400 Osborne Street, St. Marys, GA 31558. For directions place cursor over hyperlink hit control and right click <https://goo.gl/maps/OADwX> This site is in the downtown area of St. Marys.

On street parking is available along the streets in the area. Restrooms are available in the Visitors Center when open. It is open 9am-5pm M-Sat, Sun 12-5pm. Closed Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve & Day, New Years Eve & Day and Easter. Other restrooms are available in the downtown area. Also several restaurants are available in the downtown area.

St. Marys, GA is a small coastal village located in SE Georgia. It is rich in history, natural beauty, and southern hospitality. St. Marys is the gateway to the Cumberland Island National Seashore, a pristine barrier island accessible via ferry only and a wonderful day trip. Our walk will take you through the historic area, the Oak Grove Cemetery with graves dating back to 1801, and along the scenic waterfront with glimpses of Cumberland Island in the distance. Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay is located adjacent to St. Marys.

## St. Marys, GA 5 & 10K Walks ©

Start Point: 400 Osborne St.

1. **EXIT** Welcome Center.
2. **TURN RIGHT** to **CROSS** Osborne St. and **CONTINUE** on Conyers St. W. To Dillworth St.
3. **CROSS & TURN LEFT** on Dillworth St. which becomes St. Marys St. W.
4. **CONTINUE** on St. Marys St. W. to Marsh Walk Pier.( located at beginning of brick sidewalk)
5. **TURN RIGHT** and walk to end of Pier. **TURN AROUND** and return to St. Marys St. W.
6. **TURN RIGHT** on St. Marys St. W. to Bartlett St.(1<sup>st</sup> street on left)
7. **TURN LEFT, CROSSING** St. Marys St. to Bartlett St. **CONTINUE** on Bartlett to entrance of Oak Grove Cemetery which was laid out in 1788.
8. **TURN LEFT** into cemetery. Look for steps that cross through the wall just before Bryant St. and use them. Wander through the cemetery away from the river angling ahead and to the right until you come to dirt road.
9. **TURN RIGHT** on dirt road to exit cemetery to W. Weed St. (unmarked)
10. **TURN RIGHT** on W. Weed St. to Seagrove St.(2<sup>nd</sup> street after exiting cemetery)
11. **TURN RIGHT** on Seagrove St. to Bryant St. W.
12. **SLIGHT LEFT** and then **RIGHT** to continue on Seagrove St. to St. Marys St. W.
13. **CROSS** St. Marys St. W. and **LEFT** to enter St. Marys Howard Gilmon Memorial Park on right.
14. **GO THROUGH** Park and out to the end of the pier to view the St. Marys River.
15. **TURN AROUND** and exit pier.
16. **TURN RIGHT** and follow walkway along Riverfront to side entrance of Park.
17. **EXIT** Park and **TURN LEFT** to return to St. Marys St. (Restrooms in Cumberland Island Visitor Center)
18. **TURN RIGHT** on St. Marys St. and continue to Ready St.
19. **TURN LEFT** on Ready St. to Bryant St. E.
20. **TURN RIGHT** on Bryant St. E. to the end. Enjoy Marsh Views.
21. **TURN AROUND** and return to Ready St.

22. **TURN RIGHT** on Ready St. to E. Weed St.
23. **TURN RIGHT** on E. Weed St. to Norris St.

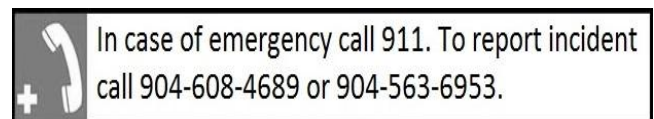
### 5K OPTION:

24. **5K TURN LEFT** on Norris St. to Conyers St.
25. **5K TURN LEFT** on Conyers to return to Welcome Center at corner of Conyers & Osborne.

### 10K OPTION:

25. **10K TURN LEFT** on Norris St. to Hall St.
26. **TURN LEFT** on Hall to Ready St.
27. **CROSS & TURN LEFT** on Ready St. to Bryant St. E.
28. **TURN RIGHT** on Bryant St. E. to Osborne.
29. **TURN RIGHT** on Osborne to E. Church.
30. **TURN LEFT & CROSS** Osborne to continue on Church St. W. to Wheeler.
31. **TURN LEFT** on Wheeler to W. Bryant.
32. **TURN LEFT** on W. Bryant to Osborne.
33. **TURN RIGHT** on Osborne to St. Marys St. W.
34. **TURN RIGHT** on St. Marys St. to Wheeler.
35. **TURN RIGHT** on Wheeler St. to W. Stable Alley.(1<sup>st</sup> St.)
36. **TURN RIGHT** on W. Stable Alley to Osborne.
37. **TURN LEFT** on Osborne to Conyers.
38. **CROSS CONYERS** and **TURN RIGHT** to return to Welcome Center at corner of Osborne & Conyers.
