After passing over the South Platte River, turn right at the first traffic light which is Leota St. On your left is Kwik Stop, you can turn left into the fueling area and drive around the east side of the store to get to the parking lot on the north side of the building.

The walk goes across and along the South Platte River; through parks; and past architecturally historic homes, a children's museum and the North Platte Canteen located along the main rail line of the Union Pacific. The Canteen and citizens of North Platte hosted over 6 million GIs during WWII as they passed through! Complete this interesting walk by viewing historic St. Mary's Hospital, the Neville Center, the Pawnee Hotel and a fire station. The Old Lincoln Highway is part of this route, as is a western mural reminding you that you are "Out West". Primarily on paved walkways, sidewalks and streets.
