

Directions to the Dollar General

FROM IH-35 North or South Bound:
 Exit at O'Connor Road /Wurzbach Parkway. Drive west on O'Connor Road to the second traffic light and the entrance to Wurzbach Parkway and continue straight onto Wurzbach Parkway. Exit Wurzbach Parkway at Nacogdoches Road and go south 1/2 miles to the Dollar General on the right.

FROM Loop 410 East or West Bound:
 Exit at Nacogdoches Road and drive north on Nacogdoches Road for 2 miles to the Dollar General on the left.

Salado Creek Greenway is part of a 23 mile-long linear park system being developed by the San Antonio Parks and Recreation Department throughout San Antonio.

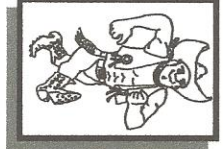

Come Join the Texas Wanderers for a Walk

The **TEXAS WANDERERS** of Fort Sam Houston, AVA-006, an organization which promotes family sports is the sponsor of this walk event. This event has been sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV). Everyone is welcome; however an adult must accompany children under 12. Everyone can walk, jog, or run at their own pace. All participants must register, sign a waiver and carry a validated start card at all times.

START - Dollar General, 10331 Nacogdoches Road, San Antonio, Texas 78217. (See map on back of the brochure) After registration drive approximately 1/2 mile to the Lady Bird Johnson Trailhead in Lady Bird Johnson Park, 10700 Nacogdoches Road. Store hours are 8:00 AM to 9:00 PM daily, however walk must be completed before dusk. Registration may also be accomplished through the AVA Online Start Box (OSB) at my.ava.org. If you register through the OSB, be sure to report completion through the OSB.

FEES - The fee for registered walkers is \$3.00 and will include IVV credit. All participants are required to register. Children under 12 not walking for IVV credit may

walk for free. There will be no preregistration and no refunds.

PETS - welcome but must be on leash at all times. Please scoop the poop.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION - The trails, rated 1A, will consist of 5 KM, 10 KM & 15 KM distances entirely on the Salado Creek Greenway. The trails are not recommended for wheelchairs but are suitable for strollers and wagons. Trails may be subject to some flooding after heavy rains.

Please stay on the designated trails and do NOT pick any of the plants or remove any objects from their place. Water is available at the start/finish and on the trail, however, it is recommended that you carry water. Restrooms are available at the start/finish and on the trail.

This is a credit only event. All start cards must be mailed in at the completion of the event. Event and distance credit may be earned each day you participate in the event without limit. The \$3.00 fee must be paid each time you walk if you want credit.

Please bring your IVV RECORD BOOKS. This event will count towards IVV achievement awards. IVV insert cards will be available. **SPECIAL PROGRAMS** - The McAllister Park event is eligible to earn "credit" to any IVV/

AVA fee paying participant who may be participating in the **Airports—Celebrating America's Flight and Walking with America's Veterans** special programs.

The Tobin Park event also qualifies for the Texas Volkssport Association (TVA) **Texas Historic Landmarks** special program (15 KM distance only).
