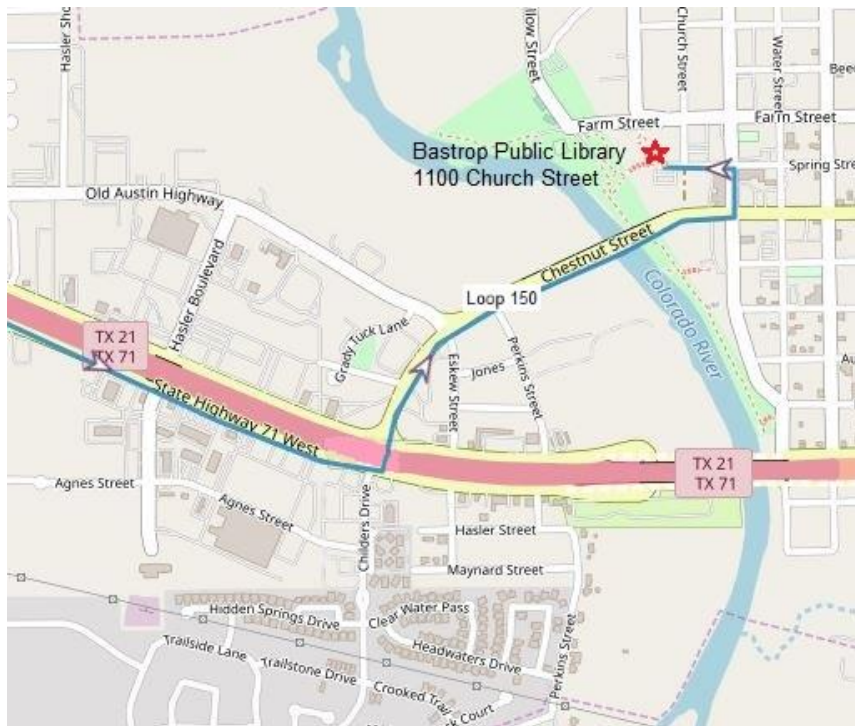


**DIRECTIONS: From Austin:** Go East on SH 71. SH 21 from San Marcus joins SH 71 about 5 miles before Bastrop. In Bastrop, from SH 71 take exit for Loop 150. At second traffic light, go left, under highway, on Loop 150. After crossing the Colorado River bridge turn left onto Main St. Go 1 block on Main, then left on Spring St. which ends at the library public parking lot. **From San Antonio:** Go North on I 35 and at San Marcus Lane take SH 21 which joins SH 71.

Use your GPS to find the best route on the day of our walk.

**ART IN BASTROP:** *Art galleries have long been a reason for people to visit Bastrop, TX, but recently the Art scene has grown and is still expanding. Lost Pines Art Center, The Art Institute of Austin, Lost Pines Art Bazaar, Monarch Art Gallery and Deep in the Heart Art Foundry (renamed Pyrology) are just to name a few. Our walk route will pass many of these establishments. The 10k route will take you out to view the foundry.*

*As you walk along Chestnut St. the Medallions embedded in the sidewalk depict various historical events and buildings as well as the El Camino Real de los Tejas route through Bastrop.*

*Recently, to draw attention to the endangered Houston Toad, the foundry has made a series of 8 small bronze toads. We will walk by some of them.*

**LOCATION Start/Finish:** Bastrop Public Library, 1100 Church St. Bastrop, TX 78602. Please note that parking for this walk is at the public parking lot next to the library. Walkers then walk approximately 0.3 km to the walk start point, where restrooms are available.

**START / FINISH TIMES:** Start between 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m., finish by 2:00 p.m.

**ROUTE:** Both the 5k and 10k routes are rated 1A, and are on well-groomed dirt, crushed granite or cement trails as well as sidewalks and city streets. One long staircase is on both routes. Ask at the start for an alternate route option that doesn't include the stairs, if needed.

**WALK FEES:**

All walkers (Credit or non-credit)       \$3.00  
Non-credit children 12 and under pay \$1.25 to cover AVA fee.

**AWARDS:** "B" awards from previous walks will be available. Children under 12 are eligible for a free "B" award.

**DISCLAIMER:** The Colorado River Walkers are not responsible for accidents, injuries, or any lost or stolen items during the event. Reasonable effort will be made to make this a safe, enjoyable event.

**EVENT CONDITIONS:** The event will be held regardless of weather conditions. All participants must carry a Start Card. Walk route twice on same Start Card for additional distance credit. Events are noncompetitive. Walk, jog, or run at your own pace. Pets are allowed on the trail, but must remain on a leash with owner doing cleanup.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Everyone is welcome. These events are open to all, regardless of age, sex, creed, race or nationality. An adult must accompany children under age 12.

**IVV CREDIT:** This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV) and counts and New Walker Packets may be purchased at the event.

**AMENITIES:** Water and restrooms are available at the Start/Finish and at other places along the route.

**CONDUCT:** Please remember that this event is open to all, including families. Please conduct yourself accordingly.
