

WASHINGTON, MO 5K YRE 1408 WALK DIRECTIONS (OSB) (RATING 2A)

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This map and directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association (AVA) athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited. In case of emergency: Dial 911

Driving directions to start point at Amtrak Train Station, 301 W. Front St., Washington, Missouri, 63090. (GPS: 38.561600,-91.012500) **From I-44 Exit #251**, go west on Hwy. 100 for 10 miles to Washington. Turn right on Hwy. 47, left on 5th St., right on Jefferson St., left on W. Front St. to # 301. **From I-70 Exit #193**, go south on Hwy. 47 for 25 miles to Washington. Turn right on 5th St., right on Jefferson St., left on W. Front St. to # 301. **From I-64/Hwy 40 Exit #10**, go west on Hwy. 94, then left on Hwy. 47 to Washington. Turn right on 5th St., right on Jefferson St., left on W. Front St. to # 301. Free parking on Amtrak parking lot, Oak and Front Streets, across the street from train station. Rest rooms in train station and on the trail.

NOTE: Please use **EITHER** the Online Start Box (**OSB**) **OR** the Physical Start Box (**PSB**) to register and complete this event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB and/or signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

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Special Programs: Ice Cream Parlors; Little Free Libraries (in Amtrak Station); Rockin' Around the Clock; Walking Missouri Counties (Franklin County)

Legend: TR = Turn Right, TL = Turn Left, SA = Straight Ahead, CR = Cross, SP = Special Program Qualifier

1. **EXIT** Amtrak Depot, **TR** on **FRONT ST.** for 2 blocks to **OLIVE ST.** passing Missouri Meerschaum Co. at 400 Front St. (where corncob pipes are made).
2. **TL** on **OLIVE ST.** until it ends at Horn St.
3. **TL** on **HORN ST.** for a short block to Dubois St.
4. **TR** on **DUBOIS ST.** for 2 blocks to 5th St. [**1K**]
5. **TL** on **5TH ST.** for 8 blocks to **LOCUST ST.**, passing Immanuel Lutheran Church at 214 W. 5th St. and Saint Peter's United Church of Christ at 20 E. 5th St. You will also pass the Washington Public Library (**RESTROOMS**) on 5th Street between Lafayette and Jefferson Streets. NOTE: The library entrance is off Lafayette St., on the north side of the building.
6. **TL** on **LOCUST ST.** 4 blocks to **MAIN ST.** [**2K**, at 3rd. St]
7. **TL** on **MAIN ST.** 1 block to **WALNUT ST.**
8. **TL** on **WALNUT ST.** 3 blocks to **4TH ST.**
9. **TR** on **4TH ST.** 1 block to **MARKET ST.**, passing the old Washington Presbyterian Church, now the Washington Historical Society Museum at 113 E. 4th St.
10. **TR** on **MARKET ST.** 1 block to **3RD ST.**
11. **TL** on **3RD ST.** 1 block to **JEFFERSON ST.**, passing the former Spaunhorst General Store (NRHP) on the SE corner of 3rd and Jefferson.
12. **TL** on **JEFFERSON ST.** 1 block to **4TH ST.** When you reach 4th St. you can see Washington City Hall ahead on the right side of Jefferson at 405 Jefferson. [**3K**]
13. **TR** on **4TH ST.** for 1 block to **LAFAYETTE ST.**
14. **TR** on **LAFAYETTE ST.** for 1 block to **3RD ST.**
15. **TR** on **3RD ST.** for 1 block to **JEFFERSON ST.**
16. **TL** on **JEFFERSON ST.** for 1 block to **2ND ST.**

17. **TL** on **2ND ST.** for 2 blocks to **OAK ST.**, passing the Washington U.S. Post Office on the NW corner of 2nd and Lafayette.
18. **TL** on **OAK ST.** for 2 blocks to **4TH ST.**
19. **TR** on **4TH ST.** for 2 blocks to **CEDAR ST.** As you cross Elm St., look to your right for the Calvin Opera House ½ block north on Elm St.
20. **TR** on **CEDAR ST.** for 1 block to **3RD ST.** On the NW corner of 3rd and Cedar is the St. Francis Borgia Parrish Elementary School. **[4K]**
21. **TR** on **3RD ST.** for 1 block to **ELM ST.** As you turn east on 3rd St., look to your left, toward the river, and you can see the rear of St. Francis Borgia Catholic Church, which is located on Main St. between Elm and Cedar Streets.
22. **TL** on **ELM ST.** for 2 blocks to **MAIN ST.**, passing Cowan's Restaurant (Home of the Mile High Pies) at 114 Elm.
23. **TR** on **MAIN ST.** for 3 blocks to **JEFFERSON ST.**, passing the Main St. Creamery (Ice Cream!) at 110 W. Main St. **(SP)**
24. **TL** on **JEFFERSON ST.** for 1 block to **FRONT ST.**
25. **TL** on **FRONT ST.** for 1 block to **LAFAYETTE ST.**
26. **TR** on **LAFAYETTE ST.**, crossing the railroad tracks and walking toward the Missouri River.
27. As you approach the boat launch ramp, **TR** into the parking lot adjacent to the river. Walk through this parking lot, with river on your left, until you see the start of a bike path. **[NOTE: *If the river is high enough to cover this parking lot, just check out Riverfront Park (step 30), and go to step 31.*]**
28. **TR** onto the bike path for a short distance until you come to a fence just before the railroad tracks. At this point the bike path turns to the left, but you will
29. **TR** on the sidewalk, with the railroad tracks on your left. Straight ahead are **RESTROOMS.**
30. **CONTINUE** walking west, between the picnic pavilion on your right, and the Old Waterworks, now an antique store, on your left. Straight ahead is a large Analemmatic sundial. If the sun is shining, you can check the accuracy of your watch. Just north of the sundial, toward the river, is a large information sign with the

history of Washington, MO. Just west is another information sign which tells about the Lewis and Clark Expedition passing this site. You are almost finished, so if you wish to relax and enjoy the view of the Missouri River, there are benches to do so.

31. **RETURN** to **LAFAYETTE ST.**, re-cross the railroad tracks, and **TR** on **FRONT ST.**, back to the Start Point at the Amtrak Station / Visitor Center.

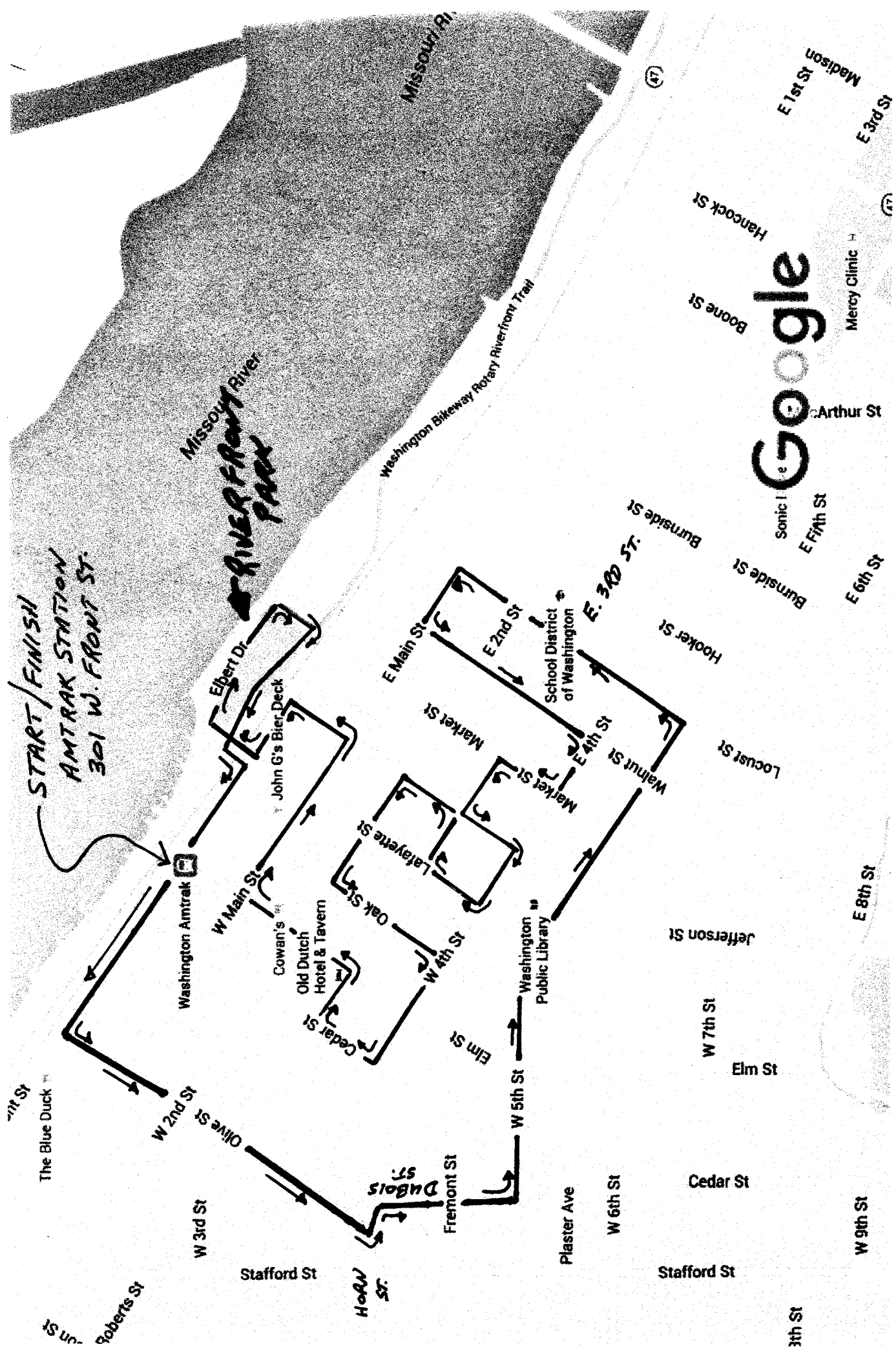

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- EXIT** the Amtrak Depot, **TR** on **FRONT ST.** to **HIGH ST.** passing the Missouri Meerscham Co. at 400 Front St. (where corncob pipes are made).
 - TL** on **HIGH ST.** to **CIRCLE DRIVE**, passing Main Park on your right (**RESTROOMS** available in the brick building between the ball diamond and the park pavilion). [**1.2K**]
 - TR** on **CIRCLE DRIVE** (no sidewalk), passing the swimming pool on your right, to the next street on your left after passing the pool.
 - TL** on **STATE ST.** (not marked – it is the first street you can turn left on after passing the pool), 1-1/2 short blocks to **VETERANS DR.**
 - TR** on **VETERANS DR.** to a "Y" at the bottom of a short hill.
 - VEER LEFT** at the "Y" to **LAKE SHORE DR.** Go up a short hill on **LAKE SHORE DR.**, passing a sign for Bernie Hillermann Park on your left. At the top of the hill, go through a small parking area on your right and you will see **LIONS LAKE**, with a walking path around the lake.
 - TR** on the walking path, walking counter-clockwise around approximately 2/3 of the lake, and you will come to a pedestrian bridge over a small portion of the lake.
 - After crossing the bridge, leave the walking path and walk straight ahead, through a small parking lot, to a short flight of steps up to **LAKE SHORE DR.** (**RESTROOMS** available to the left of the playground).
 - TR** on **LAKE SHORE DR.** a short distance to **GRAND AVE.** [**2.7K**], passing the Kohmueller Farmstead (NRHP) on the left.
 - TL** on **GRAND AVE.** passing the YMCA at 400 Grand Ave. (**RESTROOMS**), to **5th ST.**
 - TL** on **5th ST.** to **ELM ST.** There is a Phillips 66 Station on the NW corner of 5th & Elm. [**4.8K**]
 - CR** **ELM ST.**, then **TR** on **ELM ST.** to **8th St.**, passing Immanuel Lutheran Church on your left at the SE corner of 5th & Elm.

13. **TL** on **8TH ST.** a short distance, **TR** and **CR** a small pedestrian bridge over Busch Creek. Straight ahead of you is the former John B. Busch Brewery (NRHP) (now a banquet center). After crossing the bridge, **TL and CONTINUE EAST ON BUSCH AVE.** (Busch Creek will be on your left) to **JEFFERSON ST.** On your right, at 813 Jefferson St., is the John B Busch Mansion (NRHP).
14. **TL** on **JEFFERSON ST.** At the corner, **CR 8TH ST.,** then **TR & CR JEFFERSON ST.**
15. **TL** on **JEFFERSON ST.** for 3 blocks to **5TH ST.**
16. **CROSS 5TH ST.,** then **TR** on **5TH ST.** for 3 blocks to **LOCUST ST. [6.4K],** passing St. Peter's United Church of Christ on the SW corner of 5th & Market.
17. **TL** on **LOCUST ST.** 4 blocks to **MAIN ST.**
18. **TL** on **MAIN ST.** 1 block to **WALNUT ST.**
19. **TL** on **WALNUT ST.** 3 blocks to **4TH ST. [7.2K]**
20. **TR** on **4TH ST.** 1 block to **MARKET ST.,** passing a former Presbyterian Church, now the Washington Historical Society Museum at 113 E. 4th St.
21. **TR** on **MARKET ST.** 1 block to **3RD ST.**
22. **TL** on **3RD ST.** 1 block to **JEFFERSON ST.,** passing the former Spaunhorst General Store (NRHP) on the SE corner of 3rd and Jefferson.
23. **TL** on **JEFFERSON ST.** 2 blocks to **5TH ST.,** passing City Hall at 405 Jefferson.
24. **TR** on **5TH ST.** for 1 block, passing the Washington Public Library (**RESTROOMS**), to **LAFAYETTE ST.**
25. **TR** on **LAFAYETTE ST.** for 2 blocks to **3RD ST.**
26. **TR** on **3RD ST.** for 1 block to **JEFFERSON ST. [8K]**
27. **TL** on **JEFFERSON ST.** for 1 block to **2ND ST.**
28. **TL** on **2ND ST.** for 2 blocks to **OAK ST.,** passing the Washington Post Office on the NW corner of 2nd and Lafayette.
29. **TL** on **OAK ST.** for 1 block to **3RD ST.**
30. **TR** on **3RD ST.** for 1 block to **ELM ST.**
31. **TL** on **ELM ST.** for 1 block to **4TH ST.,** passing the Calvin Opera House on your right.
32. **TR** on **4TH ST.** for 1 block to **CEDAR ST.**
33. **TR** on **CEDAR ST.** for 1 block to **3RD ST.** On the NW corner of 3rd and Cedar is the St. Francis Borgia Parrish Elementary School.
34. **TR** on **3RD ST.** for 1 block to **ELM ST.** As you turn east on 3rd St., look to your left, toward the river, and you can see the rear of St. Francis Borgia Catholic Church, which is located on Main St. between Elm and Cedar Streets.
35. **TL** on **ELM ST.** for 2 blocks to **MAIN ST. [9K],** passing Cowan's Restaurant (Home of the Mile High Pies) at 114 Elm.
36. **TR** on **MAIN ST.** for 3 blocks to **JEFFERSON ST.,** passing the Main St. Creamery (Ice Cream!) at 110 W. Main St. (**SP**)
37. **TL** on **JEFFERSON ST.** for 1 block to **FRONT ST.**
38. **TL** on **FRONT ST.** for 1 block to **LAFAYETTE ST.**
39. **TR** on **LAFAYETTE ST.,** crossing the railroad tracks and walking toward the Missouri River.
40. As you approach the boat launch ramp, **TR** into the parking lot adjacent to the river. Walk through this parking lot, with river on your left, until you see the start of a bike path. [**NOTE: If the river is high enough to cover this parking lot, just check out Riverfront Park (step 43), and go to step 44.**]
41. **TR** onto the bike path for a short distance until you come to a fence just before the railroad tracks. At this point the bike path turns to the left, but you will

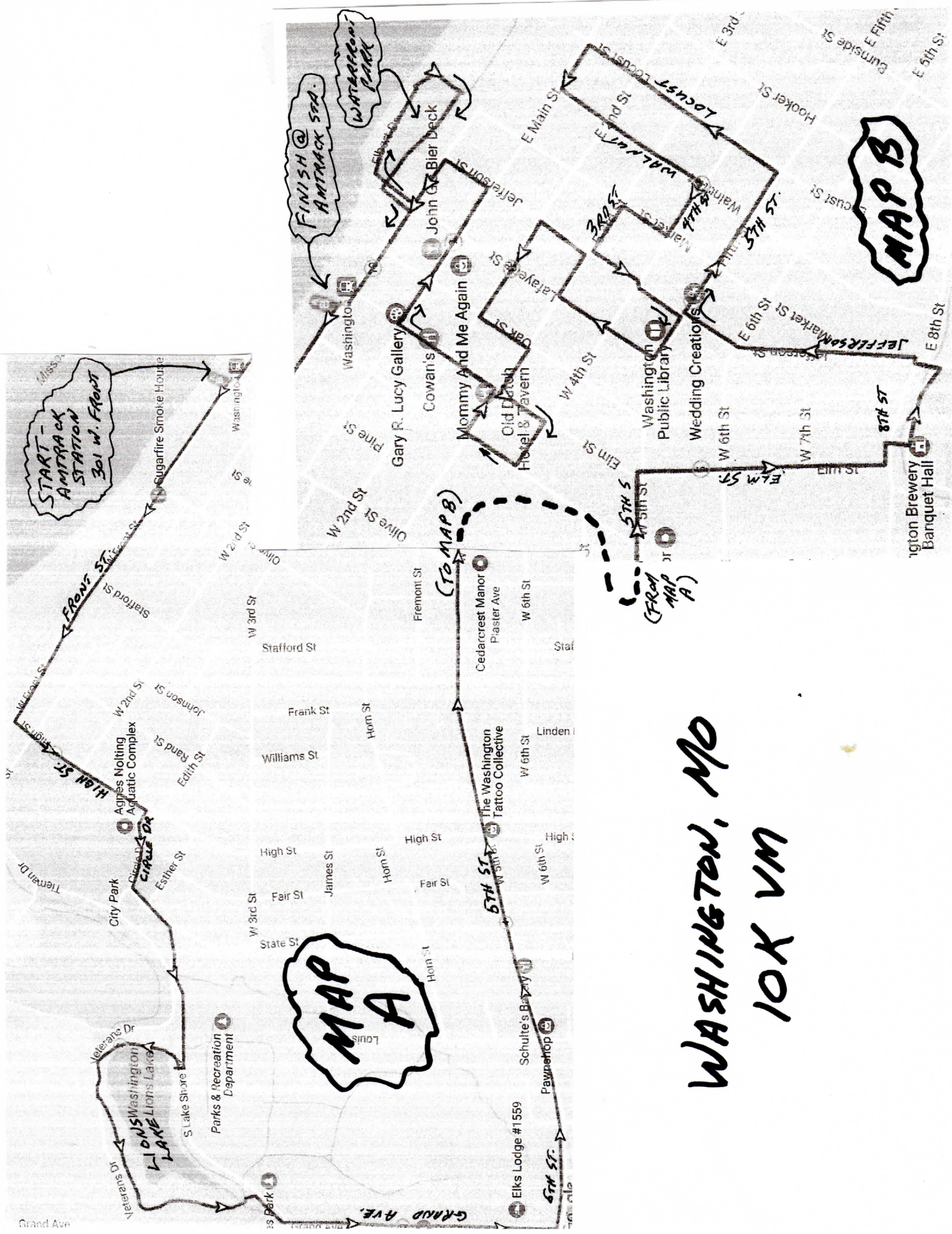
