

Directions to the 7-Eleven Chevron

The 7-Eleven Chevron is located on Pat Booker Road near the intersection of IH-35 and Loop 1604.

FROM IH-35 North or South Bound and Loop 1604 East Bound:

Exit at Pat Booker Road, Universal City. Drive east on Pat Booker Road crossing under Loop 1604. At the second traffic light (Athenian Road) turn left and and the 7-Eleven Chevron station will be on your immediate left.

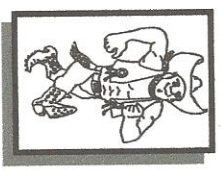
FROM Loop 1604 West Bound:

Exit at Pat Booker Road and turn right on Pat Booker Road to the first traffic light (Athenian Road). Turn left and the 7-Eleven will be on your immediate left.

Universal City began when three doctors bought farmland in late 1929 in speculation that the future military airfield (Randolph AFB) would attract businesses and homeowners. Developer Aubrey Milner named the tract Universal City in 1931 to recognize what he hoped would be the universal importance of the neighboring airfield. Randolph Field opened on October 25, 1931. Pat Booker Road, the main street of Universal City was named in honor of Air Corps captain and San Antonio native Francis P. "Pat" Booker, a pilot who served at Randolph and was later killed in an airplane crash at Maxwell Field, Alabama. In March 1960 voters approved incorporation to preclude annexation by neighboring San Antonio. On September 6, 1960 the city council officially adopted the Texas code that made it a general law city. 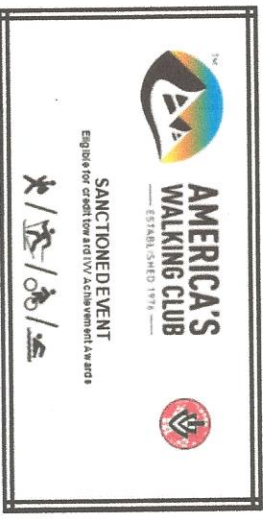

Come Join the Texas Wanderers for a Walk.....

The **TEXAS WANDERERS** of Fort Sam Houston, AVA-006, an organization which promotes family sports is the sponsor of this walk event. This event has been sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV). Everyone is welcome; however an adult must accompany children under 12. Everyone can walk, jog, or run at their own pace. All participants must register, sign a waiver and carry a validated start card at all times.

START - 7-Eleven Chevron Station, 3100 Pat Booker Road, Universal City, Texas 78148. (See map on back of the brochure) After registration drive approximately 2 miles to Northview Park, 100 Randolph Plaza, Universal City, TX 78148. Event is available daily from dawn to dusk. Registration may also be accomplished through the AVA Online Start Box (OSB) at my.ava.org. If you register through the OSB, be sure to report event completion through the OSB.

FEES - The fee for registered walkers is \$3.00 and will include IVV credit. All participants are required to register. There will

be no preregistration and no refunds.

PETS - welcome but must be on leash at all times. Please scoop the poop.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION - The trail, rated 1A, will consist of 5 KM and 10 KM distances on city sidewalks and park trails in Universal City. The trail is not recommended for wheelchairs but is suitable for strollers and wagons.

Please stay on the designated trails and do NOT pick any of the plants or remove any objects from their place. Water and restrooms are available at Northview Park. Water is not available on the trail and it is recommended that you carry water. Restrooms are available on the trail. There are several eating establishments along the trail. This is a credit only event. All start cards must be mailed in at the completion of the event. Event and distance credit may be earned each day you participate in the event without limit. The \$3.00 fee must be paid each time you walk if you want credit. "B" award patches are available for \$1.00.

Please bring your IVV RECORD BOOKS. This event will count towards IVV achievement

awards. IVV insert cards will be available.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS—This event qualifies for the AVA Walking with America's Veterans and Little Free Libraries special programs.
