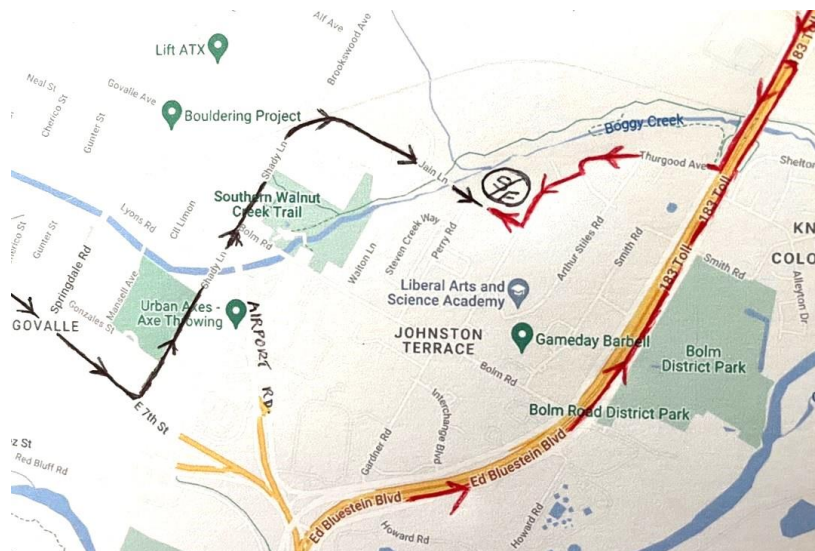


DIRECTIONS: Driving North/South on I 35: Go East on 7th St. for about 4k. After crossing Springdale Rd, next light is Shady Ln. Left on Shady Ln and cross Airport Blvd at light. Continue straight on Shady Ln, crossing Bolm Rd. Stay on Shady Ln as it curves right and becomes Jain Ln. After crossing Boggy Creek bridge, see large building at left with flag in front. Park in lot on right side of building, as Garza Community Center is at rear.

Driving North/South on US-183 Hwy (free, not toll): Turn right on Thurgood Ave, which is only accessible when traveling south on 183. (If going North on 183, make U-turn just north of Thurgood on Bolm Rd/Techni Center Dr overpass.) From Thurgood turn left onto Lotus Ln. Right on Gardner Rd, Right on Jain Ln. Enter 1st parking lot on right.

DESCRIPTION: The walk consists of two 5K routes. One circles East from the start point through a neighborhood, under US-183 Hwy, to Urban Roots East Austin Farm and back by the Southern Walnut Creek Trail running alongside Boggy Creek. The second 5K walks West through a neighborhood to Govalle Park, and then uses MoKan (Missouri-Kansas Rail) Trail to access the art scene along Springdale Rd. The last section is along the Southern Walnut Creek Trail.

LOCATION: Start/Finish: Victor R. Garza Community Center, 6002 Jain Ln, Bldg D, Austin, TX 78721. From Jain Ln, use parking lot to right of the building to proceed to S/F at rear.

START / FINISH TIMES: Start between 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.; finish by 2:00 p.m.

ROUTE: One 5k option route is rated "1A" and is on sidewalks or quiet neighborhood street surfaces. The second 5k route continues with slight elevation changes and some irregular natural surface walking, making it a "2B."

AWARDS: "B" awards from previous walks will be available. Children under 12 are eligible for a free "B" award of their choice.

FEES:

"B" Award & IW credit \$4.00

All walkers (Credit or non-credit) \$3.00

DISCLAIMER: The Colorado River Walkers are not responsible for accidents, injuries, or any lost

or stolen items during the event. Reasonable effort will be made to make this a safe, enjoyable event.

EVENT CONDITIONS: The event will be held regardless of weather conditions. All participants must carry a Start Card. Walk route twice on same Start Card for additional distance credit. Events are noncompetitive. Walk, jog, or run at your own pace. Pets are allowed on the trail, but must remain on a leash with owner doing cleanup.

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone is welcome. Events are open to all, regardless of age, sex, creed, race or nationality. Adult must accompany children under 12.

IVV CREDIT: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV) and counts toward acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards. IVV books may be purchased for \$6.00 and new walker packets for \$10.

AMENITIES: Water will be available at the Start/Finish and at checkpoints along the route. Restrooms are located at both S/F and along route.
