Description: Walk on the dike bordering the Skagit River and through the old business district including small shops and nice restaurants and a restored train station. Start box is a two-drawer wooden file cabinet. Restrooms at start, at Skagit River Park and behind the Chamber office in the restored RR station downtown (open at 10am). (Skagit River Park gates open 7am to Dusk. If closed cars can't get out. Closed Christmas Eve and Christmas day.)

Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.

1. **LEAVING** Haggen turn **LEFT**.
2. **RIGHT** at the end of parking lot.
3. **LEFT** onto Haggen Drive (unmarked) walking toward traffic and light passing Columbia Bank on your right.
4. **RIGHT** on Rio Vista.
5. Using crosswalk, **CROSS** then **LEFT** on N. Burlington Blvd to East Fairhaven Ave.
6. **RIGHT** on East Fairhaven Ave.

Restrooms at the Burlington Visitor Center
7. **RIGHT** on Cherry Street.
8. **CROSS** Greenleaf Ave. and continue on Cherry Street.
9. **LEFT** on East Rio Vista.
10. **CROSS** and **RIGHT** on Pine Street.
11. **LEFT** on Sharon Ave. (just before stop sign, notice the tree carvings).
12. **CROSS AND LEFT** on S. Anacortes Street (*this is where you leave the 10K walkers*)
13. **RIGHT** on Greenleaf Ave.
14. At stop sign, **CROSS** Gilkey to enter Skagit River Park. *Restrooms in the park.*
15. **LEFT** on Holly St. passing the library
16. **LEFT** on East Fairhaven Street.
17. **CONTINUE** on East Fairhaven to North Burlington Blvd.
18. **CROSS** and **LEFT** on Burlington Blvd.
19. **CROSS** Rio Vista Ave. and continue on Burlington Blvd to Haggen Drive.
20. **RIGHT** on Haggen Drive returning to Haggen and the finish of the walk.

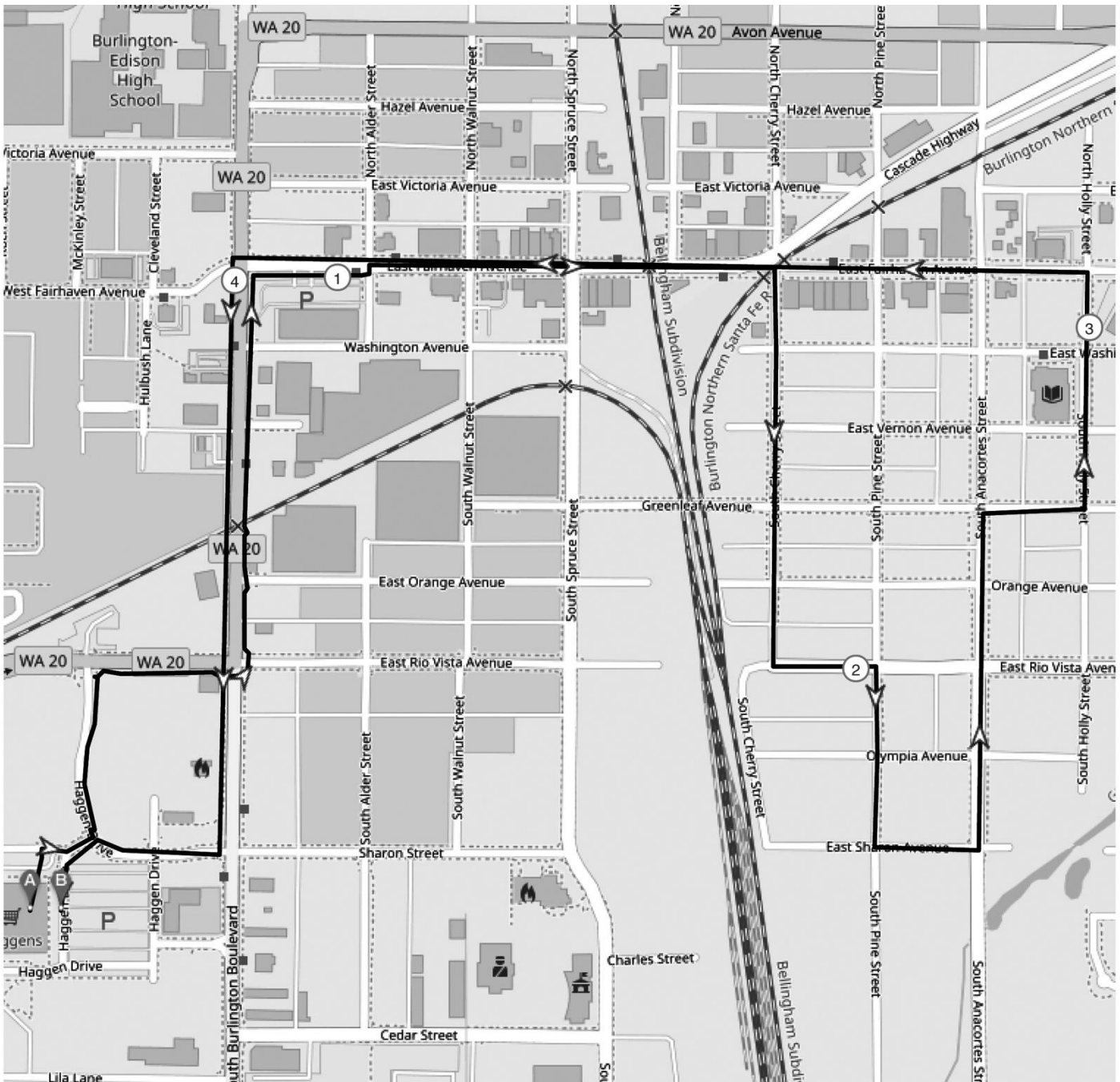

1. **LEAVING** Haggen turn **LEFT**.
2. **RIGHT** at the end of parking lot.
3. **LEFT** onto Haggen Drive (unmarked) walking toward traffic and light passing Columbia Bank on your right.
4. **RIGHT** on Rio Vista.
5. Using crosswalk, **CROSS** then **LEFT** on N. Burlington Blvd to East Fairhaven Ave.
6. **RIGHT** on East Fairhaven Ave.
Restrooms at the Burlington Visitor Center
7. **RIGHT** on Cherry Street.
8. **CROSS** Greenleaf Ave. and continue on Cherry Street.
9. **LEFT** on East Rio Vista.
10. **CROSS** and **RIGHT** on Pine Street.
11. **LEFT** on Sharon Ave. (just before stop sign, notice the tree carvings).
12. **CROSS** S Anacortes Street (*this is where the 5K walkers leave the 10K walkers*) and walk down alley and gravel path which turns into a paved road. Follow to stop sign.
13. **CROSS** and **RIGHT** at S. Skagit Street.
14. At stop sign, **CROSS** Gilkey to enter Skagit River Park. *Restrooms in the park.*
15. **CONTINUE** passing playground on your left, walking through park on gravel road.
16. **LEFT** at dike access ramp.
17. **LEFT** onto the dike road with Skagit River on your right. Continue to Gardener Rd.
Porta potty just before Gardener Rd.
18. **LEFT** onto Gardener Rd.
19. **LEFT** on East Fairhaven Street.
20. **CONTINUE** on East Fairhaven to North Burlington Blvd.
21. **CROSS** and **LEFT** on Burlington Blvd.
22. **CROSS** Rio Vista Ave. and continue on Burlington Blvd to Haggen Drive.
23. **RIGHT** on Haggen Drive returning to Haggen and the finish of the walk.
