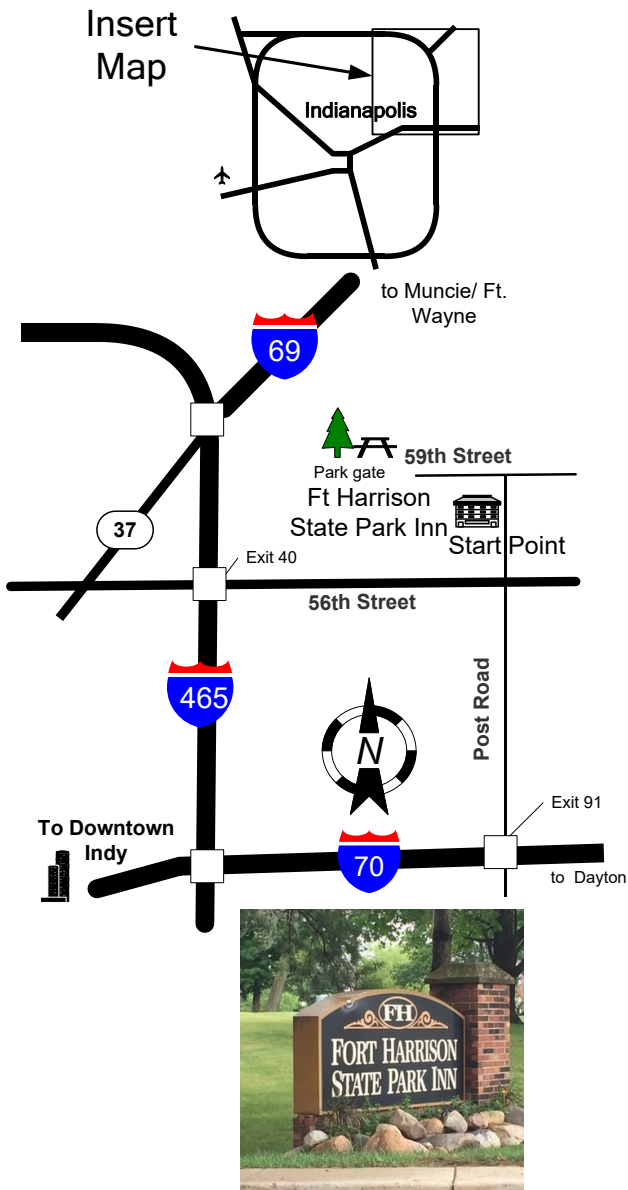


**Directions to
Fort Harrison State Park Inn**
5830 North Post Road, Indianapolis, IN 46216.

From I-465 on east side of Indianapolis take exit 40 (56th Street). Follow 56th Street east to Post Road for approximately 2 1/4 miles. Turn left on Post Road to the Inn on the left just before 59th Street. Register at the Inn and drive to trailhead to start the walk. The start box is kept at the front desk at the Inn.

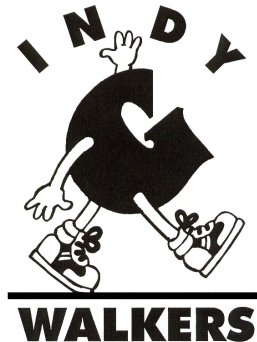

WHAT IS A VOLSMARCH?

A volksmarch is literally a "folk's walk" or walk for the people. This form of exercise allows a person to participate at their own pace with friends and family over a marked course of usually 10 kilometers (6.2 miles) or more.

START FINISH TIMES:

The events are open from dawn to dusk.

REGISTRATION:

Register at the Inn. The start box is kept at the front desk at the Inn. You will take a map and instructions with you and drive to the trailhead to start the walk.

TRAIL DESCRIPTIONS AND RATINGS:

The trails are mostly on natural paths and some park road surfaces. It wanders through rolling wooded terrain and past a picturesque reservoir..

The trails are not adequate for wheel-chairs, strollers or wagons. The trail is rated **2B** on the AVA scale which indicates some moderate hills and stair climbing on well groomed trails.

AWARD AND FEES:

Park Fee : All participants must pay the current admission fee at the park gate on most days of the year. An annual pass to all DNR properties is available for both in and out-of-state visitors

Award: A special 2¼ inch die cast medal header with a state park bar for Ft Harrison State Park attached is shown on the front page. Additional bars for other state parks, recreation areas and lakes may be added to form a chain. The award fees are:

Medal with bar & IVV credit \$13.00
Property bar only & IVV credit \$8.00
IVV credit-only \$3.00.

You may walk for free if no award or IVV credit is desired. There will be no refunds.

CONDITIONS:

These events are held regardless of weather. Children under 12 must be with an adult. All pets must be on a leash and under control. No pets are allowed in the buildings and you must clean up after your pets. There are no refunds for any reason. Trail are rated on the AVA alpha-numeric scale that measures the level of difficulty of elevation and terrain.

PROCEDURES:

These events are open to all. A start card must be filled out and turned in upon completion of the event. A map and instruction are provided in the start box. Those who pay the correct fee will be due the award and or IVV Credit. The award will be given at the completion of the event or mailed.

You can walk only during the daylight hours.

All participants are cautioned to take care and restrain pets and children.. By registering for any of these events, the participant agrees to these conditions.

REFRESHMENTS/RESTROOMS:

Water and restrooms are available along the trail. We strongly suggest you carry water as well.

IVV CREDIT:

IVV Credit will only be entered into IVV Event or Distance Books. Only one credit may be entered in the Event Book per day, Distance credit may be entered in the Distance Book each time you complete the event. There is no charge for a rewalk if completed on the same day.



LARGE GROUPS/BUSES:

Please let us know in advance if you plan to walk these events as a group. We will have a club member meet you and help with the paperwork.
