Driving directions from the west:

Stay on US 12 to Dayton.

US 12 is Main Street in Dayton.

The Weinhard Hotel is on the left.

Park on the street or in the alley between the Weinhard and the Historic Depot.

Driving directions from the east:

Enter Dayton on US 12.

The Weinhard Hotel is on the right.

Park on the street or in the alley between the Weinhard and the Historic Depot.

NOTE: A physical start box is located in the Weinhard Hotel.

NOTE: Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. DO NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. 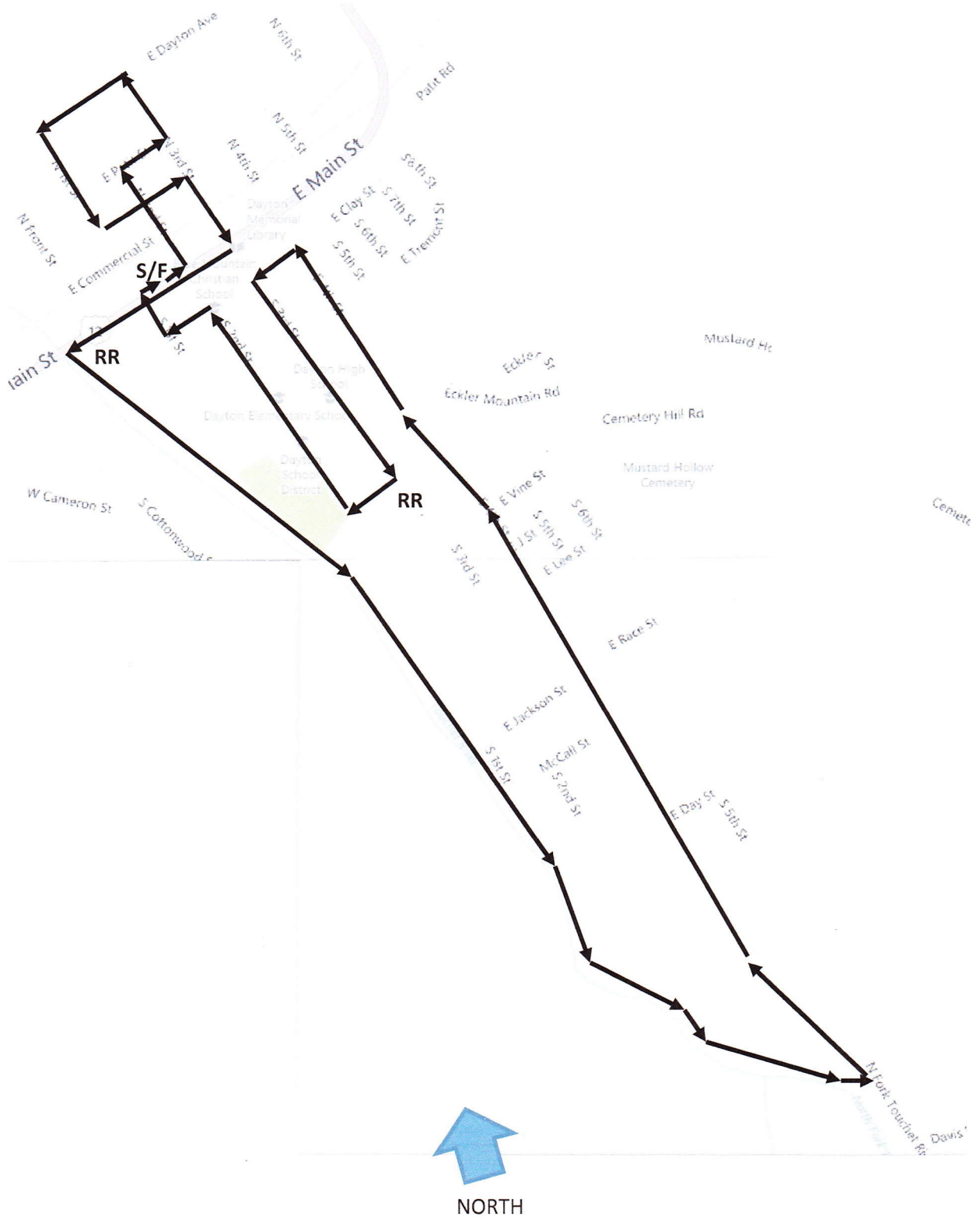

1. **EXIT** the Weinhard Hotel to Main St
2. **LEFT** on Main Street one block to N. 2nd Street (No Sign)
3. **LEFT** on N. 2nd Street to E. Patit St.
(2nd and Commercial is the Dayton Historical Depot built in 1881. Oldest in Washington. Restored in 1981)
4. **RIGHT** on E. Patit Street to N. 3rd St.
(312 E. Patit is the Andrew Nilsson Home built in 1885)
5. **LEFT** on N. 3rd Street to E. Dayton Ave (507 N. 3rd Street is the Dexter Home built in 1905)
6. **LEFT** on E. Dayton Avenue to N. 1st Street (1K)
7. **LEFT** on N. 1st Street to E. Washington Ave (504 N. 1st is the Mill House, 410 N. 1st is the Boldman Home, 303 N. 1st, all built in 1880)
8. **LEFT** on E. Washington Avenue to N. 3rd Street (203 and 205 E. Washington Street built in 1905, 221 E. Washington was the Brining Memorial Hospital built in 1935 (now offices), 303 E. Washington is Broughton Home built in 1885)
9. **RIGHT** on N. 3rd Street to Main Street and **CROSS** (303 N. 3rd is the Baker Home built in 1884, 3rd and Main is the Columbia County Courthouse built in 1886-7 and restored in 1991-2)
10. **RIGHT** on Main Street to Restroom Bldg and Touchet River Trail (No Sign) (2K at Main and 1st)
DO NOT CROSS THE RIVER
11. **LEFT** on Touchet River Trail
12. **CONTINUE** on trail until it intersects with N. Fork Touchet River Road (5.3K)
13. **LEFT** on N. Fork Touchet River Road (becomes 4th Street) to Clay Street (8.0 K) (218 S. 4th St. NP Depot 1898)
14. **LEFT** on Clay to 3rd Street
15. **LEFT** on 3rd Street to School Bus Street (9.0 K)
16. **RIGHT** on School Bus Street to 2nd Street (Bathrooms in the Park)
17. **RIGHT** on 2nd Street to Clay St (410 S. 2nd built in 1892, 314 S. 2nd built in 1871 enlarged in 1898, 212 S. 2nd built in 1891, 203 S. 2nd Community Bible Church built in 1892-3)
18. **LEFT** on Clay St to 1st Street
19. **RIGHT** on 1st to Main
20. **CROSS** Main then **RIGHT** to the Weinhard Hotel (10K)

1. **EXIT** the Weinhard Hotel to Main Street
2. **LEFT** on Main Street one block to N. 2nd Street (No Sign)
3. **LEFT** on N. 2nd Street to E. Patit St. (*2nd and Commercial is the Dayton Historical Depot built in 1881. Oldest in Washington. Restored in 1981*)
4. **RIGHT** on E. Patit Street to N. 3rd St. (*312 E. Patit is the Andrew Nilsson Home built in 1885*)
5. **LEFT** on N. 3rd Street to E. Dayton Ave (507 N. 3rd Street is the Dexter Home built in 1905)
6. **LEFT** on E. Dayton Avenue to N. 1st Street
7. **LEFT** on N. 1st Street to E. Washington Avenue (1 km/1st and Richmond) (*504 N. 1st is the Mill House, 410 N. 1st is the Boldman Home, 303 N. 1st all built in 1880*)
8. **LEFT** on E. Washington Avenue to N. 3rd Street (*203 and 205 E. Washington Street built in 1905, 221 E. Washington was the Brining Memorial Hospital built in 1935 (now offices), 303 E. Washington is Broughton Home built in 1885*)
9. **RIGHT** on N. 3rd Street to Main Street and **CROSS** (303 N. 3rd is the Baker Home built in 1884, 3rd and Main is the Columbia County Courthouse built in 1886-7 and restored in 1991-2)
10. **RIGHT** on Main Street to Touchet River Trail (Do Not Cross River) (Rest Rooms) (*2 K at 1st, Historic Buildings on Main have plaques*)
11. **LEFT** at restroom Bldg to Touchet River Trail (No Sign), cross the green foot bridge, angle to the block building (3 K)
12. **LEFT** on gravel road, pond on right and playground on left to 2nd Street
13. **CONTINUE** straight on School Bus Street to 3rd Street passing school maintenance building
14. **LEFT** on 3rd Street to Clay Street (4 K)
15. **LEFT** on Clay Street to 2nd Street
16. **LEFT** on 2nd Street to Oak Street (*203 S. 2nd Community Bible Church built in 1892-3 Originally a Baptist Church, 212 S. 2nd built in 1891, 314 S. 2nd built in 1871 enlarged in 1898, 410 S. 2nd built 1892*)
17. **RIGHT** on Oak Street to 1st Street
18. **RIGHT** on 1st Street to Main Street (*518 S 1st built in 1870, 500 S 1st built in 1908, 402 S 1st built in 1892, 309 S 1st built in 1879, 203 S 1st built in 1890, 200 S 1st built in 1890*)
19. **RIGHT** on Main to Weinhard Hotel
