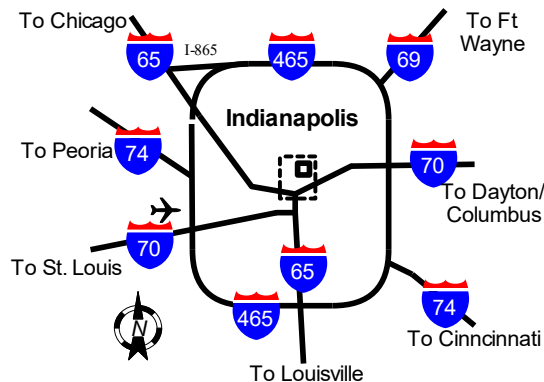


DIRECTIONS: All Saints Episcopal Church, 1559 Central Avenue, Indianapolis, Indiana, 46202 Free parking is available on the nearby streets Please note that the North Split (I-65/ I-70 downtown exchange) is undergoing a massive construction project near the start point. Please consult <https://northsplit.com/> to obtain detours around the impacted approach areas

From the north Take I-65 into downtown Indy to exit 113. Follow exit to Pennsylvania St and turn left (south) going under the interstate to 11th Street. Left (east) on 11th Street to Delaware St. Left (north) on Delaware St. going back under the interstate to 16th Street. Right (east) on 16th St to Central Ave. The church is on the SE corner of 16th Street and Central.

From the east, south and west Take I-65/70 to Washington St (exit 111) or Ohio/Michigan St (exit 112A) Follow to College Ave and turn right. At 16th Street, turn left. The church is on the left at Central Ave and 16th Street.

REGISTRATION AND FEES: The event is open to all and everyone is welcome. Awards will be available with IVV credit for a nominal fee. The fee for IVV credit only is \$3.00. There will be no refund for any reason.

AWARD and IVV Credit: This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV achievement awards. IVV record books will be available for purchase at the event. IVV Credit may only be entered into IVV Event or Distance Books.. Participants will also qualify for special program books depicted on the front page

PROCEDURE: This event is open to all. At the **START** point, each walker must register for the event. Those who pay the appropriate fee will get the award and/or IVV credit.

CONDITIONS: This event will be held rain or shine. Children under 12 must be with an adult. Pets must be kept on a leash and under control. Pets are not allowed inside any building. Bring and use a "pooper scooper" .

REFRESHMENT: Water will be available at the START/ FINISH and checkpoints. Restrooms are available at the START/ FINISH and at several locations along the trail.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: The trail will start at the church and wander interesting neighborhoods and historic sights taking 2 separate loops. You can also take a map guided route to the annual Germanfest at the Athenaeum There you can party with German beer, German food and many fun activities This trail rated 1A and will be over level terrain on nearby streets. There is a year round event nearby at White River State Park which you may do after this walk.
