Directions: For walk-on passengers from Edmonds-Kingston Ferry, Port of Kingston Kiwanis Park(PoKKP) is located to the right of the toll booth. If you are driving via Ferry, there is a free 2hr parking in the Marina parking lot on your left. Park, and walk across Hwy 104 to PoKKP. Driving from the Olympic Peninsula, head towards Kingston on Hwy. 104. There is a free 2hr parking in the Marina parking lot on your right. Park, and walk across Hwy 104 to PoKKP. RR located at Ferry Terminal and Library.

1. Starting at the Port of Kingston Kiwanis Park, with your back to the gazebo and ferry parking lot, **TURN LEFT** on the sidewalk along Washington Blvd.(street is unmarked)
2. Stay on Washington Blvd, crossing Hwy 104, for one block. **TURN RIGHT** onto Central Ave. NE (unmarked).
3. After walking a short block up hill to Ohio NE Ave., **TURN LEFT**, crossing the parking lot toward the water and a black metal fence.
4. **TURN LEFT** keeping the fence and the water on your right, and walk the perimeter of Mike Wallace park.
5. **TURN LEFT** to walk in front of the **Port of Kingston** office. Follow the sidewalk up the stairs to Washington Blvd. and Highway 104.
6. **CONTINUE** walking along Highway 104, passing dVine Wine Bar (winery), Mora Ice Creamery (Ice Cream Parlors), and the Firehouse Theater.
7. When Hwy 104 intersects with Bannister NE St. **TURN LEFT** onto Bannister, passing Downpour Brewing Co. (Breweries)(1K)
8. **TURN RIGHT** onto NE Oregon Street.
9. Walk through 4 yellow posts to the sidewalk on your left. Follow this sidewalk as it curves.
10. The large building ahead is the Regional Kitsap County Library (RR available). Continue on sidewalk which **TURNS LEFT** and down the hill to the street.
11. **TURN RIGHT** onto NE West Kingston Rd.(unmarked)
12. **CROSS** Barber Cutoff Rd, and **TURN RIGHT (2K)**.
13. **TURN RIGHT** on Tuckerman Ave. NE. into the Kingston Hill neighborhood.
14. Keep to the **LEFT** until you reach a "T" at NE Carpenter Lane.
15. **TURN RIGHT** onto NE Carpenter Lane.
16. Proceed to Barber Cutoff Rd NE. to the stop sign.
17. **CROSS** at the crosswalk, **TURN LEFT** at Barber Cutoff Rd NE (3K).
18. **TURN RIGHT** at the next stop sign onto NE West Kingston Rd.
19. At the next stop sign. **TURN LEFT** onto S. Kingston NE Road. Walk downhill over the bridge.
20. Arness County Park is on your left. **TURN LEFT** into the park, circle the park and enjoy the view (Porta Pottie).
21. Return to S. Kingston Rd and **TURN RIGHT**.
22. Cross NE West Kingston Rd. and **TURN RIGHT (4K)**, continue walking back to Kingston.
23. **TURN RIGHT** on Central Ave NE, using crosswalk. **TURN LEFT** at Washington Blvd. (5K). Kiwanis Park is straight ahead.
24. Be sure to log back into the OSB system (my.ava.org) to finish/complete your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's event bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for downloaded pdf is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the pdf is downloaded. Later, any pdf fees are credited back to walker's Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying for credit walker.). The \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days.

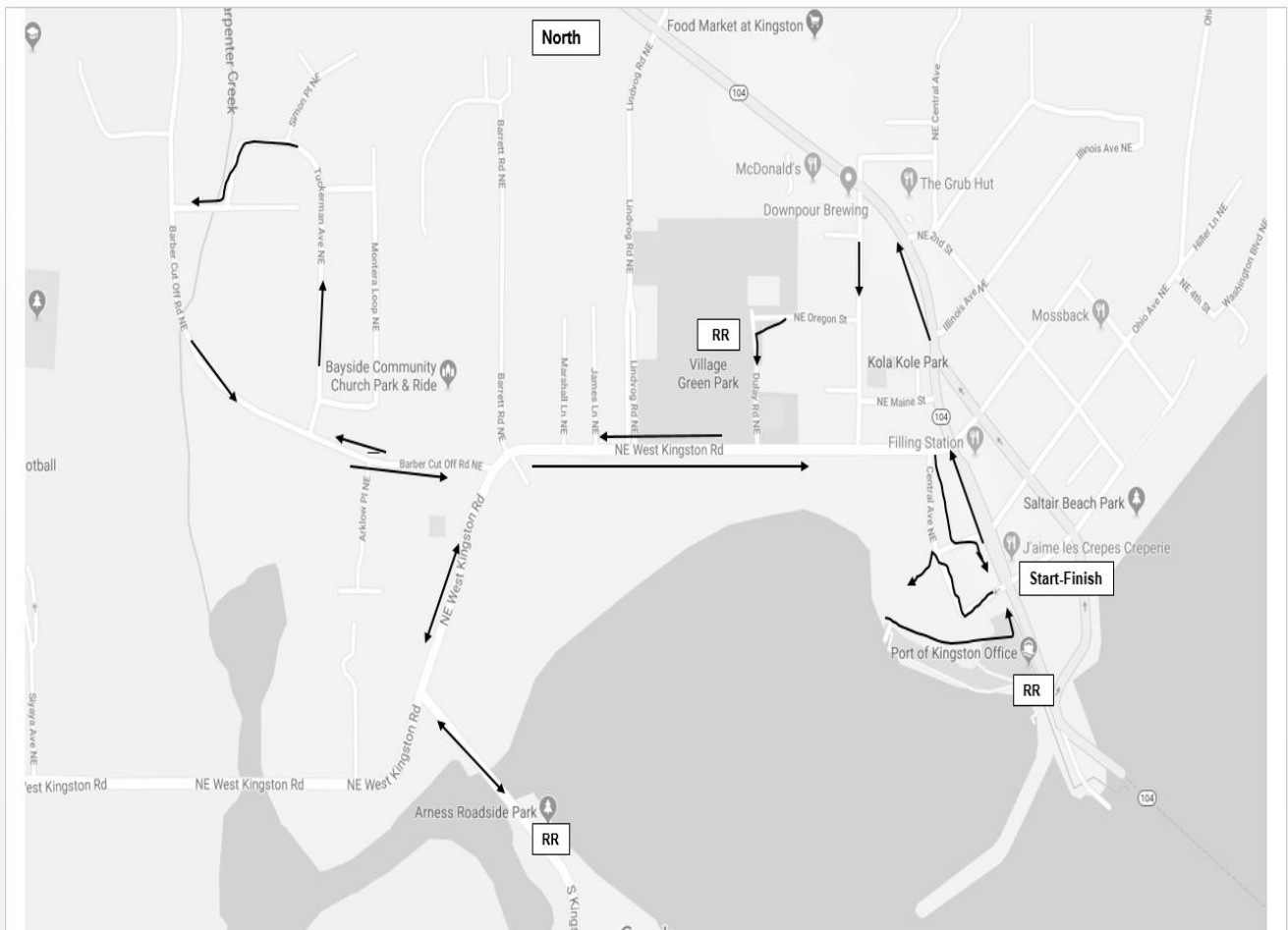
The walk directions and map may only be used in conjunction with a signed AVA athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

Directions: For walk-on passengers from Edmonds-Kingston Ferry, Port of Kingston Kiwanis Park (**PoKKP**) is located to the right of the toll booth. If you are driving via Ferry, there is a free 2hr parking in the Marina parking lot on your left. Park, and walk across Hwy 104 to PoKKP. Driving from the Olympic Peninsula, head towards Kingston on Hwy. 104. There is a free 2hr parking in the Marina parking lot on your right. Park, and walk across Hwy 104 to PoKKP.

RR located at Ferry Terminal and at Library.

1. Leaving the Kiwanis Park, with your back to the gazebo and ferry parking lot, **TURN RIGHT** on the sidewalk along Washington Blvd.(street is unmarked)
2. Walk on Washington Blvd, using crosswalk at light, and continue up hill, passing through yellow posts..
3. **TURN LEFT** at NE 3rd Ave.
4. Cross next street, and **TURN RIGHT** on unmarked street (Ohio Ave.).
5. Walk up hill on the left side, facing traffic, staying safely in single file. There is a narrow path that you can walk on.
6. On the right side of the street, you will see a brown park sign: **A Quiet Place. CROSS** street & **ENTER** the county park trail. **BEAR LEFT** at first "Y" junction. Follow trail markers:
 - (a) **RIGHT** at #8.
 - (b) **RIGHT** at #6.
 - (c) **RIGHT** at #5.
 - (d) **LEFT** at #4.
 - (e) **LEFT** at #3 to exit onto Ohio Ave (unmarked).
7. **TURN LEFT** on Ohio Ave, walking downhill.
8. On right side of road, look for green wired fence. **TURN RIGHT** before the green wired fence at the PUD Trail #1 sign, walking down a set of stairs.
9. Start the trail at the bottom by keeping to the **RIGHT**.
10. Cross over stream, **TURN RIGHT**. You will be walking along side of the creek on your right side. This is the main trail.
11. There will be side trails along the way, just keep going straight, veering to the right.
12. You should see a cement wall coming up on your right. As you reach the corner of the cement wall, take the main trail to the **LEFT**.
13. In a short distance, you will see a split in the path. Take the path **UP** the hill and continue for about 1K.
14. Path joins an unpaved road which is NE 272nd (unmarked). **TURN LEFT**, staying on NE 272nd.
15. Walk to junction with a paved road. This is Lindvog Road (unmarked). **TURN LEFT**. (At house #27066, you can see a StarWars play area in the backyard.)
16. **CROSS** Lindvog to walk on the right side.
17. When you reach Hwy 104, **CROSS** Lindvog in the crosswalk, then **CROSS** Hwy 104.
18. Walk downhill. **TURN RIGHT** on NE West Kingston Rd.
19. **CROSS** Barber Cutoff Rd NE and **TURN RIGHT** onto Barber Cutoff Rd NE.
20. **CONTINUE** to a sign for Carpenter Lake Nature Area. **TURN LEFT** on trail, which is next to school driveway.
21. You'll reach a split in the road. **TURN LEFT**, walking uphill.
22. **TURN LEFT** through cement barrier to Kitsap County Trail sign.
23. At paved road junction, **TURN LEFT**. High School Football field should be on your left. (RR available)
24. At "T" intersection, **TURN RIGHT** at stop sign. Continue toward HS parking lot.
25. Tennis Courts are on your left across from parking lot. **TURN LEFT** at this street corner intersection.
26. Walk along road between long wooden fence and parking lot. **TURN LEFT** at end of fence onto trail.
27. Trail is short and steep, covered in loose rocks. Walk the trail to the **RIGHT**, joining the main trail at the bottom which is **STRAIGHT AHEAD**.
28. Trail leads to **My Girl Drive-In/Museum**. (see www.mygirldrivein.com or call 360-297-1782 to reserve this amazing place for functions.)
29. Continue on long gravel driveway past Kingston Middle School. **TURN LEFT** on NE West Kingston Rd (unmarked), going downhill.
30. Cross new bridge and road as it curves left.
31. **TURN RIGHT** on S Kingston Rd NE. (signage also points to Indianola) in crosswalk. **CONTINUE STRAIGHT** to Arness Roadside Park on your left. (RR)
32. Walk around this small park, and return to road. **TURN RIGHT**, walking up hill to crosswalk.
33. **CROSS** NE West Kingston Rd, and **TURN RIGHT**.
34. Follow NE West Kingston Rd as it curves to the right. **CROSS** Dulay Rd NE and **TURN LEFT**. Stay on the sidewalk on the right side of the road.
