

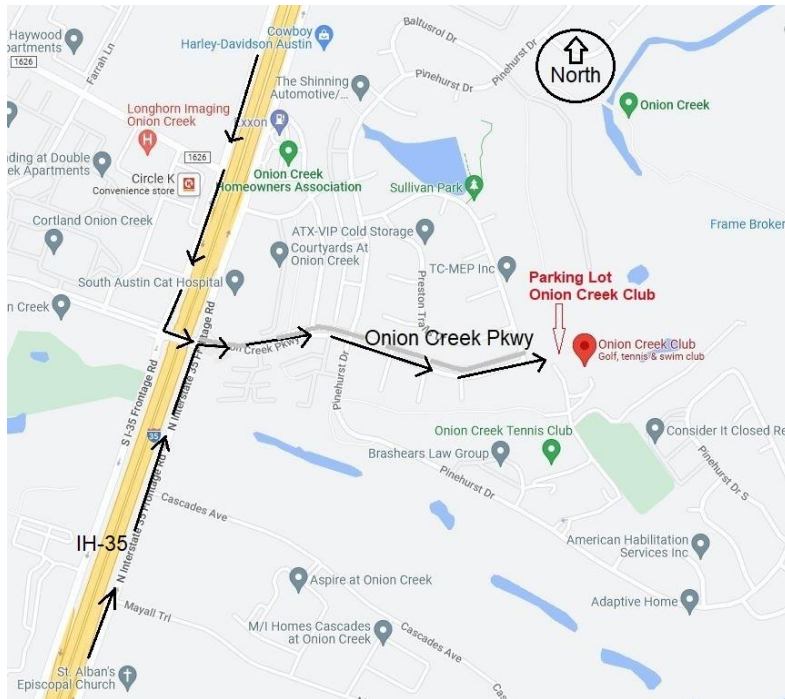
DIRECTIONS: From IH-35:

Start point is Onion Creek Club, 2510 Onion Creek Pkwy, Austin, TX 78747.

Coming from either the north or the south on IH-35, take Exit 225 (Onion Creek Pkwy) onto the frontage road.

From the north, turn Left on Onion Creek Pkwy and cross over IH-35. Proceed on Onion Creek Pkwy until it ends at the Onion Creek Club parking lot.

From the south, turn Right on Onion Creek Pkwy and continue as above.

History of the Onion Creek Club and Golf Course:

The Onion Creek Club was established in 1974 by legendary golfer Jimmy Demaret and Austin native Jimmie Connolly. They laid out the original 18 holes following the lay of the land to create a beautiful course. In the mid 1990's Ben Crenshaw and Bill Coore helped create the additional 9 holes to make the full 27-hole course that exists today. The setting is pastoral and scenic, with rolling green hills, views of the rocky Onion Creek bed, and forested areas between greens.

The **Onion Creek Neighborhood** is a quiet and peaceful community. It is rumored that each street is named after a golf course and building regulations specify that no two houses should be identical.

LOCATION Start/Finish: Onion Creek Club, 2510 Onion Creek Pkwy, Austin, TX 78747. Registration and Start/Finish will be set up at the front entrance to the clubhouse.

START / FINISH TIMES: Start between 8:00 and 11:00 a.m.; finish by 2:00 p.m.

ROUTE: The walk is primarily on neighborhood sidewalks, with a very small portion on streets and park trails. The walk starts at the Onion Creek Club and goes through a neighborhood of lovely homes. The Onion Creek Club golf course surrounds the neighborhood streets, so walkers will have views of the golf course along the route. The walk route is mostly flat, with a few slight hills. Rating for both 10k and 6k is 1A.

AWARDS: "B" awards from previous walks will be available. Children under 12 are eligible for a free "B" award.

AMENITIES: Water and restrooms are available at the Start/Finish and along the route.

FEES:

"B" Award & IVV credit	\$4.00
All walkers (credit or non-credit)	\$3.00
Children under 12 are \$1.25 to cover the AVA fee.	

DISCLAIMER: The Colorado River Walkers are not responsible for accidents, injuries, or any lost or stolen items during the event. Reasonable effort will be made to make this a safe, enjoyable event.

EVENT CONDITIONS: The event will be held regardless of weather conditions. All participants must carry a Start Card. Walk route twice on same Start Card for additional distance credit. Events are noncompetitive. Walk, jog, or run at your own pace. Pets are allowed on the trail, but must remain on a leash with owner doing cleanup.

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone is welcome. These events are open to all, regardless of age, sex, creed, race or nationality. An adult must accompany children under age 12.

IVV CREDIT: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV) and counts toward acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards. IVV books and New Walker packets may be purchased at the event.

CONDUCT: Please remember that this event is open to all, including families. Please conduct yourself accordingly.
