In case of emergency : Dial 911

Start/Finish point: The Truman Home Ticket Center, 219 N Main St, Independence MO. There is a parking lot across Main St at the corner of Main St & Truman Road. Restrooms are available inside the Truman Home Ticket Center (as of 6/2/2020 the ticket center is not currently open). There are many convenience stores along Noland Rd if you are coming north from I-70.

Directions: From I-70 take the Noland Road exit and go north on Noland Road 3.3 miles to Truman Road. Turn left on Truman Road 2 blocks to N Main St and turn left. Take the 1st right into the parking lot.

Special Programs: Walking the USA A-Z – ("I"), Rockin' Around the Clock (Jackson County Courthouse). Walk qualifies for Jackson County in the MO County booklet.

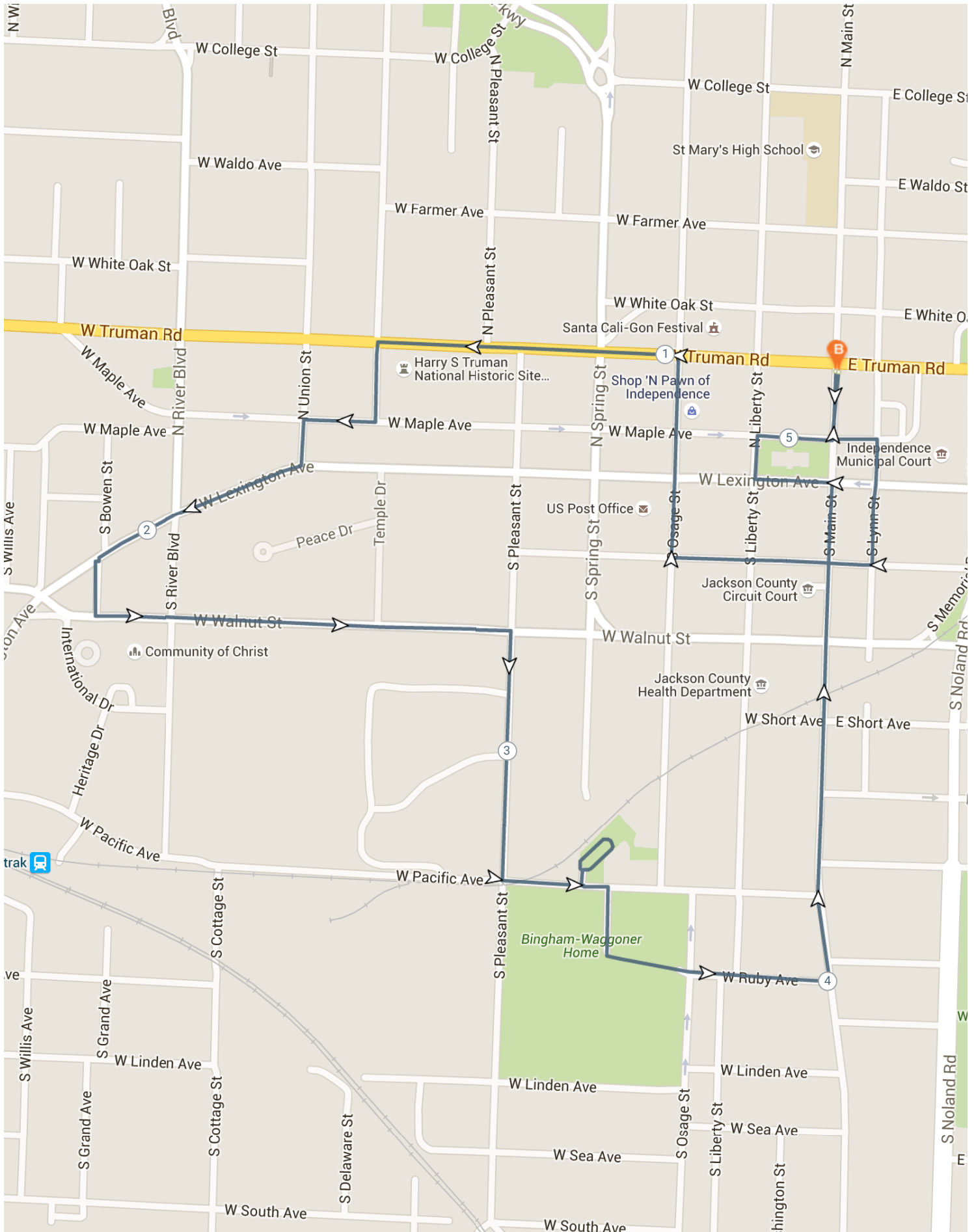
In the downtown area and along Delaware, watch for plaques on the ground with historical information.

1. Left on Main St *passing the 1859 Jail*
2. Left on Maple Ave
3. Right on Lynn St
4. Right on Kansas Ave *passing the Log Courthouse* between Main & Liberty on the left
5. Right on Osage St
6. Left on Truman Rd several blocks to the *Truman Home*
7. Left on Delaware St walking between *the Truman Home & Noland Home*
8. Right on Maple Ave
9. Cross then left on Union St
10. Right on Lexington Ave *passing The Stone Church*
11. Cross S Bowen, Turn left & cross Lexington, then immediately cross S Temple
12. Turn right into Peace Plaza and circle statue
CHECKPOINT
13. Return to S Temple and turn right
14. Left on Walnut St *passing the Community of Christ Auditorium, Temple & Visitor Center*
15. Cross S Pleasant and turn right *passing Overfelt-Johnston house*
16. Left on Pacific Ave
17. Turn left into *Chicago & Alton 1879 Railroad Depot*. Walk on left side & loop through area.
18. Return to Pacific & cross street and walk up driveway through the parking lot of the *Bingham Waggoner Estate*. Turn left on the bricks between the buildings.
19. Bear right on the dirt driveway behind the house & exit crossing Osage St onto W Ruby Ave *passing Bess Truman's birth place*
20. Left on Main St
21. Left on W Lexington Ave
22. Right on N Liberty
23. Cross maple & turn right. *Note Clinton's Soda Fountain where Harry Truman had his first job*
24. Cross Main & turn left to finish

Start/Finish point: The Truman Home Ticket Center, 219 N Main St, Independence MO. There is a parking lot across Main St at the corner of Main St & Truman Road. Restrooms are available inside the Truman Home Ticket Center (as of 6/2/2020 the ticket center is not currently open). There are many convenience stores along Noland Rd if you are coming north from I-70.

Directions: From I-70 take the Noland Road exit and go north on Noland Road 3.3 miles to Truman Road. Turn left on Truman Road 2 blocks to N Main St and turn left. Take the 1st right into the parking lot.

Special Programs: Walking the USA A-Z – ("I"), Rockin' Around the Clock (Jackson County Courthouse). Walk qualifies for Jackson County in the MO County booklet.

In the downtown area and along Delaware, watch for plaques on the ground with historical information.

1. Left on Main St passing the 1859 Jail
2. Left on Maple Ave
3. Right on Lynn
4. Right on Kansas Ave *passing Log Courthouse between Main & Liberty on left*
5. Right on Osage St for 4 blocks
6. Cross and turn right on White Oak St in front of Hawthorne Bank
7. Turn left on N Liberty *passing Trinity Episcopal Church where Harry Truman & Bess were married, St Mary's Catholic Church, for 4 blocks*
8. After carefully crossing Independence Ave (24 Hwy) turn right on W Moore. *100 W Moore is the birth home of Film & dance star Ginger Rogers*
9. Left on Main
10. Left on Mechanic Ave
11. Right on N Liberty St for 4 blocks passing The Valle Mansion on your left
12. Left on W Jones St for 4 ½ blocks
13. Past the tennis courts, turn left on trail
14. Follow trail to end at 24 Hwy (Independence Ave) *Truman Library is on the left*
15. Go under 24 Hwy on walking south on right side of N Delaware entering the Harry S Truman Historic District
16. Cross Truman Rd passing between the Truman Home and Noland House (restrooms available 8:30 – 5:00)
17. Use the crosswalk in front of the Noland House & turn left back to Truman Rd
18. Right on Truman Rd
19. Right on Spring
20. Cross & turn right on Maple *passing the 1st United Methodist Church*
21. Cross then left on Union St
22. Right on Lexington *passing The Stone Church*
23. Cross S Bowen, Turn left & cross Lexington, then immediately cross S Temple
24. Turn right into Peace Plaza and circle statue.
25. Return to S Temple and turn right
26. Left on Walnut *passing the Community of Christ Auditorium, Temple & Visitor Center*
27. Cross S Pleasant and turn right *passing Overfelt-Johnson house*
28. Left on Pacific
29. Turn left into Chicago & Alton 1879 Railroad Depot. Walk on left side & loop through area.
30. Return to Pacific & cross street and walk up driveway through the parking lot of the *Bingham Waggoner Estate*. 10k skip to # 33

31. *11k option: Continue to the rear left corner of parking lot to the trail. Walk counterclockwise around the trail to view the wagon swales.*
32. *Return to the parking lot and turn right on the bricks towards the house.*
33. Turn left on bricks towards house
34. Bear right on the dirt driveway behind the house & exit crossing Osage St onto W Ruby Ave *passing Bess Truman's birth place*
35. Left on Main St
36. Left on W Lexington Ave
37. Right on N Liberty
38. Cross Maple & turn right. *Clinton's Soda Fountain where Harry Truman had his first job is on the corner of Maple & Main*
39. Cross Main & turn left to finish
