

Directions:

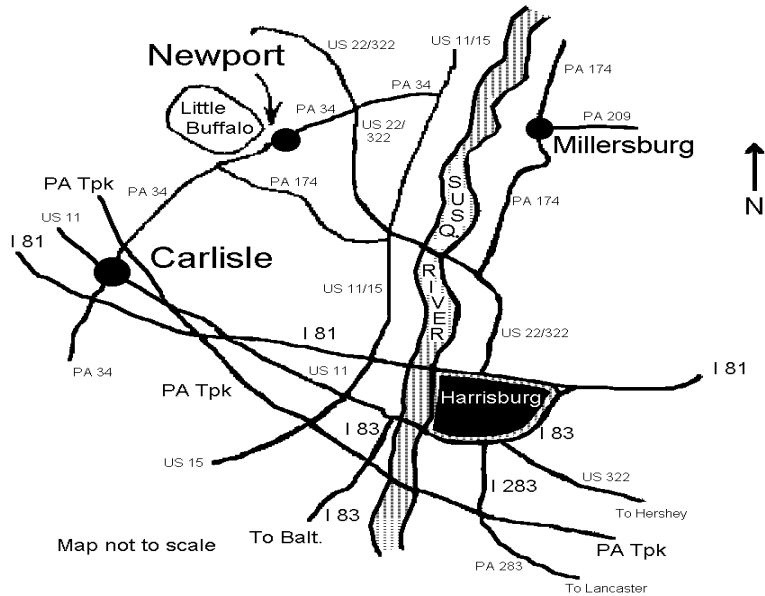
From State College: Take SR 322 East to Newport Exit.

From Harrisburg: Take SR 322 West to Newport Exit.

At Newport exit, turn onto SR 34 South toward Newport. Stay on PA 34 through town. Turn Right onto Little Buffalo Road. Drive past the first park entrance (Address Shown) to the second entrance. Turn left onto Swimming Pool Road. Follow the signs to the parking lot for the pavilions. If you miss the sign, you can park in the swimming pool lot. Pavilion #2 is between the two parking lots. NOTE: Google does not show Pavilion 2 only 1. They are beside each other.

Parking: There is plenty of free parking.

After registering, you will drive 2 miles to the other side of Holman Lake to walk the 5K.

Walk Start Time: 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. Finish by 4:00 pm.

Eligibility: Everyone is welcome to participate. Walk at your own pace. Runners are welcome. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult.

Trail: Louise Clouser designed the first year round event in PA here at Little Buffalo State Park. Come stroll down memory lane as you walk past the Blue Ball Tavern, Clay's Covered Bridge, Shoaff's Grist Mill and the Newport and Sherman's Valley Railroad car.

The 5K will be an easier route to enjoy walking around Holman Lake and through the historic district. The 10K includes a more difficult route using the woods trails.

Registration and Fees: These events are Free to those who wish to participate without IVV Credit. IVV Credit is \$3.00 for event credit. Children 12 and under may walk for credit, but Susquehanna Rovers will pay for their walk.

Procedure: AVA policy requires that every participant, fee or non-fee, must sign an insurance waiver and obtain a numbered start card which is carried while on the trail. At the end of the walk, the start card

is turned in and IVV books are stamped for official credit, if the fee has been paid. The trail may be walked a second time on the same day using the same start card at no additional cost.

Conditions: The events will be held regardless of the weather. There will be no littering. Wildlife and plant life are not to be disturbed. No refunds. Pets are allowed on the walk. Leash laws must be observed. There are restrooms near by. Water will be available at the registration area. Hard for wheelchairs and strollers.

Louise was known by everyone. She brought volksmarching to central Pennsylvania by being a founding member of the Rovers and KSVA. She also helped to form the Nittany Nomads in State College. She developed many, many Volksmarches - many were through farmers fields and woods. She walked in all 50 states and was an inspiration and driving force for our sport. She did like to stay warm.

Louise was a pilot, a teacher, and a philanthropist. She was born on a farm in Perry County and received a bachelor's from Shippensburg University and a master's from Penn State. She taught school in England, Japan, Puerto Rico, Harrisburg and at Quantico Marine Base in Virginia.
