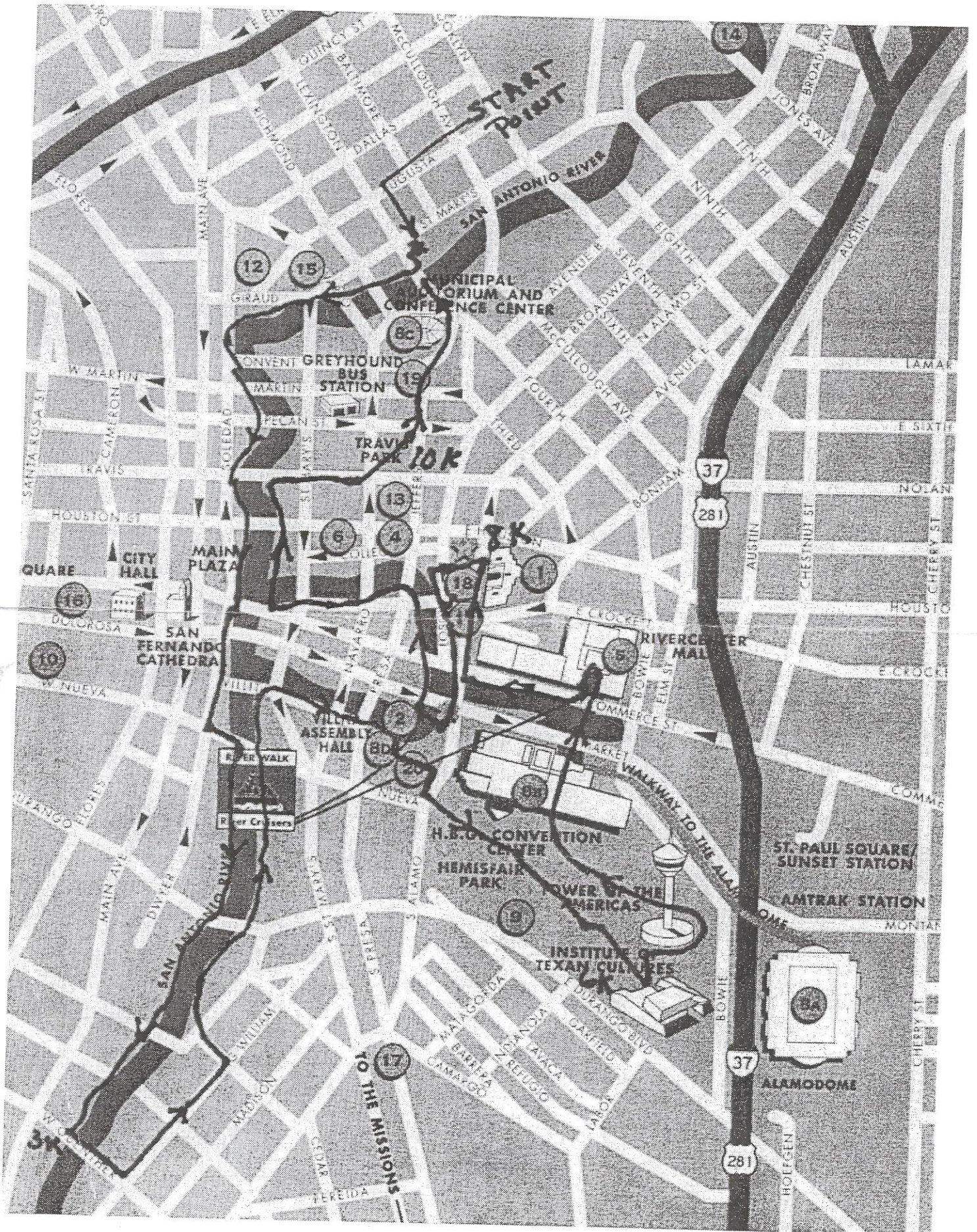


The trail head is located on the 1000 block of Lexington Avenue between St. Mary's Street and Avenue A. There are no restrooms at the start but there are some along the trail. Phone 911 for emergencies. For non emergency information phone Gerry Kamicka at 210-658-2160.

1. Enter the Riverwalk at "Riverwalk" sign across Lexington Ave. from the El Tropicano Hotel. Turn **RIGHT** and walk along the west side (river on your left) of the river and pass to the right of the stairs going up to Commerce St.; continue to the River Park on your right.
2. Turn **RIGHT**. Go up the steps into the Park to street level, which is Main Plaza. Cross Main Plaza to San Fernando Cathedral and Cathedral Center. Turn **LEFT** to light and cross Dolerosa/Market to the Purple Heart Memorial. Turn **LEFT** and pass the front of the Bexar County Courthouse to E. Main Plaza (no street sign).
3. Turn **RIGHT** and walk 2 blocks to Nueva St. Cross Nueva St., turn **LEFT**, walk 1/2 block. Turn **RIGHT** at the river and enter Riverwalk walking around the semi-circle tower, continue on the west bank of the river (river on your left) to just past San Antonio River Authority offices sign.
4. Just before the sign indicating that the area is subject to flooding, go up the steps on the right and turn **LEFT** on Guenther St., go over the bridge and turn **LEFT** on King William St.
5. Continue 3 blocks on King William, turn **LEFT** at Beauregard St. and cross Washington, go through the park to the river. Turn **RIGHT** and go down the ramp and walk along the river toward downtown. Turn **RIGHT** at River Bend and go toward the main developed area of the Riverwalk.
6. Walk along the river until you reach the Arneson River Theater (note the stage across the river on your left and the grass seats on your right). Turn **RIGHT** and go up the steps and through the entrance to La Villita. Turn **LEFT** at first street (no street sign) and walk 1 block to Alamo St.
7. Turn **RIGHT** on Alamo St. and go 1/2 block to stop light. Turn **LEFT** and cross Alamo St. and enter HemisFair Park.
8. Continue straight ahead toward the Tower of the Americas continuing on to E. Nueva. Proceed past the John H. Wood Federal Court House on your right to the Schultze House. Turn **LEFT** at the path just past the Schultze House and follow the path to the Tower.
9. Turn **RIGHT** and proceed through the archway marked "to the Institute of Texan Cultures", go through the parking lot and H. B. Zachry Flag Plaza to the Institute.
10. Go back to the Tower and go **RIGHT** and circle the Tower and exit **RIGHT** onto the main walkway keeping the Convention Center on your right. Turn **RIGHT** at
11. Continue on the Riverwalk with the river on your left. Continue to River Center Mall (pass Marriott River Walk Hotel on your right), turn **RIGHT** and enter the Mall. Walk along the walkway and go all around the lagoon and leave the Mall.
12. Continue on the Riverwalk (with the river on your left) until you come to the Chamber of Commerce (just before Alamo St. crosses the river). Go up the stairs to your **RIGHT**. You are on the corner of Alamo and Commerce Sts.
13. Walk along Alamo St. past the Menger Hotel. This is Alamo Plaza. Visit the Alamo. Walk around the grounds. Restrooms are at the rear of the grounds.
14. Circle the Cenotaph (tall white marble monument to the heroes of the Alamo), cross Alamo St. in front of the Hyatt Hotel. Go down the stairs. Walk through the Hyatt to the Riverwalk.
15. Turn **LEFT**, follow the Riverwalk (with the river on your right) to the Palacio del Rio Hilton Hotel. Just beyond the Hilton doorway with the copper awning, turn **RIGHT** at the bridge and cross the river and turn **RIGHT**. You will walk past many restaurants.
16. Continue on the River Bend portion of the Riverwalk until it joins the main channel. Go **LEFT** up the stairs, turn **RIGHT** at the passageway and cross over to the other side of the river and turn **LEFT** down the stairs. Turn **RIGHT** and walk along the river, crossing under Houston St., and go up the stairs at Travis St. (name is on the bridge). Turn **RIGHT**.
17. Walk 1 1/2 blocks, cross Navarro, turn **LEFT** and cross Travis St. Walk diagonally through Travis Park. Turn **LEFT** at Jefferson St., walk one 1 block to the Vietnam and Korean war memorials. Walk **RIGHT** around the Municipal Auditorium to Fourth St. Turn **LEFT** and return to the start.

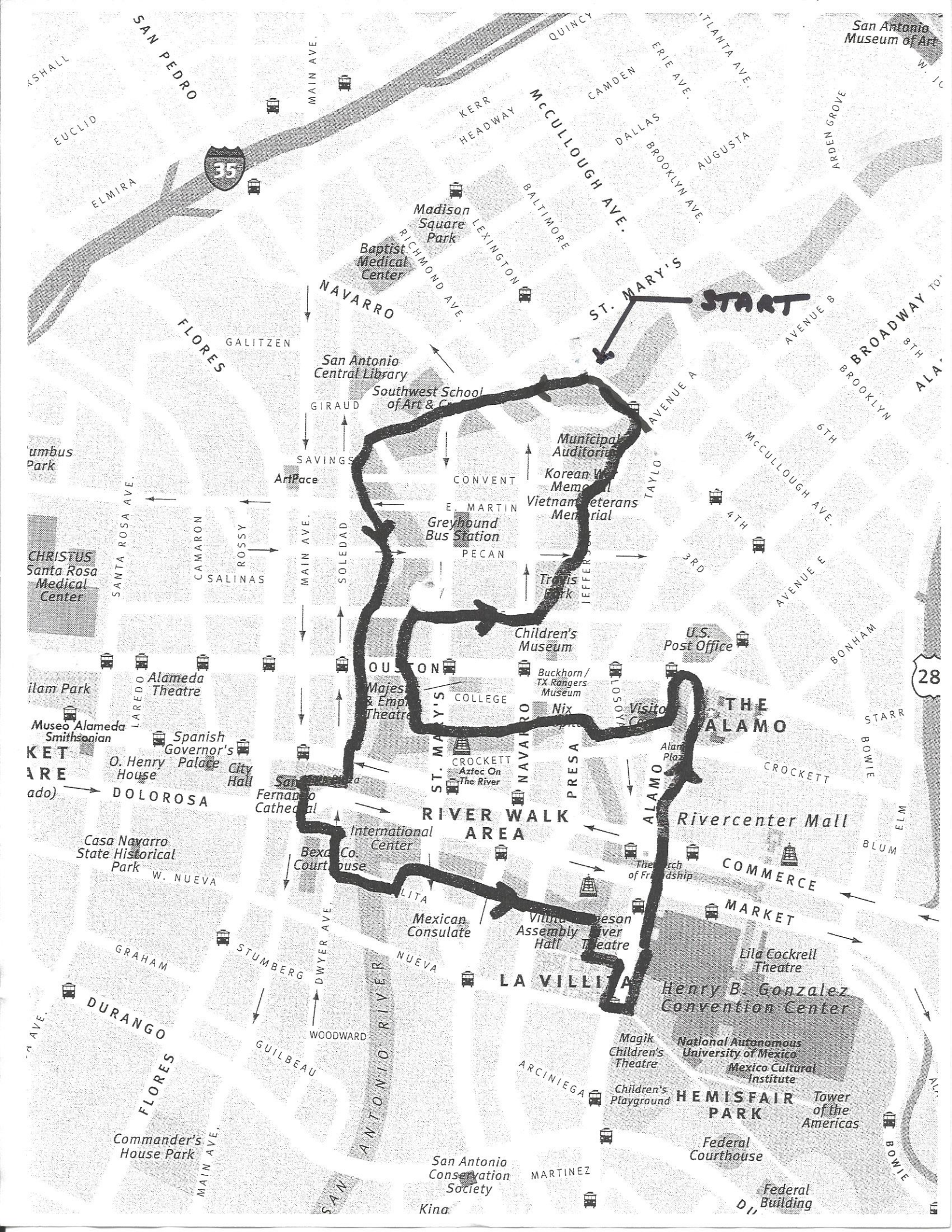

## 6 KM TRAIL

1. Enter the Riverwalk at "Riverwalk" sign across Lexington Ave. from the El Tropicano hotel. Turn **RIGHT** and walk along the west side (river on your left) of the river and pass to the right of the stairs going up to Commerce St.; continue to the River Park on your right.
2. Turn **RIGHT**. Go up the steps into the Park to street level, which is Main Plaza. Cross Main Plaza to San Fernando Cathedral and Cathedral Center. Turn **LEFT** to light and cross Dolerosa/Market to the Purple Heart Memorial. Turn **LEFT** and pass the front of the Bexar County Courthouse to Main Plaza (no street sign).
3. Turn **RIGHT** and walk 1/2 block to Villita St. Turn **LEFT**, walk 1/2 block. Turn **LEFT** at the sign for the Riverwalk and continue to the end of the building. Turn **RIGHT** and go down the stairs to the Riverwalk. Continue straight (with the river on your left).
4. Walk along the river until you reach the Arneson River Theater (note the stage across the river on your left and the grass seats on your right). Turn **RIGHT** and go up the steps and through the entrance to La Villita. Turn **LEFT** at first street (no street sign) and walk 1 block to Alamo St.
5. Turn **RIGHT** on Alamo St. and go 1/2 block to stop light. Turn **LEFT** and cross Alamo St.
6. Turn **LEFT** on Alamo St. and just after crossing Market St. you will see a historical marker. You are on the corner of Alamo and Commerce Sts.
7. Walk along Alamo St. past the Menger Hotel This is Alamo Plaza. Visit the Alamo Walk around the grounds. Restrooms are at the rear of the grounds.
8. Circle the Cenotaph (tall white marble monument to the heroes of the Alamo), cross Alamo St. in front of the Hyatt Hotel. Go down the stairs. Walk through the Hyatt to the Riverwalk.
9. Turn **RIGHT**, follow the Riverwalk (with the river on your left) on the River Bend portion of the Riverwalk until it joins the main channel. Turn **RIGHT** and walk along the river (with the river on your left), crossing under Houston St., and go up the stairs at Travis St. (name is on the bridge). Turn **RIGHT**.
10. Walk 1 1/2 blocks, cross Navarro, turn **LEFT** and cross Travis St. Walk diagonally through Travis Park. Turn **LEFT** at Jefferson St., walk one 1 block to the Vietnam and Korean war memorials. Walk **RIGHT** around the Municipal Auditorium to Fourth St. Turn **left** and return to the start.

## SAN ANTONIO RIVERWALK DRIVING DIRECTIONS AND PARKING INFORMATION

The trail head for the San Antonio Riverwalk events is located on the 100 block of Lexington Avenue between St. Mary's Street and Avenue A.

From I-35 Northbound or Southbound, take the McCullough exit (exit 157B) and proceed to St. Mary's Street. Turn right on St. Mary's Street and go two blocks to Lexington Avenue, turn left for ½ block to the start.

From US 281/! 37 southbound take the McCullough exit (exit 141C) and proceed to St. Mary's Street. Turn left on St. Mary's Street and go two blocks to Lexington Avenue, Turn left for ½ block to the start.

### Parking

On street metered parking is available in the area. Most meters are 2 hour limited meters, however, there are 10 hour limited meters on both Baltimore and Lexington. Check the individual meter for time limits. Metered parking is not enforced on Sundays.

There are also paid parking lots available on Lexington Avenue and nearby Broadway

**WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT** - Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish and complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participants Event Bank until they have submitted event completion information including the date of the event, the distance and the selection of applicable special programs that the person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the users Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a users Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion information as a paying "for credit" participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDR will expire in 60 days.)
