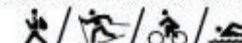

Comments

Chadron State College's trails curve through the natural terrain of Nebraska's Pine Ridge, past pollinator-attracting wildflower beds, water catchments for windbreaks of native trees, and new student housing landscapes filled with high plains low-water-use plants. The Mari Sandoz Heritage Trail, the concrete trail locally known as the "Snake" winds through the Thompson Natural History Preserve and is highlighted by crossing the upper dam at Briggs Pond and coursing to a scenic overlook of the city at the top.
