

Biloxi, MS Year-Round Walk – 5 KM

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This map and directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association (AVA) athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

START/FINISH POINT: Biloxi Visitor's Center, 1050 Beach Blvd. Biloxi, MS 39530

From I-10, take exit 46B to I-110 south for 4.4 miles then exit 1B to US 90 W (Beach Blvd.) for .8 miles to the Visitor's Center, on right, across from the Lighthouse.

AVA Special Programs: *Bridges – Spanning the USA; Take a Walk in a City Park; Walking the USA A – Z(B).*

1. START at the Visitor's Center on Beach Blvd. across from the Biloxi Lighthouse.

The Biloxi Lighthouse was built in 1848 and has been kept by female keepers for more years than any other lighthouse in the United States. It was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1973 and declared a Mississippi Landmark in 1987.

2. TURN RIGHT on sidewalk to Porter Ave.

3. TURN RIGHT on Porter Ave., to Howard Ave.

4. TURN RIGHT on Howard Ave. and continue under the I-110 overpass [QUALIFER: Bridges] to Caillavet St.

The Biloxi Fire Museum at 1046 Howard is a 1937 fire house with exhibitions of historic photographs and antique fire equipment documenting the 120-year history of the Biloxi Fire Department.

5. CROSS & TURN RIGHT on Caillavet St.

6. TURN LEFT on Jackson St. one block, **CROSS** Reynoir St. and **TURN RIGHT**.

7. Take Reynoir a short distance to a **LEFT TURN** onto a walking street (Water St. no street sign but look for an AVA sign..)

8. Follow Water St. for 2 blocks to Rue Magnolia

On your right is the Mardi Gras Museum in the old Magnolia Hotel, circa 1847. On the corner at Rue Magnolia is Mary Mahoney's Old French House Restaurant, in the Brunet-Fourchet house, ca 1853.

9. TURN LEFT on Rue Magnolia, to Jackson St.

Around the corner on the right is the Creole Cottage, from 1834.

10. TURN RIGHT on Jackson St. to GE Ohr.

11. TURN RIGHT on GE Ohr to Water St.

12. TURN LEFT on Water St. to Lameuse St.

13. TURN RIGHT on Lameuse St. to Beach Blvd.

14. TURN LEFT on Beach Blvd. to Main St.

On your left is the Biloxi Town Green [QUALIFER: City Park]. Note the Katrina Memorial.

15. TURN LEFT on Main St. to Water St.

16. TURN LEFT on Water St. back to Lameuse St.

17. TURN RIGHT on Lameuse St. to Jackson St.

18. TURN LEFT on Jackson St. to GE Ohr.

CHECKPOINT: What is the name of the house on the corner of Jackson St. and GE Ohr?

19. TURN RIGHT on GE Ohr to Howard St.

20. TURN LEFT on Howard St. for several blocks and back under the I-110 overpass (AVA sign).

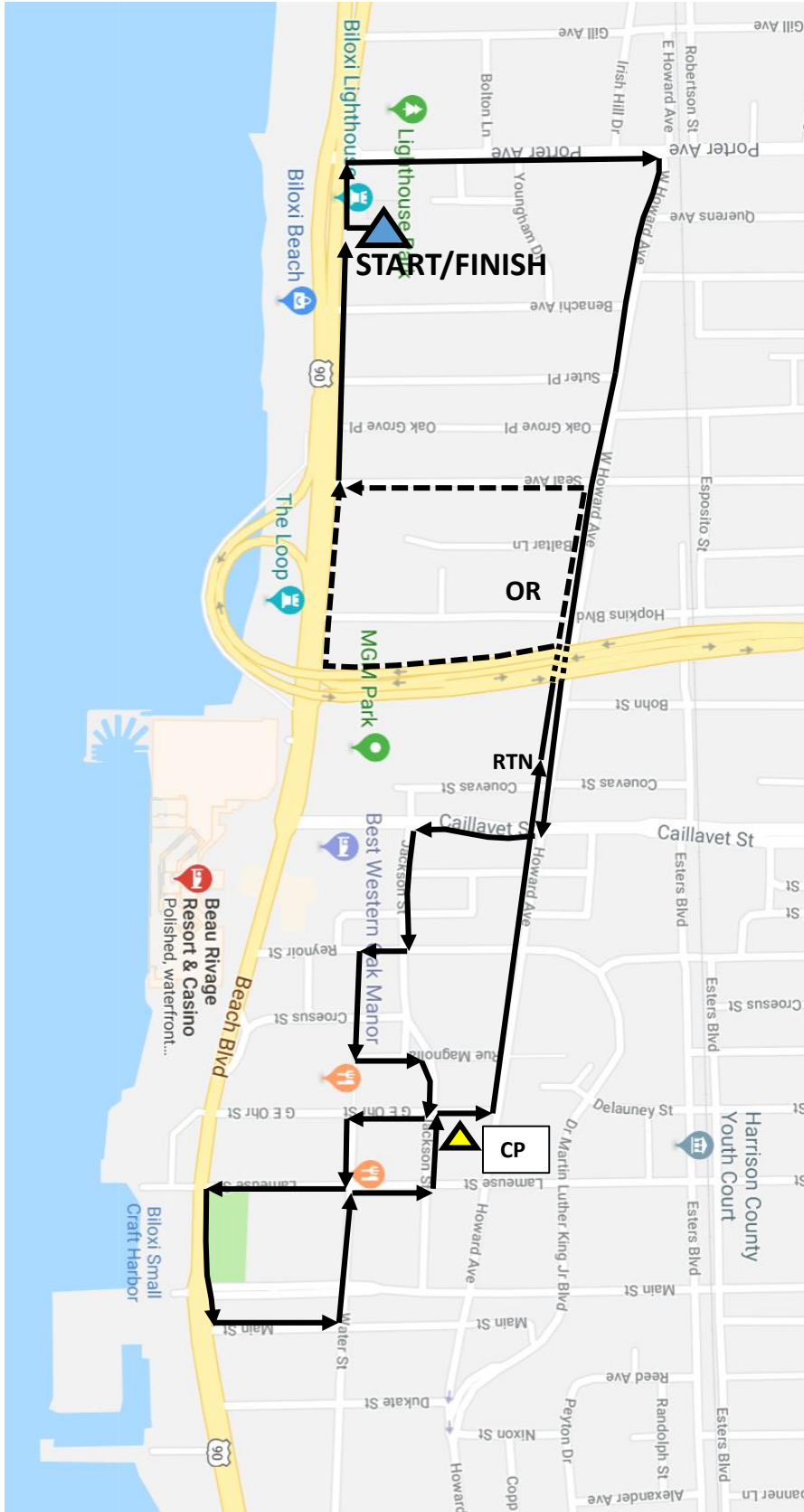
On you right, pass the Saenger Theater (the first talking movie theater in MS) and the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, circa 1902.

21. TURN LEFT at the sidewalk next to I-110, to Beach Blvd. **OR**, continue one more block to Seal St. and turn here, to Beach St.

22. TURN RIGHT on Beach Blvd and return to finish at the Visitor's Center.

Biloxi, MS Year-Round Walk – 10 KM

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1. START at the Visitor's Center on Beach Blvd. across from the Biloxi Lighthouse.

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2. TURN RIGHT on sidewalk and walk several blocks (West) to Chalmers Dr.

3. TURN RIGHT on Chalmers Dr. one block to Father Ryan Ave.

4. TURN RIGHT on Father Ryan Ave. Walk 4 blocks, CROSS White Ave. and continue 2 more blocks to the cemetery.

5. TURN LEFT on Caldwell Dr. Walk through this end of the "Old French" or "Biloxi City Cemetery to Irish Hill Dr.

This is a beautiful cemetery filled with unique and unusual tombstones.

6. TURN RIGHT on Irish Hill Dr. to Gill Ave.

7. TURN RIGHT on Gill Ave. to Bolton Lane.

8. TURN LEFT on Bolton Ave. to Porter Ave.

9. TURN LEFT on Porter Ave. to Howard Ave.

(You will pass the Quave-Lopez Safety Center – there are water fountains, rest rooms and snack machines.)

10. TURN RIGHT on Howard Ave. and continue under the I-110 overpass [QUALIFER: Bridges] to Caillavet St.

11. CROSS & TURN RIGHT on Caillavet St.

TURN LEFT on Jackson St. one block then **CROSS** Reynoir St. and **TURN RIGHT**.

13. Follow Water St. for 4 blocks to Lameuse St.

14. TURN RIGHT on Lameuse St. to Beach Blvd.

15. TURN LEFT on Beach Blvd. for several blocks to Keller Ave.

On your left is the Biloxi Town Green [QUALIFER: City Park]. Note the Katrina Memorial.

16. TURN LEFT on Keller Ave.

CHECKPOINT: *Notice the Historical marker on the right side of the street: what drink was created here in 1898?*

17. TURN LEFT on Howard St. for 3 blocks, to Bellman St.

18. TURN LEFT on Bellman St. to Water St.

19. TURN RIGHT on Water St. to Lameuse St.

20. TURN RIGHT on Lameuse St. to Jackson St.

21. TURN LEFT on Jackson to GE Ohr.

22. TURN RIGHT on GE Ohr to Howard St.

On the corner on your right is the Redding House, built circa 1900.

23. TURN LEFT on Howard St. for several blocks and back under the I-110 overpass (AVA sign).

On you right, pass the Saenger Theater (the first talking movie theater in MS) and the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, circa 1902.

24. TURN LEFT at the sidewalk next to I-110, to Beach Blvd. **OR**, continue one more block to Seal St. and turn here, to Beach St.

25. TURN RIGHT on Beach Blvd and return to finish at the Visitor’s Center.
