**Walk 1:** Bartlesville (50 miles North of Tulsa): Register at Holiday Inn Express & Suites, located at 4016 SE Price Road, Bartlesville, OK 74006. Phone: 918-766-0020 Call to confirm hours. Drive to Start Point listed on map.

**Walk 2:** Mannford/Lake Keystone: Start/Finish point is the Park Store just inside the entrance to the park. Store hours vary with season. Please call the Park Store, phone: 918/865-4477, to confirm the Store will be open for your visit.

**Walk 3:** Tulsa/LaFortune Park: Start/Finish point Tandy Family YMCA, 5005 S. Darlington Avenue (East of Yale on 51<sup>st</sup> Street; the "Y" is on your left). Open 5:00AM to 9:30PM Mon. thru Fri; Sat.7:30 AM to 6:30 PM; Sundays, open 1:00PM to 6:00PM. Phone: 918/280-9622.

**Walk 4:** Tulsa/Promenade Mall: Start/Finish point Mall Customer Service Desk inside mall, corner of Yale Ave. & 41<sup>st</sup> Street. Store phone is 918/627-9282, ext. 0. Call Desk for open hours before going.

**Walk 5:** Tulsa/Utica Square: Start/Finish point Walgreen's Drug Store, 1714 S. Utica Square at 21<sup>st</sup> St & Utica Ave. Walk down to dusk. Store Phone: 918/743-9968.

**Walk 6:** Tulsa-Jenks/River Parks Trails: Start point address is 2738 E 91<sup>st</sup> St., located at corner of 91<sup>st</sup> & Delaware (between Harvard & Riverside) Tulsa, OK. Register at Fiesta Mart (918/299-8131), and then drive a short distance to trailhead at 96<sup>th</sup> & Riverside Drive. (Please let business customers go first.)

**ELIGIBILITY:** This event is open to the public and all are welcome to participate. This is an excellent activity for families. Children under age twelve must be accompanied by an adult.

**LOCATION OF EVENT:**

**From Tulsa:** Travel East on Broken Arrow Expressway (OK-51); it will turn into Muskogee Turnpike (tolls apply). Take the Exit for Wagoner (State Highway 51) and turn Left (East) and proceed to Hulbert. The event is located at the pavilion of Hulbert City Park, located on Main Street (State Highway 51) in Hulbert, OK. Follow TWC signs.

**From OKC:** Go East on I-40 to Highway 69 and go North to Wagoner. Turn Right (East) onto State Highway 51 and proceed to Hulbert. Follow Tulsa directions.

**I-44 Going West:** Take Exit for Highway 69 and proceed South to Wagoner. Turn Left (East) onto State Highway 51 and proceed to Hulbert. Look for TWC signs.

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This is a 10K/5K event rated 1A. It is rated hard for wheelchairs and medium for strollers. Pets on leash are allowed, and Restrooms are available at the startpoint.

**START/FINISH TIMES:** The event will take place on Saturday, June 17, 2023, rain or shine. Start time **9:00 AM until 11:00 AM.** Finish by **1:00 PM.** No refund will be available for non-completion of event.

**PROCEDURE:** All participants must obtain a start card at the registration (start/finish) point and present this card at all check points along the route, even if no fee is required. Upon completing the walk, the card is surrendered, and the participant then receives any award or IVV credit earned. Remember to bring your IVV record books to record your credit. Record books are for sale at the event.

**AWARDS AND FEES:** "Credit only" is \$3.00 No fee is charged if IVV credit is not desired.

**FACILITIES:** Water and restrooms will be available.

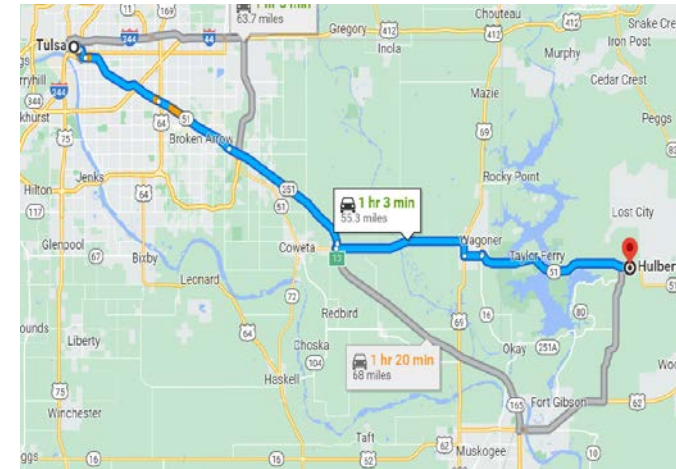

Volkssporting events include walking, biking, swimming and cross-country skiing. A volkswalk or a volks-bike is an organized, leisurely walk or bike through a scenic, historic or interesting area over a predetermined route. Swims are usually held in pools, though some are held in natural bodies of water. Cross-country skiing is held in the northern and/or mountainous areas of the country. Volkssporting is designed to appeal to people of all ages. The walk, bike, swim or ski is non-competitive. Participants can travel at their own pace, thus making it an excellent recreational activity for the entire family. A volkssporting event is a great way to meet new friends and a fun way for individuals to exercise.
