:00p.m. & finish by 5:00p.m.

**Course:** The 5k is mainly on a shady paved path with restrooms at the start point and checkpoint. The 10K has additional distance that is on a mowed grass path. Area of full sun on the trails. Rating: 1B

**Walking Events:** These walking events will be map guided. Participants will be given directions with written descriptions and a map. Walk events are **CANCELLED** if there is severe weather and/or dangerous conditions in the area. Return to the start/finish area ASAP. Event credit will be stamped into your IVV Record Books

**Swims:** Water walk or swim at your pace. Bring your own towels and appropriate swim attire. The pool will be shared with Y members. These swim events will be CANCELLED if there is severe weather conditions. IVV Credit will be given to those present. **No pool fee;** thank the YMCA

**Registration:** IVV Credit will be \$3.00 per event. Signing the AVA liability waiver is required of all participants. No free participants. IVV Record Books may be purchased for \$6.00 each.

**Event Comments:** Although many streets are tree-lined, **be prepared for walking in full sun.**

**Weather:** Weather conditions can quickly change in this part of the U.S. **Be aware of the county that you are in** as weather warnings are issued by counties.
