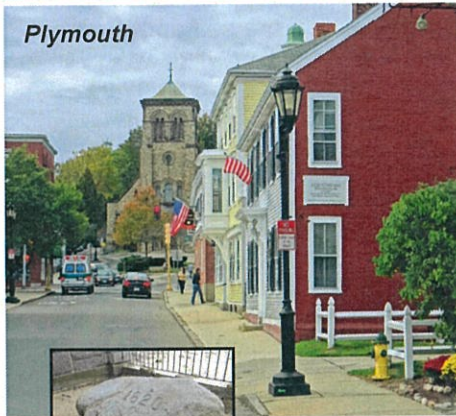

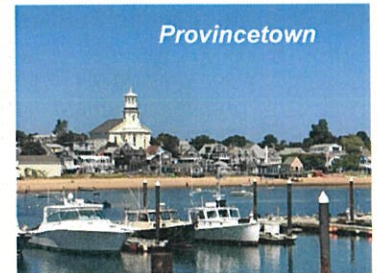

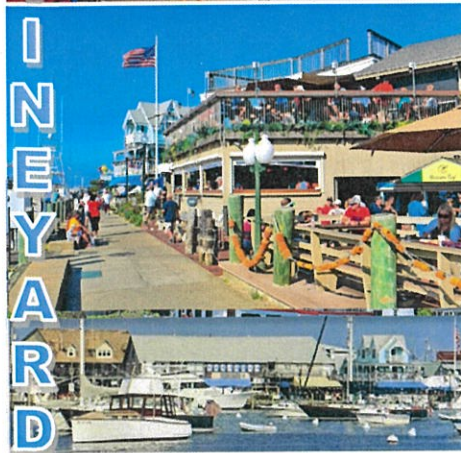

CAPE COD, MASSACHUSETTS

Featuring Martha's Vineyard

4 Days - 3 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1** Depart from Pennsylvania and travel to Cape Cod, MA. The Cape extends 70 miles into the sea and is home to both natural beauty and quaint colonial villages. Arrive in **Sandwich** for the **Olde Cape Cod Walk** which is either 6K or 10K. Afterwards, you will depart for the Bayside Resort to check in and relax before enjoying dinner on your own in the area.
- Day 2** After a hot continental breakfast, travel northward along scenic Route 6A (*the Old King's Highway*) which winds through colonial villages filled with wonderful examples of New England architecture. You will view the Eastham Windmill and a Cape Cod Lighthouse and drive through the **Cape Cod National Seashore** area. You will also stop at the Visitor's Center. You will be surrounded by sand dunes and the ocean as you approach your final destination at the tip of Cape Cod, **Provincetown**, which was formerly known as the "Province Lands" when the Pilgrims landed here before deciding to settle across the Bay in Plymouth. Provincetown has a rich history which combines a love of the sea and the arts. While in Provincetown, you will **Walk in the Birthplace of American Liberty** which is either 6K or 10K. Afterwards, return to your hotel to relax and freshen up before departing for a delicious dinner on your own.
- Day 3** Following a hot continental breakfast, depart with your guide on the Hy-Line ferry from Hyannis to Oak Bluffs - **Martha's Vineyard**, one of the most popular New England seashore resorts. Upon arrival you will have a guided **sightseeing tour** and free time to explore the towns of Oak Bluffs and Edgartown at your own pace. Return to the mainland via ferry to enjoy dinner on your own on the Cape.
- Day 4** Your day begins with a hot continental breakfast, then check out and depart for a visit to America's hometown, **Plymouth**, where you will **Walk in the Footsteps of the Pilgrims**, either 5K or 10K. Later, you will visit the **Plimoth Patuxet** (*formerly the Plimoth Plantation*) for a visit. Later, you are free to explore Plymouth's sites on your own, including **Plymouth Rock** (*the traditional site of disembarkation of the Pilgrims in 1620*), the **Mayflower II** (*a reproduction of the ship that brought the Pilgrims to the New World*) and the **Forefather's Monument** (*the largest, solid granite monument in the United States.*) After your visit, bid farewell to Cape Cod as you depart for home with lasting memories of your trip to Cape Cod.
