

The Olympic Peninsula Explorers Volkssport Club Welcomes You to the Gardiner – Miller Peninsula State Park Walk

The walk is 5k and 10k (2C) and are on somewhat difficult terrain with some moderate hill climbing. Strollers: No, Wheelchairs: No, Pets: Yes, Restroom: Yes.

Walk on forest trails within the park. Some trails are primitive. The 10k route has a spectacular view of Protection Island Aquatic Reserve, mountains, and the Strait. Sturdy footwear and walking/hiking poles are recommended as well as bug spray.

The walks start and end at Miller Peninsula State Park, 1091 Diamond Point Rd, Sequim, WA. From US 101, turn on Diamond Point Rd. Look for a developed parking lot with facilities on the left (1.2 miles).

NOTE: A Washington State (Parks) Discover Pass is required for parking. A kiosk is available to buy a daily pass at the park.

Walk Registration:

Registration takes place online using the AVA Online Start Box, on <http://my.ava.org>. Follow the instructions provided to create a user account and sign the AVA waiver (one time). Instructions for payment are also included. Download the directions and print as needed. The POC does not provide event directions or accept alternate payment methods.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have physically completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the “My Start Box” tab, then the “Finish Table” tab, then click on “Go to Finish Table” button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped “virtual” insert cards that you may choose to print out.

AVA Challenges: Walk the USA A-Z

1. Enter the trail on the NORTHWEST side of the parking lot. RIGHT and continue on gravel road until you come to a trail reentering the woods to the right.
2. At the first fork, keep to the RIGHT.
3. At the first kiosk (A), turn LEFT.
4. At the next "T" intersection, turn RIGHT.
5. As the trail wanders near the road, stay to the RIGHT.
6. Continue on this trail as it crosses a small bridge over a culvert.
7. At the "T", turn RIGHT and continue on the trail.
8. Near the top of the second hill, there will be a narrower trail that veers to the RIGHT. Take this trail (short evergreen at the intersection).
9. You will pass log benches on your right.
10. Stay on this trail until you come to Aerospace Rd (Kiosk G). The road is and unmarked, wide gravel road.
11. 5KM – at Aerospace Rd (Cement Blocks and cable barricade), turn around reverse course back to the registration table at the parking lot.
12. 7KM at Aerospace Rd (cement blocks and cable barricade), turn
13. Turn right on the trail.
14. Continue on this trail until you come to the kiosk (A) that you passed at step 3. Turn LEFT.
15. Follow this trail back to the parking area.
16. Be sure to log back into the OSB system (my.ava.org) to "finish/complete" your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded pdf is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the pdf is downloaded. Later, any pdf fees are credited back to a walker's Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying for credit walker.) Note however that the \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days.

AVA Challenges: Walk the USA A-Z

1. Enter trail on the NORTHWEST side of the parking lot.
2. At the first fork, keep RIGHT
3. At the first kiosk (A), turn RIGHT. Stay on the main trail and keep to the LEFT.
4. At Aerospace Rd (unmarked, wide gravel road), turn RIGHT.
5. Cross Aerospace Rd and turn LEFT at the next intersection (Kiosk B) and continue past the white barricade.
6. At the "T" intersection, turn RIGHT past the kiosk (C).
7. Stay to the LEFT at the next "Y" intersection.
8. At the "Y" intersection, stay to the right and continue down the hill past the kiosk (D).
9. Continue on this trail until you come to the beach.
10. Enjoy the view of the Straits of Juan de Fuca and Protection Island.
11. When you are ready, reverse course and proceed back on the trail to the kiosk that you passed at step 8.
12. At the next "Y" intersection, stay to the LEFT passing the kiosk (D) on your left.
13. Keep to the RIGHT at the next "Y" intersection.
14. At the "T" intersection, turn LEFT keeping the kiosk (C) on your left.
15. Continue on this trail until you come to Aerospace Rd. Turn RIGHT (Kiosk B). Cross Aerospace Rd and re-enter the trail that is almost immediately across from the intersection.
16. Stay on this trail until you come to the first kiosk (A) that you passed in step 3. Turn LEFT at the kiosk and return to the parking area.
17. Be sure to log back into the OSB system (my.ava.org) to "finish/complete" your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded pdf is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the pdf is downloaded. Later, any pdf fees are credited back to a walker's Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying for credit walker.) Note however that the \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days.

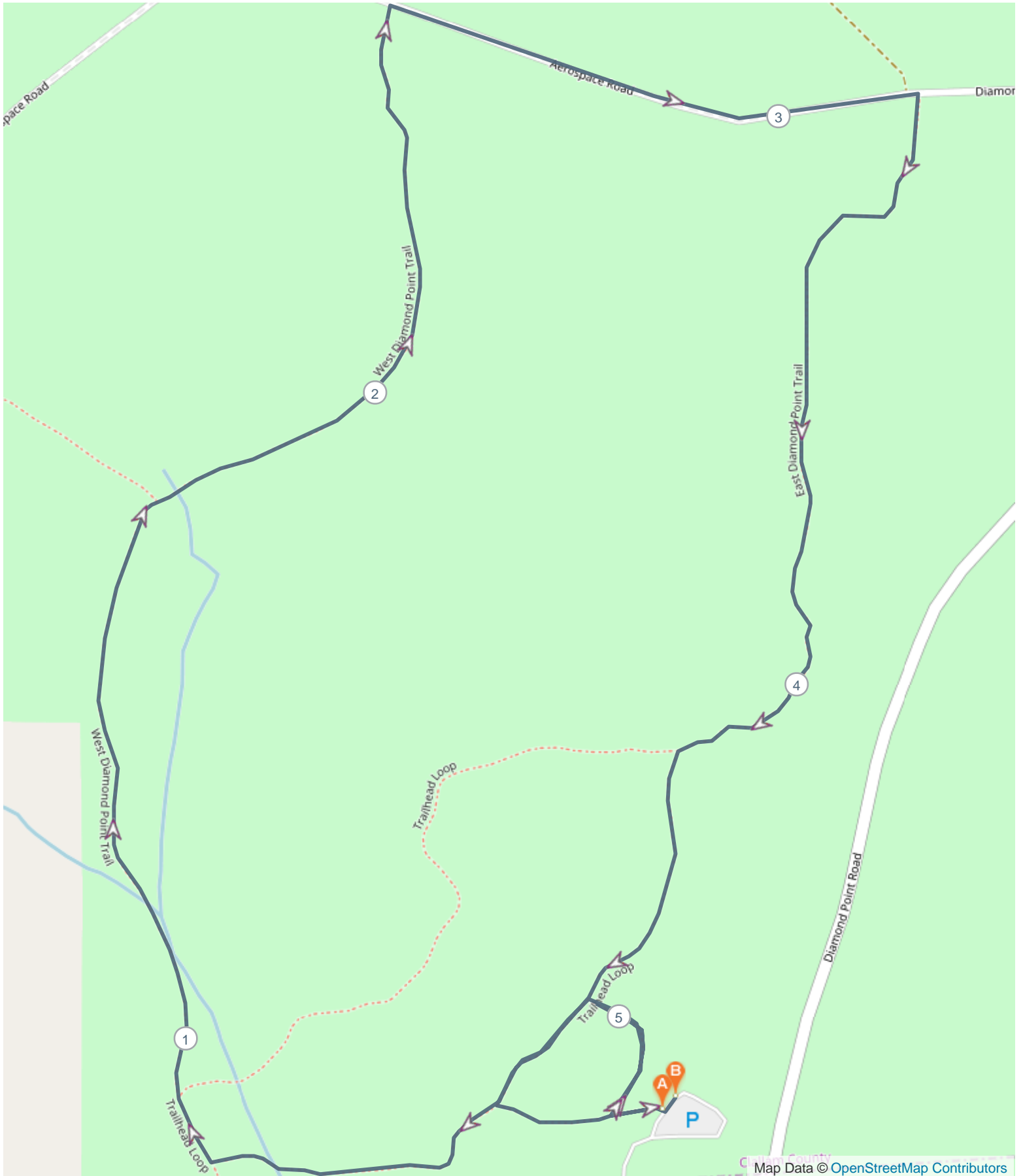
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Miller Peninsula 5km
