CENTER POINT, TEXAS is on the Guadalupe River nine miles southeast of Kerrville in southeastern Kerr County and nine miles west of Comfort along SH27. The site became a focal point for business activity when early settler Dr. Charles de Ganahl opened a post office in his home on the north side of the river in November 1859. Ganahl called the post office Zanzenburg in honor of his ancestral home in the Austrian Tyrol. Founded largely by settlers from western Tennessee, the community continued to grow as relatives and neighbors from Tennessee converged on the banks of the Guadalupe.

ROUTE: The two 5km walks (SW22-121258) will include the historic district and the surrounding countryside. The trails includes scenic views of the river and dam (shown above) and walks along a section of the historic Old Spanish Trail. One 5km trail walks through the Center Point Cemetery which has the largest number of burials of Texas Rangers in the state. It has a rating of 1A and is passable for strollers. Wheelchairs may have some difficulty. Participants may complete the walk event twice on one registration. A shorter distance will be available for those unable to complete the full route.

ELIGIBILITY: Volkssporting is a non-competitive sport and welcomes all age groups. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Pets are welcome but must be kept on a leash. Every participant must carry a validated start card and must stop at the checkpoints.

FEES: ALL participants must pay a registration fee of \$3.00. Donations will be accepted to help defray expenses. No pre-registration.

AWARDS: There will be no "A" award for this event. Various "B" awards will be available for a nominal fee. Children 12 and under may choose a patch or pin award free of charge.

DISCLAIMER: The sponsors cannot be held responsible for lost or stolen items, accidents, or injury. All participants must sign a waiver. A reasonable effort will be made to make this event safe and memorable. Event will take place regardless of weather. There will be no refunds.

REFRESHMENTS: Water and fruit will be available at the checkpoints. **Restrooms at the start/finish.**
