



## Two Routes Available – Historical (10K) & Nature-Oriented (10K)

**Special Programs** – None

**Start Point:** Balboa Encino Golf Course, 16821 Burbank Blvd., Encino, CA 91436.

**Directions to start:** From the 405 Freeway, North or South to Burbank Blvd offramp. Turn west on Burbank Blvd. past Hayvenhurst to the parking lot entrance right before seeing the Balboa Encino Golf Courses sign. Turn into the parking lot, then turn left and go over the hill and park in the front entrance parking lot which leads to the bathrooms and the coffee shop.

### Encino Historical 10k

1. Exit the parking lot to the bike path following Burbank Blvd.
2. Turn left on the bike path next to Burbank Blvd. to the traffic signal at Hayvenhurst.
3. Turn right on Hayvenhurst, go under the 101 Fwy to Magnolia St. and cross Magnolia.
4. Turn right on Magnolia to Petit Ave. (Note the community garden)
5. Turn left on Petit
6. Turn right on La Maida St.
7. Turn right on Moorpark St. to Los Encino State Historical Park (Restrooms available).
8. Continue on Moorpark to Balboa Ave.
9. Turn left on Balboa to Ventura Blvd.
10. Turn right on Ventura Blvd.
11. Turn right on Genesta Ave.
12. Turn left on Otsego.
13. Turn right on Amestoy.
14. Turn left on McCormick
15. Turn right on Aldea.
16. Turn left on Weddington.
17. Turn right on Louise, go over the 101 Fwy. to Burbank (cross Burbank).
18. Turn right on Burbank to Balboa (cross Balboa) (Restrooms right before Balboa)
19. Turn left on Balboa—the golf course is on your right.
20. Follow the chain link fence around the golf course (Just before the bridge, the fence turns to the right, so turn with it. The trail

transitions from pavement to a dirt path with the golf course on your right and the LA River on your left.

21. Continue along the trail back to the Club House area and the start point

### Encino Nature-Oriented 10k

1. Exit the parking lot to the bike path following Burbank Blvd.
2. Turn left on bike path next to Burbank Blvd. to the far end of the eastern parking lot.
3. Enter the gate opening left, to the dirt path through the par course.
4. Proceed east on dirt path (Encino Golf Course is on the Left, the bike path and Burbank Blvd. on the right).
5. At the far east end of the golf course, continue straight ahead along the righthand fence on the pavement to the opening in this fence just before the bushy growth that indicates the river.
6. Jag right through the opening in this fence, then go left on the bike path.
7. Proceed on the bike path over the bridge to the signal at Woodley Ave. & Burbank Blvd.
8. Cross Woodley Ave. at the signal and continue straight on the path/sidewalk (Burbank Blvd. on your right) over a small creek.

9. About 40 feet beyond the creek, turn left on path leading to stone pillar announcing that this is the Sepulveda Wildlife Reserve
10. Proceed straight ahead through the opening in the wood rail fence to the dirt trail.
11. Left (north) on the dirt trail with the lake on your right and the creek on your left, passing several small paths to the right that lead to wildlife viewing sites.
12. At the north end of the lake, go right toward the restrooms.
13. From the parking lot, go left down the paved road to the circle, then right up a slight incline to the Archery Range.
14. Reverse course, returning to the asphalt park road
15. Turn right (west) on the park road past the Sepulveda Basin Cricket Fields and past the entrance to the Tilman Water Reclamation Plant to Woodley Ave. (second stop sign).
16. Turn right (north) along Woodley Ave., walking on grass and dirt to Victory Blvd.
17. Left at Victory, crossing Woodley Ave.
18. Turn left immediately onto bike path running back along Woodley for 1 block pass a tall palm tree, then, immediately turn right (west) on the bike path. Woodley Lakes Golf Course will be on your left and an entry road will be on your right.
19. Continue past the entry to the golf course parking area.
20. When the bike path angles left up a slight hill, cross the road on your right to the sidewalk.
21. Follow the path as it curves left to Lake Balboa.
22. Turn left at the T intersection of the path (the lake is on your right).
23. Continue about 2/3 of the way around the lake, taking the right fork at all intersections. Several restrooms and water are available.
24. Turn right at the park road.
25. Cross the road at the faded crosswalk just before the bridge, then cross the bridge on the parallel pedestrian path.
26. Proceed straight ahead along the left side of the park road to Balboa Blvd. (park entrance).
27. Turn left (south) on the bike path along Balboa Blvd. Cross the bridge over the L.A. River and continue south. (Balboa Golf Course is on the left and Balboa Blvd. is on the right.)
28. Turn left on the bike path at Burbank Blvd.
29. Turn left at the first driveway and proceed around the north side of the parking lot to the stop/start point.
