The start point is the Federal Hill Commons
 There is free parking at the park which is open from dawn to dusk.

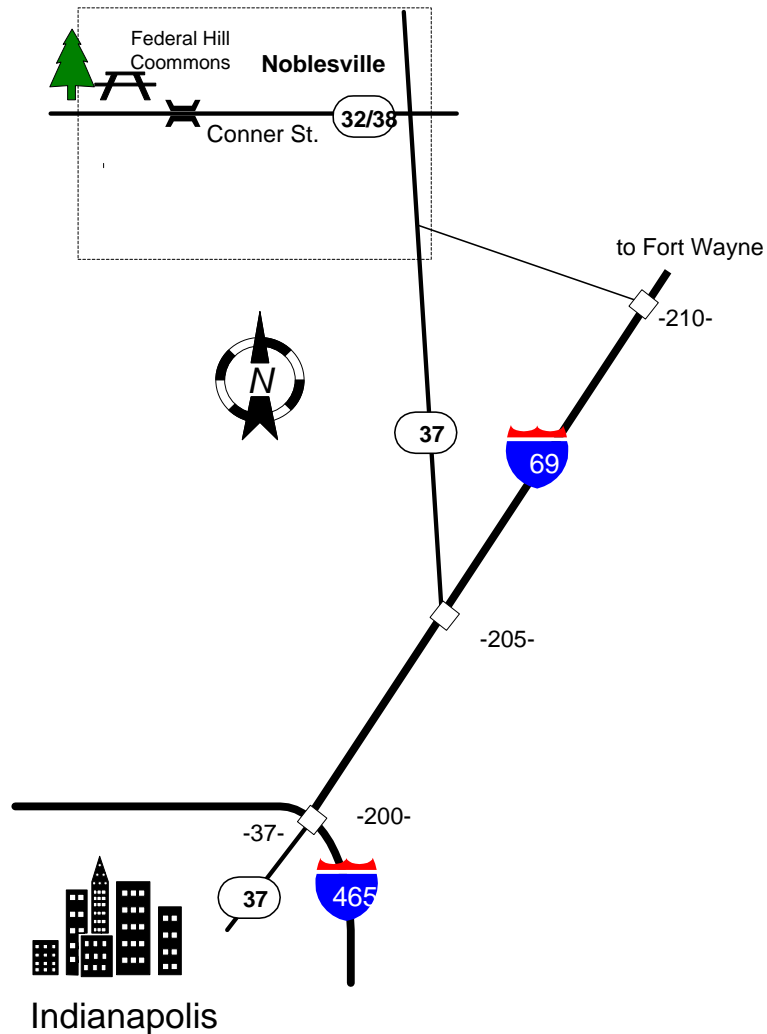
From Indianapolis and the South: From I-465 (on the northeast side of Indianapolis), take I-69 North (exit 37). Follow I-69 North to the Noblesville exit (205 – Noblesville /SR 37) Follow SR 37 North for approximately seven (7) miles to SR 32/38 (Conner Street). Turn left on Conner Street and go 1½ miles to Nixon Street-just past bridge. Right, then right again into the parking lot. on the west side of the park-.

From the North, take I-69 South to Exit 210 (SR 238/Noblesville). Turn right and follow SR 238 West for five (5) miles to SR 37. Turn right (north) on SR 37 approximately 1½ miles to SR32/38 (Conner Street). Turn left on Conner Street and go 1½ miles to Nixon Street-just past bridge. Right, then right again into the parking lot. on the west side of the park- .

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10 K Trail

There are rest rooms available at the start point (1) and in Forest Park (22)

1. Exit parking lot and head toward playground / splash pond area (rest rooms available).
2. R at path heading toward stage. L at path next to stage then L taking the path away from stage leading out of park
3. R at Logan Street. Carefully cross Cicero Rd (SR 19) at crosswalk and cross bridge over the White River.
4. On the other side of the river, take the stairs going down. L on the path by the river
5. Stay on the trail under the bridge (**1 K**), to the end of the parking lot
6. L at sidewalk between bike rack & Veterans Monument next to Riverside Cemetery
7. R at Veterans Monument then walk through opening in iron fence into the cemetery. Continue on the grass a short distance to the blacktop road
8. R on road noting historic gravestones to next intersection. R and loop road going toward the River then back to same intersection.
9. Keep straight on road going out of the cemetery gate (Cherry St.) to 5th Street
10. L on 5th Street and go one block to Maple Street. L on Maple Street
11. Continue straight ahead on sidewalk past the Veterans Monument again to path directly in front of the river.
12. L on walking path keeping the river on your right going past cemetery as it bends to the left and follow to Pleasant Street at Southside Park (**2 K at Division Street**)
13. L at Pleasant Street to 10th Street (**3 K at 6th St.**) Be careful crossing busy 8th Street.
14. Cross 10th Street & turn left (Dairy Queen). Follow 4 blocks to Seminary Park
15. R on diagonal path into park going past gazebo to 9th Street exiting park
16. L on to 9th Street to Cherry Street (1 ½ block).
17. R on Cherry Street to 16th Street. (**4 K at 12th Street**)
18. Cross 16th Street & turn left. Carefully cross Conner St. at crosswalk to Logan Street
19. L on Logan Street to 8th Street (**5 K at 14th Street**) *Checkpoint: What is the name of the ice cream shop at 864 Logan St on the courthouse square?*
20. Cross 8th Street and turn right. Veer slightly left by the blue awning of Bouden's Cleaners and enter the White River Greenway trail
21. Cross the pedestrian bridge over the White River and SR 19 into Forest Park (**6 K**)
22. Continue on path as it winds up the hill, past several playgrounds (*rest rooms available 7K*) to the north end of the park.
23. After crossing the road with a fish image on the crosswalk, you will come to a large metal sign "The Trails and Greenways to Forest Park" L at this trail split
24. Continue on path past shelter, and veer left at the ball fields, across the RR tracks, past the golf course on the right (**8K**), and uphill to the trail head on Lakeview Drive
25. . L on Lakeview Drive (large yellow sign with arrow) on sidewalk to Brown Street
26. R on Brown St to Woodview Drive (1 block)
27. L on Woodview Drive (9K) to Sunset Drive.

28.) L on Sunset Drive to Lakeview Drive.
L on Lakeview Drive to Logan Street...
29. Cross Logan Street at the crosswalk and turn left . Continue to start / Finish on the right.(10.1 K)

6 K trail

1. Follow steps *1 thru 19 above*. At 8th Street, turn left and cross Logan Street
2. Continue on the other side of Logan Street passing the Hamilton County Judicial Center and over the White River Bridge
3. Carefully cross at the crosswalk at SR 19 just past the bridge. L into the park and start/finish (**6 K**)

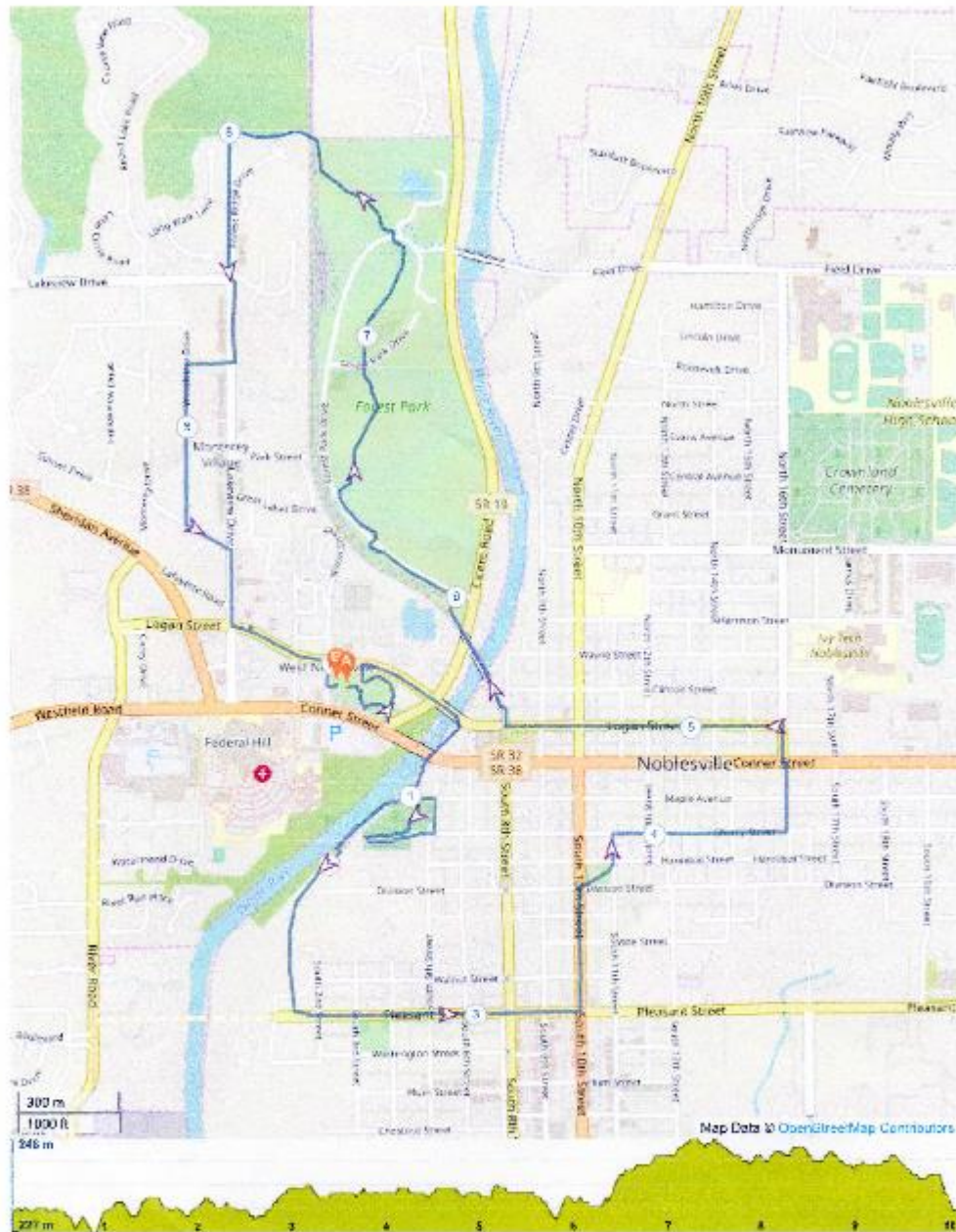
