Three Cities, Three Parks, Y-1864
Tualatin, OR
5/10 Km, rated 1A

Walk Start Location: 7410 SW Bridgeport Rd., Tigard, OR, 97224. GPS Coords: 45.39340, -122.75256.

Driving Directions: From I-5, take exit 290, Lake Oswego/Durham. Southbound turn right & Northbound turn left onto Lower Boones Ferry Rd. Drive about .2 miles where Lower Boones Ferry becomes Bridgeport Rd. At stoplight turn left into REI's parking lot. REI Hours - 7 days a week at 10am Mon-Sat - open until 9pm; & Sun 10am - until 6pm. For holiday hours, call Tualatin REI at 503-624-8600.

Park away from the REI store.

Restrooms available in REI and in Cook Park.

Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

"Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB."

WOC Challenges-2020 (Parks, Pedestrian Bridge, Palms, River, Railroad, Spas & Trails)

1. Starting from REI parking lot, walk to Bridgeport Rd. entrance.
2. **RIGHT** on Bridgeport Rd. to Hazel Fern Rd.
3. **LEFT** on Hazel Fern Rd. entering Bridgeport Village
4. **Straight** on Hazel Fern and continue thru mall walk area until reaching front of the theatre complex.
5. **RIGHT** one block to just past Pastini.
6. **RIGHT** one block to just past Barnes & Noble
7. **RIGHT** at Barnes and Noble one block to Hazel Fern RD
8. **CROSS & LEFT** on Hazel Fern Rd one block to Bridgeport Rd.
9. **RIGHT** on Bridgeport Rd. to Boones Ferry Rd. **CROSS** Boones Ferry Rd. and continue straight now Rivendell Dr. to Arkenstone Dr.
10. **LEFT** on Arkenstone Dr. to parking exit for Durham City Park, across from house #17090.
11. **RIGHT** into parking area and continue down on trail over a bridge into Durham City Park keeping **RIGHT** at the first "Y" and continue until reaching a "T".
12. **RIGHT** at the "T" on the trail (Fanno Creek Trail) keeping the railroad on your left. At the "Y" go to the **LEFT** and continue clockwise as the trail circles Durham City Park returning back to the RR now on your right. Continue on trail until reaching first trail on your right that goes beneath the Railroad tracks.
13. **RIGHT** on the trail under trestle and continue on paved path as it weaves along a field/wetland area passing a kiosk area in Cook Park until reaching a parking lot with restrooms.
14. **LEFT** in the parking lot past another group of restrooms, the car entrance road to Cook Park and through another parking lot with baseball fields on your left and soccer fields on your right to small path at end of parking lot.
15. Continue **STRAIGHT** on small path a very short distance past another small restroom to path on left.
16. **LEFT** on trail between restrooms and Shelter 1.
17. At the next "Y" **RIGHT** on trail closest to the Tualatin River.
18. Continue on trail to canoe launching area on the river past shelter 3 and enter a natural trail into a wooded area to a "Y".
19. **RIGHT** at the "Y" and continue to a 5 trail junction.
20. Take the trail 2nd on right (nearly straight ahead) to paved sidewalk with Kiosk.
21. **RIGHT** and **RETURN** on the trail to "T" junction just past Railroad trestle.
22. **RIGHT** on paved trail (Fanno Creek Greenway) crossing bridge into Tualatin Community Park
23. Continue on paved Fanno Creek Greenway to the Railroad Trestle.
24. **PASS UNDER** the trestle then **LEFT** to trail on left next to the Tualatin River
25. **LEFT** on the trail staying next to river until it merges with Fanno Creek Greenway. Bear **RIGHT & CROSS** River and continue on trail to first trail on right.
26. **RIGHT** on the trail returning to play and parking area exiting on Arkenstone Dr.
27. **LEFT** on Arkenstone Dr. one block to Rivendell Dr.
28. **RIGHT** on Rivendell Dr. to Willowbottom
29. **LEFT** on Willowbottom Way to Boones Ferry Rd.
30. **RIGHT** on Boones Ferry Rd. to Bridgeport Rd/Rivendell Dr.
31. **CROSS** Rivendell Dr. and **LEFT** on Bridgeport Dr. to entrance to REI.

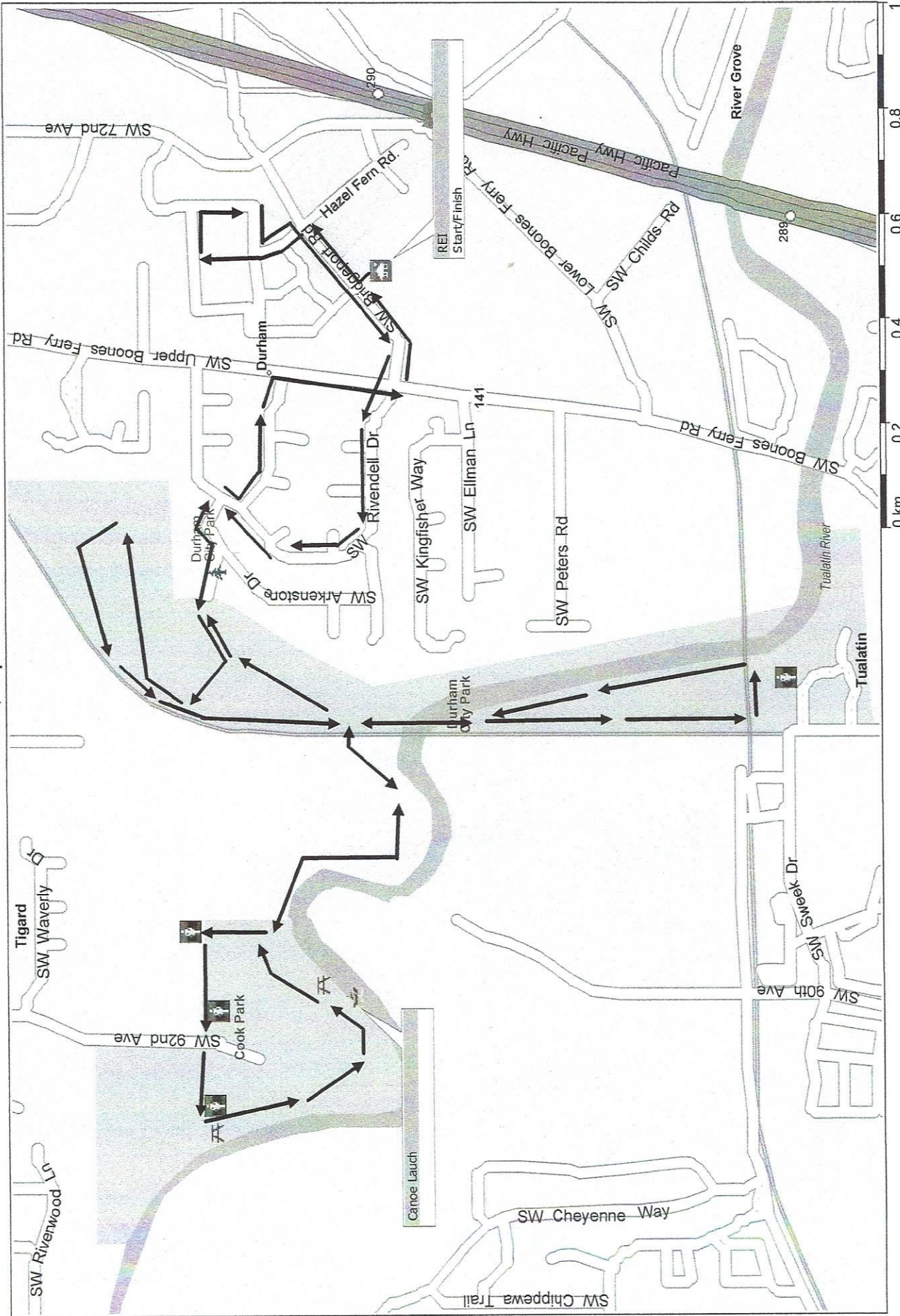
