Event Type: Year Round Walk - Y0987 **Distance - Trail Ratings:** 5K,6K, 11K - 2 A

Description: Hours M-F 5 AM to 2 AM Daily. This is a remote start walk. **PSB** register for this walk in Anacortes and then drive 4.4 miles to the ferry. (Fee parking at ferry terminal). Driving directions are on the walk directions. You need not take your car as the walk begins and ends from the ferry landing in Friday Harbor. There is a parking fee. Walk along country roads with fabulous water views. The walk finishes through downtown Friday Harbor. The 5 km stays in Friday Harbor business and residential districts. Toilets available at ferry landing but not on the walk routes. Take water as there is none on the route.

Times: Hours M-F 5 AM to 2 AM Daily. **Awards & Fees:** IVV Credit Only

Start Point / Driving Directions: For PSB. The Market grocery store parking lot at 1519 Commercial Ave. From I-5, Exit 230, Highway 20 west. Follow signs for Anacortes. In Anacortes, follow Highway 20 as it turns right on Commercial Ave. Follow Commercial Ave. past 17th and turn right into store parking lot. Walk box is near ATM machine. Start box Lat. & Long. coordinates: **48.508700, -122.612400**

For OSB – From I-5 take Exit 230 Highway 20 west to Anacortes. In Anacortes, follow Highway 20 as it turns right on Commercial Ave. and proceed to 12th Street. Turn left. 12th St. will turn into Oakes Avenue. Follow signs to the San Juan Ferry terminal and choose any parking area. There is a parking fee. You will not need your vehicle in Friday Harbor to complete the walk. Terminal Lat. & Long. Coordinates: **48.504223, -122.679842**

Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.

1. **CROSS** and **RIGHT** on Front Street as you exit the ferry, using the cross walk. Walk up the ramp with the water on your right
2. **CROSS** Spring Street
3. **RIGHT** to cross Front Street using the cross walk.
Walkers with Strollers: To avoid the 5 flights of stairs, turn Left on Spring Street and Right on 1st Street. Just past the Whale Museum you turn left on Court Street and skip to #12
4. **LEFT** on Front Street with the water on your right.
5. **VEER SLIGHTLY RIGHT** to enter the small Fairweather Park.
6. After a short distance, just past the seal, **TAKE THE STAIRS ON YOUR LEFT**
7. **WALK AROUND** the traffic circle to the 5 flights of stairs on the other side.
8. **WALK** up the stairs. *At the top of the stairs, turn around for a good view of the harbor. This lets you catch your breath too!*
9. **WALK** to the street in front of you. *Before you continue straight, look to your left and you'll see the Veteran's Museum in the American Legion Building) and the next building is the Whale Museum*
10. **WALK STRAIGHT AHEAD** on Court Street, past the San Juan County Courthouse to 2nd Street.
11. **RIGHT** on 2nd Street, continuing as it curves left and becomes Guard Street.
12. **LEFT** at Tucker Avenue, using the crosswalk to cross Guard Street
13. **RIGHT** to continue on Guard St. 1 K
14. Continue on Guard Street, passing the school complex, to Marguerite Place.
15. **LEFT** on Marguerite Place to Park Street.
16. **LEFT** on Park Street to Blair Avenue.
17. **RIGHT** on Blair Avenue (2km) to Spring Street.
18. **CROSS** Spring and Caines Street at the intersection and continue on the left side of Caines Street. Follow as it curves left.
19. **LEFT** on Argyle Avenue.
20. **RIGHT** on Nichols Street (*Mural on the Ace Hardware, Demeter Bakery on your left*) to "A" Street.
21. **CROSS** "A" and Nichols Street to continue on the left side of Nichols Street.
22. **LEFT** on "B" Street (unmarked) and walk one block past the Sunken Park on your left to Harrison Street.
23. **RIGHT** on Harrison Street. Follow Harrison to the T-intersection at the bottom of the hill. *Turn Point Road to your right, Warbass Way to your left.*
24. **CROSS** and **LEFT** on Warbass Way. Walk on the right side of Warbass Way, being careful of traffic as you see the harbor and Brown Island on your right.
25. **RIGHT** on Harrison. After one block you will pass the ferry traffic holding area on the right.
26. **CONTINUE** on Harrison to Spring Street. Skip to #28 unless doing the Additional 1 K Option
27. **ADDITIONAL 1 K OPTION**
 - a. **LEFT** on Spring Street and walk two blocks.
 - b. **RIGHT** to cross Spring St.
 - c. **RIGHT** again to walk down Spring Street on the opposite side.
 - d. **CROSS** Front Street and continue straight ahead out the dock to the interpretive building
 - e. **TURN AROUND** and return to Front Street.
 - f. **LEFT** to Ferry and finish.
28. **RIGHT** on Spring Street, and walk one block to the traffic circle and Veteran's Memorial at Front Street.
29. **LEFT** to cross Spring Street,
30. **RIGHT** to cross Front Street
31. **RIGHT** again on Front Street to Ferry and finish.

Driving directions to ferry: Leaving The Market, turn right on Commercial Avenue. Proceed to 12th Street and turn left. This will turn into Oakes Avenue. Follow signs to ferry. Use the ferry parking area. There is a parking fee. You will not need your vehicle in Friday Harbor to complete the walk.

1. Leaving the ferry use the crosswalk to **CROSS** Front Street.
2. **RIGHT** and go to Spring Street.
3. **LEFT** on Spring Street to First Street.
4. **LEFT** on First. First will become Harrison after crossing the ferry traffic holding lanes.
5. **LEFT** on Warbass Way (unmarked, across from “B” Street)
6. You will now be walking on a circular road keeping the water to your left for about 7 km. The name of the road will change to Turn Point and then Pear Point. (There are restrooms at the Jackson Beach boat launch – about 7.5K)
7. Continue by the Friday Harbor Sand and Gravel Pit keeping the water on your left.
8. **RIGHT** on Argyle Avenue. 7.6 km. Stay on the right using the walking path.
9. **CROSS** Argyle at Rose Lane in order to walk on the sidewalk. Continue on Argyle.
10. **RIGHT** on Spring
11. **CROSS** and **LEFT** on 1st Street
12. *CHECKPOINT: How many skeletons are on the outside of the Whale Museum?*
13. **LEFT** on Court Street.
14. **RIGHT** on 2nd Street. Go about 50 feet to the crosswalk
15. **LEFT** crossing the crosswalk. You will now be on Reed Street. Continue to Blair Avenue.
16. **LEFT** on Blair Avenue
17. **LEFT** on Spring Street.
18. **RIGHT** on Front Street and return to the ferry landing.

There are lots of fun shops and good restaurants available in Friday Harbor to entertain you while you await your ferry departure.
