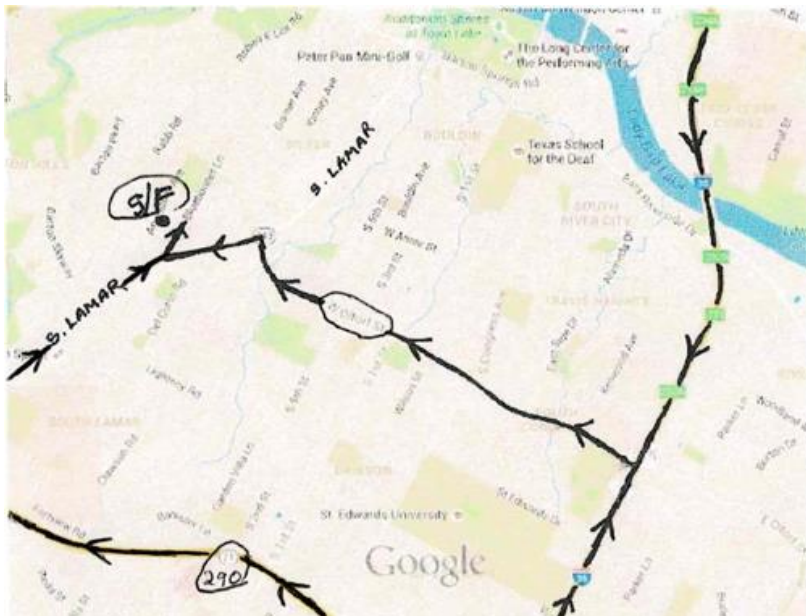


**DIRECTIONS: Driving North on I 35:** Take exit 230 for 290/71 WEST. Drive about 3 miles to exit Right for S. Lamar. Drive 1 mile to turn L on Bluebonnet.

OR Take exit 232A (Oltorf St.). Turn Left (West) on Oltorf and drive about 2 miles on Oltorf, to dead end at S. Lamar. Left on S. Lamar about 0.4 miles to the red light at Bluebonnet. Right on Bluebonnet.

Left on Rabb Glen to park at rear of Communities of Christ Church.

**Driving South on I 35:** Take exit #232A (Oltorf St.). Turn Right (West) and \* (see above).

**DESCRIPTION:** Both the 10k and 6k routes take you through this artistic, older (vintage 1920's), and economically diverse Zilker neighborhood of South Austin. You will pass the homes of 2 artists and a purple martin sanctuary. The 10k route continues on through parts of Zilker Park and past the Umlauf Sculpture Garden.

Some walkers may plan a visit to the garden after the walk, as it opens at noon.

**LOCATION Start/Finish:** Community of Christ Church, 2132 Bluebonnet Lane, Austin Tx. 78704

**START / FINISH TIMES:** Start between 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.; finish by 2:00 p.m.

**ROUTE:** The 6k option route is rated "1A" and is on sidewalks or quiet neighborhood street surfaces. The 10k route continues with slight elevation changes and some irregular natural surface walking making it a "2B"

**AWARDS:** "B" awards from previous walks will be available. Children under 12 are eligible for a free "B" award of their choice.

**FEES:**

"B" Award & IW credit \$4.00

All walkers (Credit or non-credit) \$3.00

**DISCLAIMER:** The Colorado River Walkers are not responsible for accidents, injuries, or any lost or stolen items during the event. Reasonable effort will be made to make this a safe, enjoyable event.

**EVENT CONDITIONS:** The event will be held regardless of weather conditions. All participants must carry a Start Card. Walk route twice on same Start Card for additional distance credit. Events are noncompetitive. Walk, jog, or run at your own pace. Pets are allowed on the trail, but must remain on a leash with owner doing cleanup.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Everyone is welcome. These events are open to all, regardless of age, sex, creed, race or nationality. An adult must accompany children under age 12.

**IW CREDIT:** This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IW) and counts toward acquisition of IW Achievement Awards. IW books may be purchased at the event for \$6.00.

**AMENITIES:** Water, will be available at the Start/Finish and at checkpoints along the route. Restrooms are located at both start/finish and along The route.
