### Comments

Wyuka is listed on the National Registry of Historic Places and was designed to preserve the rich history of the original grounds. Wyuka (Lakota-to rest) is a nationally recognized historic cemetery and is literally a museum without walls. It features statuary art and monumental architecture, historical tributes to Lincoln families, civil war veterans, ordinary citizens and magnificent memorials to Firefighters, 9/11, Desert Storm, Desert Shield, Purple Heart and the Holocaust. This walk is a memorial to Rose Quackenbush, long time president of the Lincoln Volkssport Club who hosted this walk for many years.
