**Directions:**

**I-5 NORTHBOUND:** Exit #192 (Broadway). North on Broadway. **Turn Left** onto 13th St. to Colby Ave. Starting point on corner of 13th St. and Colby Ave. Street parking.

**I-5 SOUTHBOUND:** Exit 198 (N Broadway/SR529S). Cross Snohomish River on Broadway to 13th St. **Turn Right** onto 13th St, continue to Colby Ave. Starting point on corner of 13th St. and Colby Ave. Street parking.

**Walking Instructions:**

1. Facing 13th St. with hospital entrance to your back, **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk on 13th, heading East.
2. **TURN LEFT** on Wetmore Ave, walk on right side of street.
3. Cross 10<sup>th</sup> St and **TURN RIGHT**, walking on 10th.
4. **TURN LEFT** on Broadway Ave.
5. At T intersection next to Golf Course, **TURN LEFT** to enter Everett College campus.
6. Continue straight ahead on campus. Look for Jackson Conference Center building on your right.
7. Pass Jackson Center **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk.
8. Pass Parks Student Union (RR), sidewalk curves **LEFT**.
9. At Totem Pole take **LEFT** sidewalk junction.
10. **TURN RIGHT** at next sidewalk junction.
11. Continue past Clock Tower to edge of campus.
12. Straight ahead cross edge of parking lot A to Wetmore Ave.

13. Little Free Library "34472" on Wetmore Ave & 8<sup>th</sup> St.
14. Cross Wetmore Ave, continue on 8<sup>th</sup> St.
15. **TURN LEFT** on Rucker Ave.
16. **TURN RIGHT** on 16<sup>th</sup> St.
17. Cross Grand Ave to trail/sidewalk in Grand Ave Overlook Park.
18. **TURN LEFT** on trail.
19. Continue on trail to end of overlook at 19<sup>th</sup> St.
20. Cross Grand Ave, continue on 19<sup>th</sup> St.
21. Cross Colby Ave **TURN LEFT**.
22. Continue on Colby back to Providence Hospital.

### **Directions:**

**I-5 NORTHBOUND:** Exit #192 (Broadway). North on Broadway. **Turn Left** onto 13th St. to Colby Ave. Starting point on corner of 13th St. and Colby Ave. Street parking.

**I-5 SOUTHBOUND:** Exit 198 (N Broadway/SR529S). Cross Snohomish River on Broadway to 13th St. **Turn Right** onto 13th St, continue to Colby Ave. Starting point on corner of 13th St. and Colby Ave. Street parking.

### **Walking Instructions:**

1. Facing 13th St. with hospital entrance to your back, **TURN LEFT** on sidewalk on 13th, heading WEST to Grand Avenue. Cross Grand Ave.

2. **TURN LEFT** on Grand Ave. to 23rd

**1703 Grand** (1910) Butler-Jackson House is in the Northwest Neighborhood. 1967 Senator Henry M "Scoop" Jackson & family moved into the home (\$65,000 purchase price). Senator Jackson ran for president twice.

**2012 Grand** (1901) William Chase Cottage. Simple worker-class house

**2031 Grand** (1908) W.J. Clough House. Swiss chalet character in a Craftsman Style home.

**2132 Grand** (1900) Gable-front vernacular house that was once hidden by a neighborhood grocery store.

**2228 Grand** - Mills Flats. The Mills family developed many cottages & bungalows on 2 blks of Grand. This unusual 2 story house is suggestive of 19th century Greek Revival style. Note bridge to sidewalk.

3. **TURN LEFT** on 23rd to Rucker.

4. **TURN RIGHT** on Rucker to Everett Ave

**2301 Rucker** (on left) (1899) Andrew J. Andrew Northwest Colonial Revival style, historically restored by Dave & Diane Loop.

**2302 Rucker**-John T. McChesney House. Mr. McChesney was in charge of J.J. Hills Everett Improvement Company.

**2320 Rucker** (1905) Governor Roland H. Hartley Mansion. Has a ballroom on the 3rd floor & a turnstile in the garage to turn the car around to drive out.

**2421 Rucker** (1905) Schumacher Ecklund House. Classic American Foursquare. Arthur & his wife Theresa lived in the house from 1918 to 1977.

**2632 Rucker** (1923) Madrona Apts. Advertised in the Herald as having every modern device known in apartment houses'. Tudor - apartment -style.

5. **TURN LEFT** on Everett Ave to Hoyt (1 block)

6. **TURN RIGHT** on Hoyt to Hewitt

**2702 Hoyt** (1934) The Everett Public Library. (RR)

7. **TURN LEFT** on Hewitt to Lombard

**At Colby:** Everett Historic Theatre

**At Wetmore:** Free Speech Corner - Traditional spot for local evangelists & soapbox orators. Focal point for controversy that led to the Everett Massacre.

**1721 Hewitt** (1925) Central Bldg. Cost: \$150,000

**1801 Hewitt**-Commerce Block. Occupied by Everett Women's Suffrage Club the year Washington women gained the right to vote.

**1805 Hewitt** (1902) Fire & rebuilt (1909)

**1901 Hewitt** (1902) Early commercial bldg.

**1915 Hewitt**-Mitchell Hotel. This was the main city hotel when the original Monte Cristo Hotel was turned into a hospital.

8. **TURN LEFT** on Lombard to California

**2812 Lombard** (1930) Labor Temple built during depression. Fraternal orders/labor organizations.

9. **TURN LEFT** on California to Colby

**Corner of Oakes** (1920) Challacombe Funeral Home **Corner of**

**Oakes** -Fire Station #2 built in the 1920's

**Corner of Rockefeller** (1921) YMCA Georgian style

10. **TURN RIGHT** on Colby to 23rd

**2722 Colby** (1925) Med-Dental Bldg. Art Deco & Renaissance style.

**2714 Colby**-Treasure House, was oldest business on Everett & Colby. Built in the 20's as an auto shop.

**1611 Everett Ave** (1921) Knights of Columbus

**2416 Colby** Established 1880 - Everett High School - example of 'Beau Arts Academy' classicism is rich in detail.

11. **TURN LEFT** on 23rd to Rucker

**2301 Hoyt** (1920) Trinity Episcopal Church

12. **TURN RIGHT** on Rucker to 13th

**2230 Rucker** (1901) John T McChesney House

**2208 Rucker** (1910) Blackman House \$6,000 to build

**2201 Rucker** (1905) Spanish Colonial style

**2129 Rucker** (1895) Clark Mansion

**2112 Rucker** (1905) Howard S. Wright Construction magnate built this house & his company built Seattle Worlds Fair buildings including the Space Needle

**2108 Rucker** (1907) Hilzinger House This family moved here in 1903 from N. Dakota. Home was unoccupied for 15 years recently but has undergone a transformation.

**2031 Rucker** (1932) Marlborough Apts. Art deco/modern

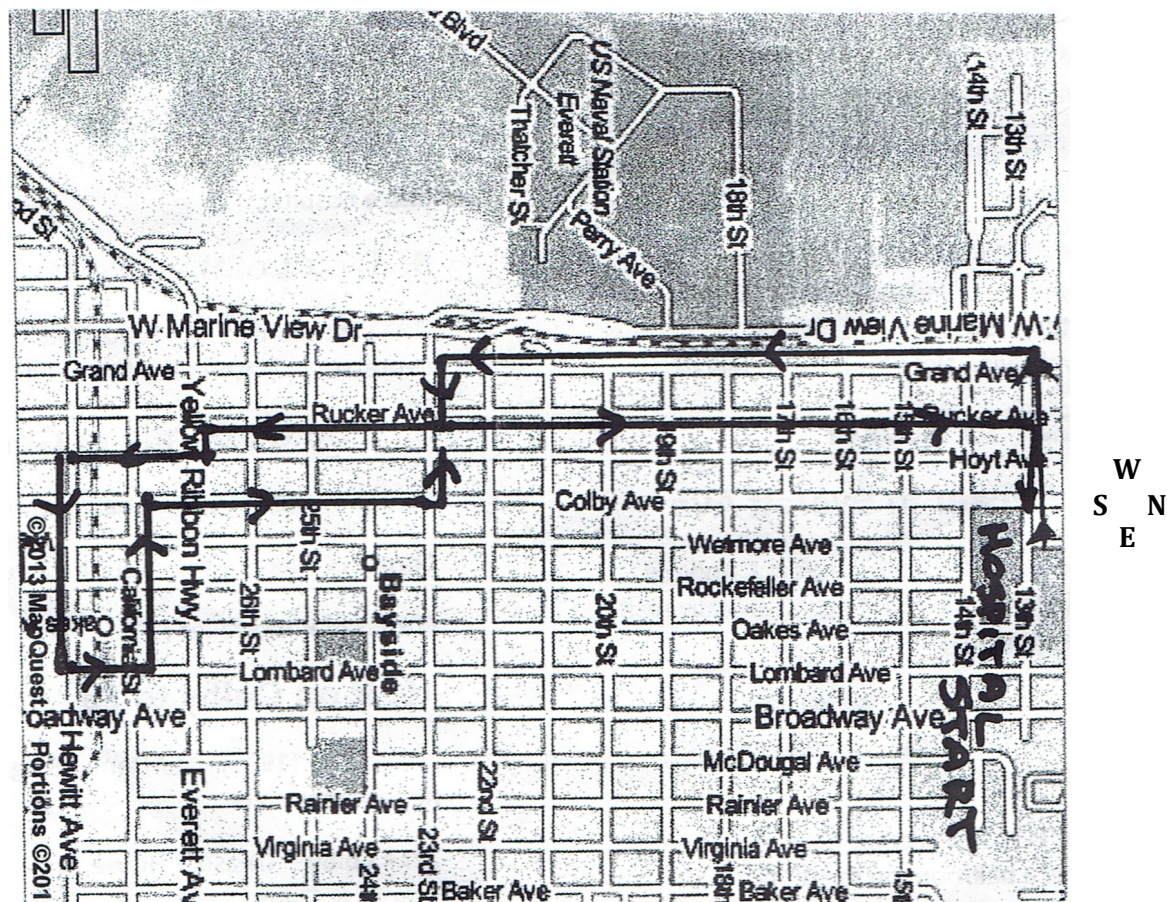

**I-5 NORTHBOUND:** Exit #192 (Broadway). North on Broadway. **Turn Left** onto 13th St. to Colby Ave. Starting point on corner of 13th St. and Colby Ave. Street parking.

**I-5 SOUTHBOUND:** Exit 198 (N Broadway/SR529S). Cross Snohomish River on Broadway to 13th St. **Turn Right** onto 13th St, continue to Colby Ave. Starting point on corner of 13th St. and Colby Ave. Street parking.

### **Walking Instructions:**

1. Facing 13th St. with hospital entrance to your back, **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk on 13<sup>th</sup> St. heading East.
2. **TURN LEFT** on Wetmore Ave, walk on right side of street.
3. Cross 10<sup>th</sup> St and **TURN RIGHT**, walking on 10th.
4. **TURN LEFT** on Broadway Ave.
5. **TURN LEFT** at corner with Tower St (Golf Course beyond fence), entering Everett College.
6. Continue straight ahead on campus. Look for Jackson Conference Center building to your right..
7. Pass Jackson Center, then **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk.
8. Pass Parks Student Union (RR), sidewalk **curves left**.
9. At Totem Pole **take left** sidewalk junction.
10. **TURN RIGHT** at next sidewalk junction.
11. Continue to edge of campus, pass Clock Tower.
12. Continue to Wetmore Ave, **TURN RIGHT**.
13. **TURN RIGHT** on Alverson Blvd.
14. **TURN RIGHT** on 2<sup>nd</sup> enter Legion Park.
15. **TURN RIGHT** to pass parking, enter Evergreen Arboretum.
16. Enter on **right side**, at trail junction **take right** hand gravel trail.
17. Continue across bridge, continue straight ahead to Silver Boxed sculpture in corner of Arboretum.

18. Return on **right side** of Gazebo, continue past Water Sculpture.

19. Exit Arboretum, **TURN LEFT** on 2<sup>nd</sup> to exit Legion Park.

20. Cross Alverson Blvd, **TURN RIGHT**.

21. Cross W Marine View Dr in crosswalk, **TURN LEFT**.

22. Follow W Marine View Dr, passing Port Gardner Bay.

23. Cross 10<sup>th</sup> St, **TURN RIGHT** to boat launch parking and Restroom in park.

24. Continue past front of Restroom to sidewalk trail. Sidewalk will **curve left**.

25. Follow sidewalk along edge of water, **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk toward Fisherman's Tribute statue.

26. Pass statue, **TURN LEFT** on 13<sup>th</sup> St, pass Scuttlebutt Brew Pub.

27. Continue on 13<sup>th</sup> St. Cross to right side at round about intersection.

28. **TURN RIGHT** on W Marine View Dr.

29. At new Pedestrian Bridge enter elevator or climb stairs to bridge.

30. Cross bridge to Grand Ave Overlook Park. Little Free library at 1603 Grand Ave.

31. **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk thru overlook park.

32. At end of overlook park, **TURN LEFT** on 19<sup>th</sup> St.

33. Walk on 19<sup>th</sup> St., crossing Colby Ave, **TURN LEFT**.

34. Follow Colby Ave return to hospital.
