DIRECTIONS: Map: <http://tinyurl.com/DelrayPublix>; GPS: 26.4710652,-80.0673911. To Publix at 555 NE 5th Ave from I-95S/N use exit 52, Atlantic Ave. Turn left from I-95S (right from I-95N). Go .9 mi and turn left on Swinton Ave. Go .5 mi and turn right on NE 4th St. Turn left on NE 6th Ave. at light & then turn left & left into Publix. Wheelchairs/strollers are OK. Pets are allowed on a leash. There are restrooms at Publix and Anchor Park (10k). Lots of eating locations on Atlantic. Deck 64 on the route is good.

This map and directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

Walks further south off I-95 are Ft. Lauderdale (exit 26) and Miami South Beach (exit 4). A walk north is in West Palm Beach (exit 70).

Log into the OSB system (my.ava.org) to "finish/complete" your online registration after doing the walk. A fee of \$2 for a downloaded pdf is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the pdf is downloaded. Later, any pdf fees are credited back to a walker's Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying for credit walker, i.e. \$3.

1.	From Publix front go LEFT on walkway to 6th Ave/US1. Turn RIGHT to NE 4 St.
2.	Cross and LEFT on NE 4 th St. crossing US 1/NE 6 th Ave. Carefully cross to LEFT side facing traffic. No sidewalks.
3.	RIGHT on Palm Trail.
4.	RIGHT on NE. 2nd St.
5.	Cross & LEFT on NE 7th Ave.
6.	Cross & LEFT on NE 1st St. crossing 7 th Ave.
7.	RIGHT on Adult Center Rd. with shuffleboard on the left to Veterans Park.
8.	LEFT into Veterans Park at crosswalk towards pavilion and take walkway to RIGHT to bridge.
9.	5K: Go to Instruction # 32. 10K: LEFT on Atlantic Ave. crossing the Intracoastal waterway.
10.	RIGHT & cross Atlantic at Venetian Dr.
11.	RIGHT on Miramar Dr.
12.	LEFT on MacFarland Dr. Walk on left.
13.	LEFT on Ingraham Ave.
14.	Cross & RIGHT on Venetian Dr.
15.	LEFT on Nassau St.
16.	Cross & RIGHT on Gleason St.
17.	RIGHT on Bay St. crossing Gleason.
18.	LEFT on Venetian Dr.
19.	LEFT on Langer Way.
20.	Cross & RIGHT on Gleason St. and enter Anchor Park thru parking <u>exit</u> to sidewalk to Highway A1A. Restrooms on left.
21.	LEFT on A1A.
22.	LEFT on Ingraham Ave.
23.	Cross & RIGHT on Gleason St.
24.	RIGHT on Miramar St. crossing Gleason.
25.	LEFT on A1A to Atlantic Ave. RIGHT & cross Atlantic Ave. continuing LEFT on A1A.
26.	LEFT on Thomas St. at crosswalk/East Wind Condos.
27.	LEFT on Seabreeze Ave.

28.	RIGHT on Basin Dr. and curve to the LEFT to Lowry St.
29.	LEFT on Lowry St. for 20 m.
30.	RIGHT on E Rd. 1st right.
31.	RIGHT on Atlantic Ave., cross the Waterway.
32.	5K: Bear LEFT and walk under Atlantic Ave. at the bridge. Continue on the walkway next to the intracoastal passing Deck 84 restaurant. 10K: Curve right to Park and then RIGHT and under Atlantic Ave. at the bridge. Continue on the walkway next to the intracoastal passing Deck 84 restaurant onto Marine Way.
33.	RIGHT on SE 1st St.
34.	LEFT immediately on Marine Way.
35.	RIGHT on SE 2nd St. RIGHT crossing 2d St. and LEFT crossing SE 6th Ave. continuing on SE 2d St.
36.	Cross & RIGHT on SE 5th Ave. to SE 1 st St
37.	Cross & RIGHT on SE 1st St.
38.	LEFT on SE 6th Ave. to Atlantic Ave.
39.	Cross & LEFT on Atlantic Ave. Walk to NE. 1st Ave. (5 Blocks).

40.	RIGHT on NE 1 st Ave. continue on sidewalk with park on the right. Carefully cross to left side. Continue to NE 1 st St.
41.	Cross & RIGHT on NE 1 st St. crossing 1 st Ave.
42.	LEFT on NE 2d Ave. and enter Pineapple Grove Art District. Cross 2d St.
43.	RIGHT on NE 3d St.
44.	Cross & NE 3d Ave.
45.	LEFT on NE 2 ^h St.
46.	LEFT on NE 5 th Ave/Federal Hwy. LFL At 360, "Putting Around".
47.	Cross 5th Ave and LEFT then cross 4 th St. on NE 5th Ave. to Publix walkway and finish.

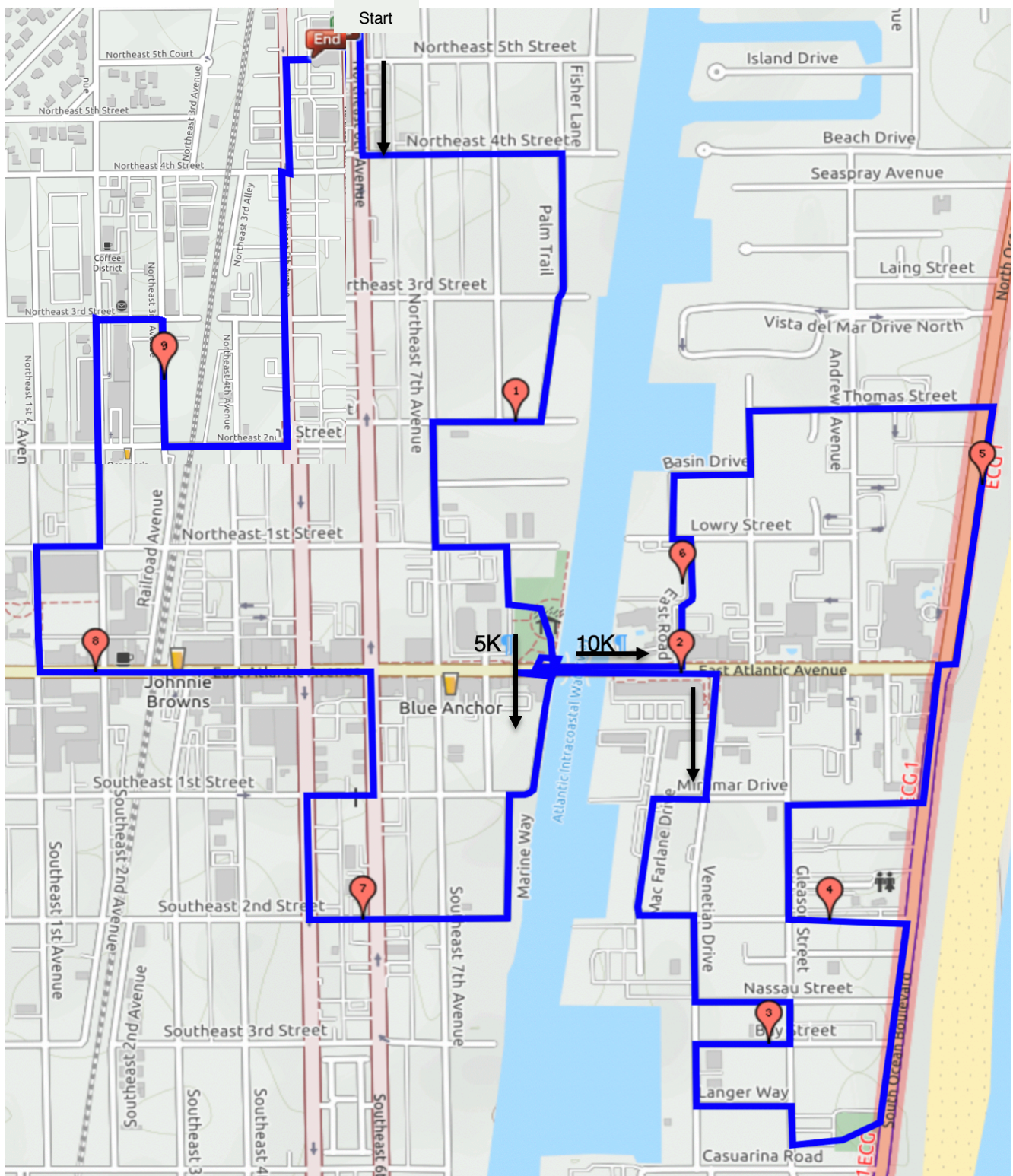
